- Students who are currently under **Probation 2** are allowed to register at beginning of Fall 2014 Semester.
- Each student should meet with his/her academic advisor **prior to** registering.
- The student assumes total responsibility for his/her choice regarding courses and study plan.
- Student in good academic standing may register 12 to 19 credit hours.
- Students who are under Probation 1 cannot register for more than 13 credit hours.
- Honors students and students who expect to graduate in Fall Semester 2014/2015 may register for up to 22 credit hours with college approval.
- Questions regarding section capacities, closed sections and all types of restrictions should be directed to your College Advising Units.
- Students who will receive Probation by the end of Spring semester 2013/2014 must correct their registration during the add/drop of the Fall Semester.
- Student who are continuing and failed in any of their UGRU course will have to correct their registration during the add/drop of the Fall Semester.
