Abstract

The study aimed to investigate the situation of the UAE Legal legislator regarding the right of individuals to case, and specifically to appeal a judicial court. The Union Supreme Court has restricted the method of direct appeal in public authorities alone (without individuals), However, through its judgments, the Court has followed a certain method of interpreting the meaning of direct appeal, whereby the majority of appeals by individuals have been regarded as direct appeals other than those prescribed by law, making them inadmissible. The study reviews the court's jurisprudence in this field, finding that the court considers the appeal to be direct if it is included in the case law. The appeal shall also be deemed to be direct if it is submitted by one of the litigants in the substantive case before entering into the subject matter of the case. There is no doubt that the Union Supreme Court of the UAE has narrowed considerably the concept of direct appeal.
