The United Arab Emirates (UAE) aims to produce a **reading generation** that will help establish UAE as the capital of cultural and knowledge content (UAE MOHAP, 2019).

This reading festival, under the patronage of **His Excellency Chancellor Zaki Anwar Nusseibeh**, with the theme: **“Teachers and Leaders as Lifelong Readers”** intends to actualize this vision of a reading nation with teacher-trainees, teachers, school leaders, teacher-educators at the forefront.

The College of Education Office of Assistant Dean for Student Affairs and the Office of Research and Graduate Studies have combined their efforts to organize a month-long reading festival that would celebrate the **joy of reading**: *what it means to be a reader, and what it means to be part of a community of lifelong readers*. The reading festival is meant to be a vibrant month-long event with university-wide literary talent show, literary café sessions celebrating local and UAE-based authors and illustrators, reading challenges, conversations with academics and practitioners on engaging readers, and award-winning international authors and illustrators sharing their literary and creative process throughout the event.

The festival intends to go beyond the idea of reading as a mere skill that needs to be acquired, but **reading as a way to know and understand one’s self and the world – and the role that each of us play in building a more equitable, sustainable, humane, and inclusive society**.

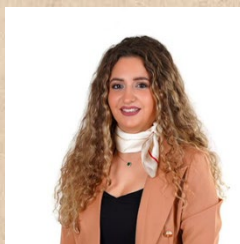
