Abstract

The aim of this study was to evaluate and analyze the policy of incubation of poster care of children in the United Arab Emirates by studying the views of the concerned parties (the local authorities and institutions in the country and the relevant ministries, Ministry of Interior, Ministry of Education, and Ministry of Health) The study of the case and the analysis of content and personal interview to collect data, as well as the researcher to develop tools to determine the degree of satisfaction of administrators and officials in charge of the project incubation and to determine the degree of satisfaction of the host families, The researcher found that the degree of satisfaction of the foster families as well as the administrators and officials was high. The study showed that the poster care of children has achieved the desired goals and that the position of the Federal National Council is positive towards the incubation policy.
