1. Governance of Student Services

Overview

The Students Affairs Deanship aims to enhance the learning environment at the University; support students in the attainment of their educational objectives; foster in students a sense of responsibility; promote an environment of cultural diversity, respect for others and a student-centered culture that serves the academic mission of the University.

The establishment of this system of governance operates to assure the alignment of the Student Services Policies with other University Policies and ensure that these Policies are contemporary, effective, and reflective of institutional values.

Scope

Unless specified to the contrary, the Policies in this Manual apply to all students enrolled at the United Arab Emirates University and all student organizations within the University.

Objective

The objectives of the university Student Affairs Policy Manual are as follows:

1. To define policies that govern all aspects of student life at the University;
2. To define clear and concise rules that students will follow while studying at the University; and
3. To serve as a primary reference and guidance on all matters related to student life.

Policy

1. The DVC for Students Affairs and Enrollment is the custodian of this Manual. All inquiries and matters relating to the Manual will be addressed to the Dean.
2. All Policies and Procedures stated in this Manual operate in conjunction with the relevant Signatory Authority.
3. Requests for updating the Manual (add/delete/amend) can be originated by any of the users of the Manual through the official channels of policy changes.
4. The updated version of the Manual will be posted online.
5. The Manual is maintained in two languages: English and Arabic. Where discrepancies in translation occur, the Arabic version takes precedence over the English.
