Having reviewed the Federal Law No (1) of 1972 concerning the competences of the Ministries and the Powers of the Ministers and its amending laws.

Minister of Higher Education & Scientific Research Decree No (74) of 1999 concerning the working system of the education services institutions and the report of the Commission for Academic Accreditation concerning the Institutional Accreditation of “United Arab Emirates University” to work in the field of Higher Education,

**Decrees:**

**Article 1**

United Arab Emirates University is institutionally accredited to work in the field of Higher Education, in accordance with the provisions of the Federal Law No (4) of 1992, effective from April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2014 to March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2019. This accreditation is subject of regular reviewing in the framework of the comprehensive assessment conducted by the Ministry.
