
### **ENROLLMENT HISTORY IN GRADUATE PROGRAMS**




#### **ENROLLMENT HISTORY BY COLLEGES**

#### **GRADUATE STUDENT PUBLICATIONS BY YEAR (2010 – 2019)**



We have crossed a journey full of achievements and self-development. It all started with one question. The world is adapting digital payments why do physical receipts still exist?? Since then, Retech is on an endless journey to combat the unnecessary use of paper receipts. For a better sustainable future and aligning with Dubai 2021 vison of going paperless We're a team of passionate Emirati youth and our task is to leverage the retail industry by promoting Top-Notch Tech solutions. With our mobile app solution integrated with point of sale system.

We provide a seamless transaction of digital receipts and an interactive user interface, with real-time expense tracking enhancing the user experience & cutting down expenses.

We programmed a mobile app that leverages the use of artificial intelligence. The Mobile application advanced backend programming along with the mobile camera captures the data from receipts and invoices and transfers them digitally.

The captured data is analyzed and subcategorized into specific details, targeting the user's interest. This analyzed data is, with the help of sophisticated statistical equations is tuned into daily, weekly, yearly expenses per category! Giving the user a 360 view on his money, What goes in, What goes out, What have you saved and budgeted! #### **NANCY KACHOUH** PhD Student, Civil Engineering, COE

I am a PhD candidate and a research assistant in the Civil Engineering Department at the United Arab Emirates University (UAEU). My primary research interest is in the area of 'Structural/Material Engineering' with a particular emphasis on studying the behavior of concrete structures made of sustainable construction materials. My doctoral research revolves mostly around the area of steel fiber recycled aggregate concrete with an emphasis on sustainable construction. I have 2 articles and 2 conference papers published. I am one of the authors of the article "Effect of steel fibers on the performance of concrete made with recycled concrete aggregates and dune sand", published in "Construction and Building Materials" journal in 2019. My second published article is "Influence of steel fibers on the flexural performance of concrete incorporating recycled concrete aggregates and dune sand" published in "Journal of Sustainable Cement-Based Materials" in 2020. I presented the conference paper entitled "The Use of Steel Fibers to Enhance the

I was honored to receive this prestigious award that highly contributed to my educational path in civil engineering. Being a finalist to receive the award, ACI Foundation supported me financially to attend the ACI Convention in Quebec, Canada in March 2019. As a winner of the ACI Fellowship. I received an educational stipend, appropriate recognition in Concrete International magazine and on the ACI Foundation website; paid travel expenses and attendance fees for two additional ACI Concrete Conventions in the fall of 2019 and Nancy Kachouh at the Big 5 event, Dubai, 2019 spring of 2020; and assistance in finding an industry mentor. ACI Fellowship Award gave me the opportunity to earn more skills and to widen my research area by supporting me financially. Being recognized in Concrete International magazine on the ACI Foundation website is a very important step that highly contributed to my Phd studies in the Civil Engineering area. The Award I received from ACI Foundation will not only contribute to my current Phd studies only, but it will give me a big plus in the future when applying to positions in the educational sector.

As a member of the ACI-UAE chapter I was invited to be a speaker at the Big 5 conference in Dubai, UAE, in November 2019. The Big 5 is the largest exhibition dedicated to the infrastructure and heavy construction industry in the Middle East. Held November 25-28, 2019, at the Dubai World Trade Centre, the event hosted over 68,000 attendees and hundreds of local and international companies showcasing innovative solutions and products. My presentation was about the use of steel fibers in enhancing the performance of concrete made with recycled aggregate.





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# BODY WORLDS MUSEUM -ABU DHABI TRIP
