6. Teaching Assistant Violations, Disciplinary Actions and Grievances

Goal

TA policies and its Code of Conduct describe the extents expected from the TA conduct and duties. Violation of these policies and regulations is subject to disciplinary actions which may impose penalties.

Policy

- 1. In case the TA is accused of a violation requires interrogation, he/she will be subject to the faculty disciplinary actions and policies relevant to university faculty violations and grievances.
- 2. In special cases, committees may be formed for investigation by a decree of the Vice Chancellor including the responsibilities of the committee.
- 3. The resignation of TA shall not impede proceeding with his/her disciplinary interrogation procedures and it shall be prohibited to accept the resignation if the TA has been referred to the Investigation Committee or Violations Committee.
