Abstract

This thesis deals with the limits of the liability of the partner in the limited liability company, in accordance with what is stated in the UAE legislation and comparing it with the texts related to the same subject in Jordanian legislation.

The importance of this issue stems from the limited liability of the partners in the limited liability companies towards their customers, due to the weakness of the guarantees provided by the limited liability of the partners which concentrate in the amount of their shares in the capital of the company only.

Therefore, this study dealt with the definition of the limited liability company by defining its characteristics, management and expiry in a preliminary chapter. The first chapter deals with the responsibility of the partner in the limited liability company before or during the establishment stage of the company, by looking at the general and specific conditions of the company and then the formal conditions for its holding, and the provisions regarding the responsibility of the partners in the event of failure of one of these conditions. In the second chapter, the study dealt with the responsibility of the partner during the life of the company, and after liquidation, through explaining the responsibility of the partner during the life of the company, and his responsibility for management, and when liquidating. The study concluded that the limited liability of the partners significantly affects the financial rights of the customers. It is necessary to establish conditions and guarantees that increase the extent of the partner's responsibility to guarantee the rights of others and encourage them to trust and deal with the company.
