Abstract

The issue of food pollution has a wide interest because of the importance of food in human life and health. Wherefore, many legislation tend to take care of Food Safety. The study of this subject aimed to indicate the adequacy of federal and local legislation that issued to protect Food Safety through analysis and comparison between these legislations. It begins with clarify the meaning of Food Safety and the terminologies similar to it and the sources which are affecting it before it review the legislation that ensured food protection in UAE.

In addition, the study aimed to explain the importance of the role of administrative authorities to protect food through the powers, the procedures and the administrative sanctions to implement food legislation to achieve the purpose of what were found in a way that ensures food safety and suitability for human consumption.

The results of the topic have been shown that despite the existence of food legislation, but still difficult to apply it in the field due to the federal and the local legislation that may interfere or conflict with the provisions contained in each, as well non-compliance of the food legislation by food establishments' owners.
