Payment methods:

According to the new University procedure, we would like to inform you that cash payment will NO longer be accepted by UAEU cashier.

- Cash deposit in UAEU account , Original deposit slip must be submitted to UAEU cashier for processing the payment with student name & ID. **Fax or photocopies will not be accepted as proof of payment.**

Deadline for Settlement of Tuition & Fees for Fall 2017:

- 1st Payment Deadline (50% of total tuition fees) on, **20 Aug – 31 Aug 2017**
- 2nd Payment Deadline (Remaining 50% of total tuition fees) on, **3 Sep – 10 Oct 2017**

Tuition Payment Installment Plan

- To arrange a tuition payment installment plan, students must apply at the SAO before **18 September 2017**. If you were entitled to an installment plan in the previous semester you must apply again for the current semester
- Non Payment of total tuition fees on or before **25 October 2017** will result in hold on registration and records. A hold means that you will not receive course grades until you pay your fees. It also means that you will not be able to register for courses in the next semester until payment is made. Unfortunately it may also mean forfeiture of grades and credits earned during the semester.
- **(SPONSORED STUDENTS)** Students whose tuition charges are paid or guaranteed by a sponsor must submit a valid official letter of financial agreement from the sponsor no later than **28 September 2017**, or risk having their registration for Fall 2017 cancelled.
