<u>Abstract</u>

The research investigates with the question of the court adheres to the limits of the criminal proceeding in the UAE Criminal Procedure Law, in order to acquainted the principle and the justifications of the Court restrict limits of the criminal proceeding, and the extent of the courts' commitment to those limits.

The research structure includes two main parts; the first part identifies the court adheres to the limits of the criminal proceeding (Rem and Personal scope) and the legal basis of the courts compliance to the criminal proceeding bounders. The second part illustrates the courts' authority to amend or change the legal characterization in the criminal proceeding.
