Procedures of Policy No. (12) - Student Volunteering

1. A volunteer is defined as:
 - a) An uncompensated individual who performs services directly related to the University. Volunteer work aims to support the humanitarian, charitable or public service activities of the University, and/or to gain experience in specific areas.
 - b) An uncompensated student who performs services for entities external to the University.
2. Categories of individuals who can volunteer within the University:
 - a) University students.
 - b) University Alumni.
 - c) Non-university high school students under the age of 18. (School students under the age of 15 are not eligible to apply for volunteering.)
3. School students may volunteer as part of the school program with the agreement of the responsible departments.
4. School students must get parental approval before being approved for volunteering.
5. If a person seeks to volunteer for services that are considered high risk (either to the volunteer or to the University), the volunteer must sign a disclaimer releasing the University from responsibility and liability for the consequences of their volunteer service.
6. The following services are some examples of high-risk services:
 - a) Laboratory work.
 - b) Working with animals.
 - c) Working with minors, patients, human research subjects.
 - d) Professional services, such as those performed by accountants, architects, engineers.
 - e) Services involving travel of any sort.
7. A University volunteer's term of service may be terminated for cause at any time and with no prior notice. An appeal to this decision can be submitted to the DVC for Students Affairs.
