Abstract:

The study deals with the philosophy and development of the penalties imposed on the crimes created using modern technology, In accordance with Decree-Law No. (5) of 2012 on Combating Cybercrimes, Research and study in the philosophy and approach of the legislator to the penalties he decides is of great importance, especially in cyber-crimes, since this is a new crime under criminal law.

The most important of these are the security, social and economic aspects, over time,

these crimes have crossed continents and have not recognized borders. States have become in dire need of deterrent legislation to achieve their objectives and purposes.

This has led the UAE legislator to address them by criminalizing illegal uses through punitive provisions against anyone who wishes to delve into in this regard, the United Arab Emirates was one of the first Arab countries to legislate in the field of combating Cybercrimes. It led to the promulgation of Law No. (2) of 2006, followed by Decree Law No. (5) of 2012.

Law No. (2) of 2006 covered some types of crimes that were known during the period that accompanied its issuance, but over time, the progress and development of technical means, the law became out of date for the new developments in the field of information technology. 2006, and resulted in the Decree Law No. (5) of 2012, adopting the policy of punitive tightening, which increased the penalties prescribed for those crimes, whether the penalties for deprivation of liberty or fines, and to achieve the goal that was inspired by the UAE legislator behind the tightening of these penalties, The UAE legislator and provision for mitigation of punishment.
