Abstract

In this research, we discussed the criminal liability for the physician and the like for the crime of abortion case. We discussed this subject in two main chapters. The first chapter has covered the presumed conditions of the abortion crime. It is one of the presumed conditions that change the legal adaptation of crime from misdemeanor to felony. This change results in determining the punishment prescribed for the crime in its aggravated or mitigating circumstances.

We also discussed in this chapter the condition of the place and its impact on the existence of crime and we found that the crime is not only the pregnant woman; the place in this crime is the fetus and is a special condition for the crime of abortion. We also studied the crime and the corner of the physical and moral cornerstone.

In the second chapter we discussed the rules of criminal liability of the physician and the like for the crime of abortion, where we discussed the general rules of permissibility, and found that the patient's consent here does not allow the physician to abort. We also discussed the case of therapeutic abortion that denies the physician's criminal responsibility.

In this chapter, we are presented with a criminal contribution to the crime, both of which is the original contribution and the contributory contribution. We also addressed the punishment prescribed for different forms of abortion. We introduced the penalty of initiation where the UAE legislator takes the personal doctrine of punishment and is punished for initiating abortion.
