Abstract

The harm to the integrity of the body is one of the most complex types of damages when estimating compensation, considering that it affects the life, work, and livelihood of the injured person, especially since the physical injury resulting from the harmful act may aggravated in the future - after the issuance of the final judgment - where the court and medical expertise may not be able to consider. Whether by exacerbating the damage and its constituent elements, or by exacerbating the value of the damage by changing the market value of currencies.

This study shows the jurisprudential differences in the issue of the permissibility of compensation for the exacerbation of damage in itself and its value, and the legal basis for each opinion.

This study aims to find a clear legal regulation followed by the UAE courts in deciding the issue of reconsideration of compensation for the aggravation of bodily harm.

This research has reached some conclusions and recommendations.
