- Recognize the impact of Stress and Burnout in healthcare.

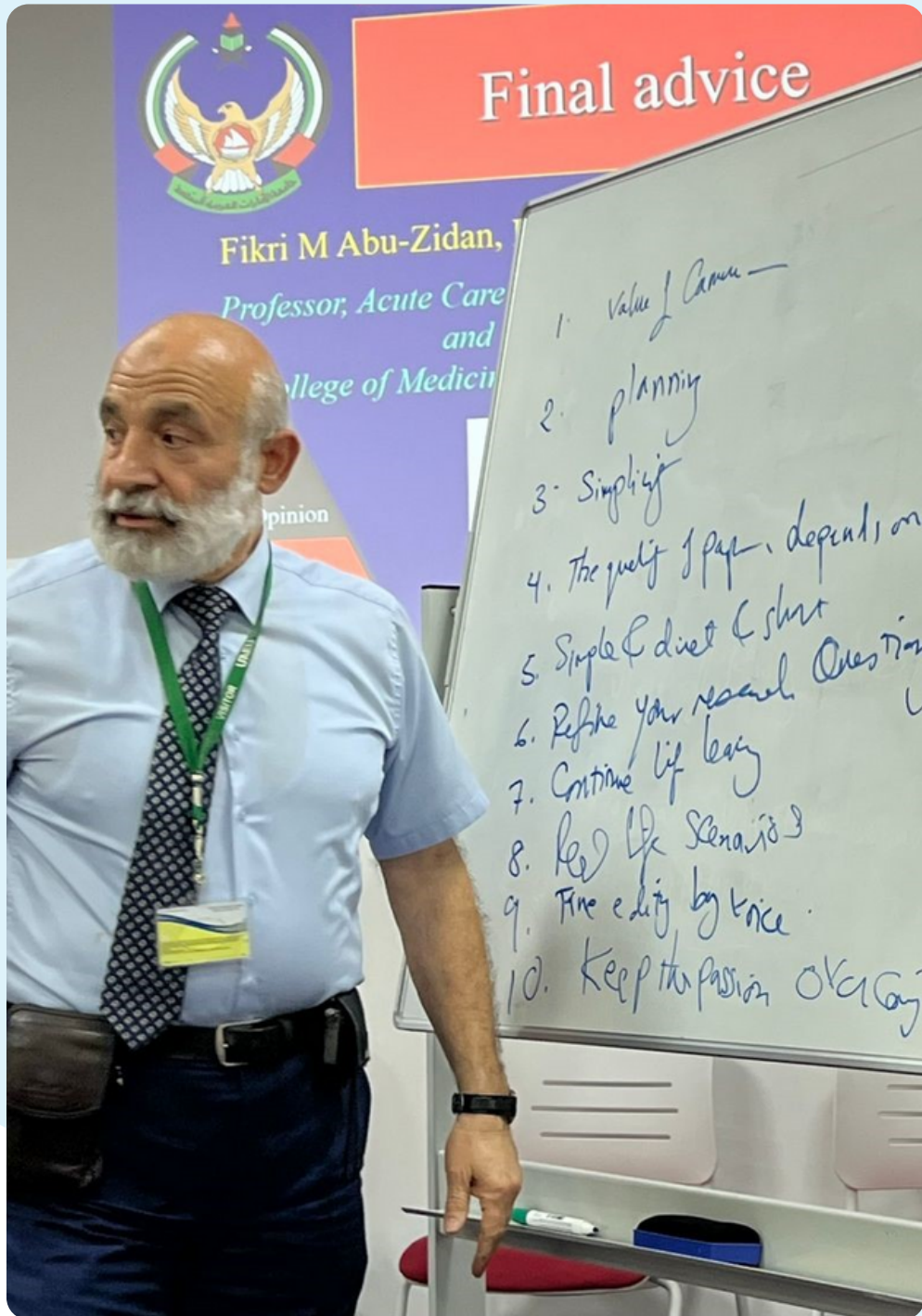
Clinical Reasoning and Critical Decision-Making Workshop, May 3rd, 2023



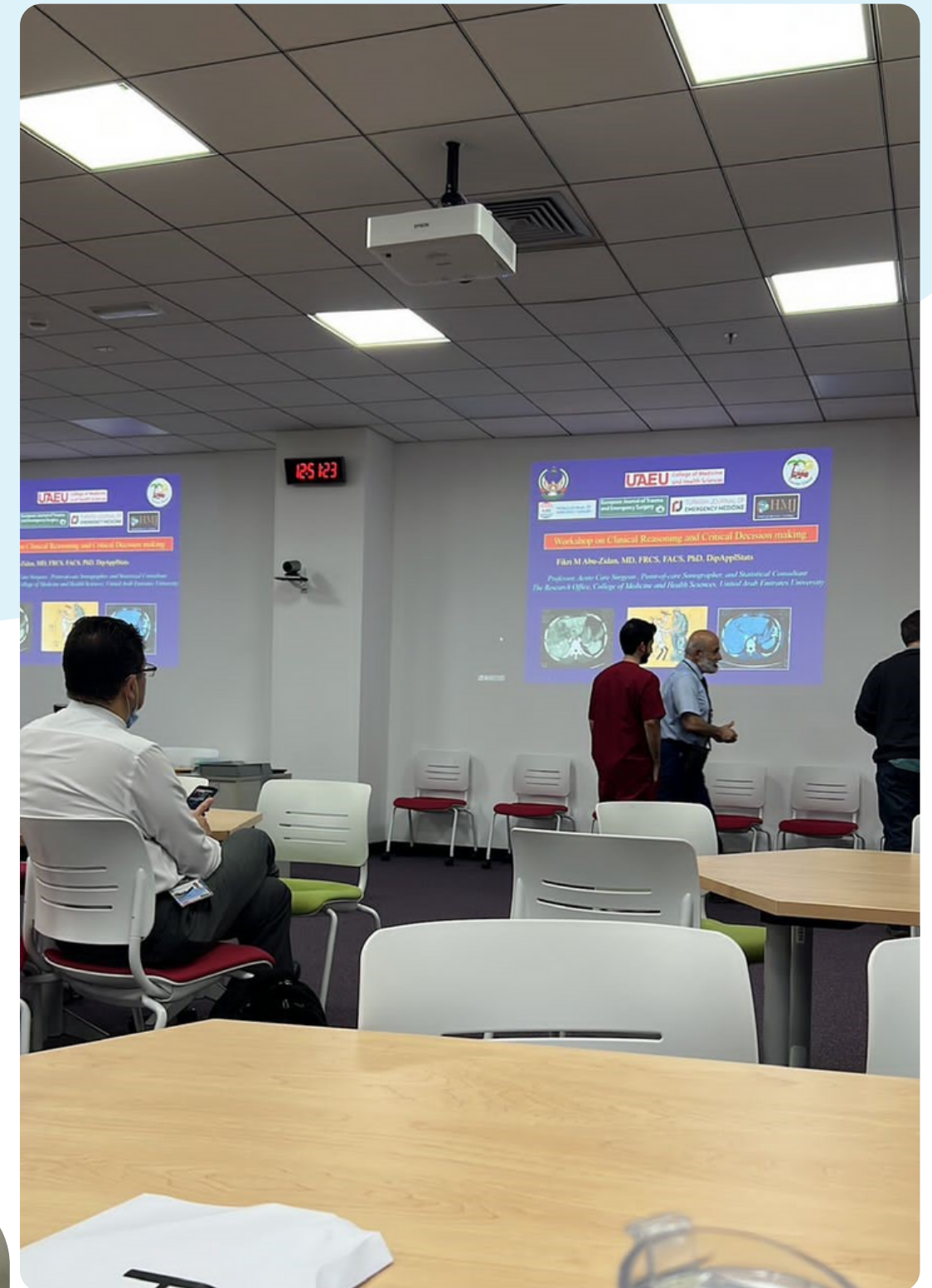
Critical decision making (CDM) is a complex process in which decisions are made depending on the patient, health care providers and the environment in which care was given, 6 hours workshop was delivered by Professor Fikri Abu-Zidan is an international scholar in acute care and trauma surgery, disaster medicine, point-of-care ultrasound, and applied medical statistics and research methods.

- Apply the methods of clinical reasoning in real interactive challenging cases.

- Have a chance to actively participate in solving challenging clinical problems.

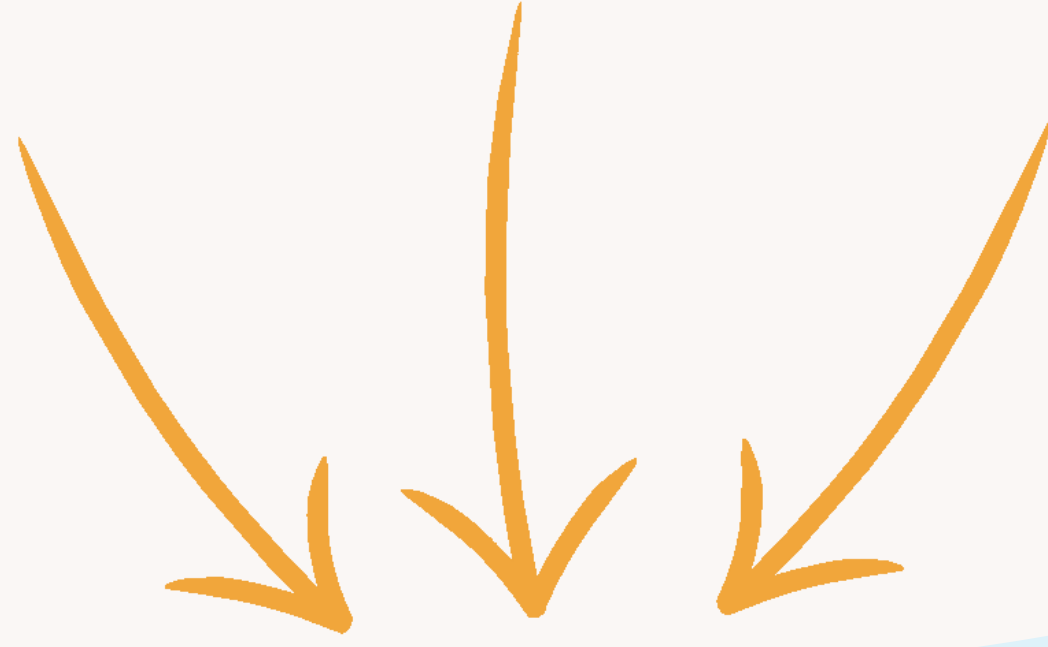
