Admission

I. Policy

The United Arab Emirates University shall establish requirements governing admission in conformity with the policies of the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research and shall implement procedures that effectively and efficiently enroll qualified students to the University.

Students shall be admitted to the various colleges within the University according to the general policies and regulations established by the University.

Admission shall be limited to students whose achievements in high school qualify them for university education. A minimum of 70% on the General Secondary Certificate will be required.

Admission applications to the UAE University will be processed in complete coordination through a central admission office, the National Admissions and Placement Office (NAPO), in the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research. From time to time, the University will survey the needs of the United Arab Emirates job market for graduates from various specializations and determine the number of students to be admitted to each academic program.

Every college will set the minimum admission requirements for each of its academic programs. Admission of students into a particular program will be competitive among the students who fulfill the minimum admission requirements for the program.

The University will foster student life through cultural, social and sports activities and functions.

II. Application

This policy shall apply to the admission of all undergraduate students to the United Arab Emirates University.
