Description:

Bayesian approach is becoming increasingly popular in all fields of data analysis. It also plays an increasingly important role in data mining and deep learning. This workshop will be a first step into Bayesian statistics. It will investigate the underlying theory and fundamental concepts by way of simple and clear practical examples.

Topics Covered:

1) Bayes' Theorem. Differences between classical (frequentist) and Bayesian inference. 2) Posterior inference: summarizing posterior distributions, credible intervals, posterior probabilities, and posterior predictive distributions. 3) Gamma-poisson, beta-binomial and normal conjugate models for data analysis. 4) Bayesian regression analysis. 5) Use of simulations for posterior inference. Simple applications of Markov chain-Monte Carlo (MCMC) methods and their implementation in R.
