Abstract:

Reasons which made me interested in this subject No doubt, constitutional claim of its diverse types & forms represents the only way through which constitutional censorship is undertaken over laws since it guarantees one of the most significant human rights. Besides, this claim assumes a considerable role in achieving justice and secures remedies for defendants. Through addressing this legal part, which is considered as one of the key legal systems and is considered the most sensitive in the constitutional claim, emphasis was put in this study on referral in its two forms; the first is to pay no curtailment, in which individuals initiate proceedings, and the second is the plea for spontaneous referral from courts.
