Abstract

This thesis deals with swearing and invectiveness crime according to the Combat the Information Technology crimes law, Article (5). This crime can be considered as one of an Innovative crimes, which is rapidly spread, due to the technology development and the communications, which has been used to commit swearing and invectiveness crime. The importance of this study refers to the need of knowing the legal provisions relating to the crime of swearing and invectiveness using modern electronic means, as one of the Innovative crimes, and have not been studied extensively by researchers, so that almost no previous specialized studies on this subject because of the belief that this crime is referred to the general rules. This study aimed to clarify this crime by dividing the research into two chapters: the first one deals with the substantive provisions of this crime and includes clarifying both the physical element and the moral pillar, and then clarifying the punishment provisions for this crime. The second chapter deals with the procedural provisions of this crime, by examining the complaint as a general restriction on the Public Prosecution in initiating the penal action. Then, the investigation of the jurisdiction in this crime and the methods of proof. The study stressed the importance of focusing on awareness of this type of crime and the need to train and increase the efficiency of those working in the control of these crimes and achieve them in line with the technological development in the means of modern technology, and the need to tighten the penalties for the perpetrators of this crime, because it poses a serious danger and a great impact on the honor and consideration of the victim.
