- Support senior staff to liaise with government agencies and other authorities as may be required regarding development objectives, policies and procedures.
- Ensure compliance with the company's Quality Assurance policies and procedures
- Assist senior staff in the identification and pursuit of business development opportunities.
- Assist in the preparation of proposals and qualification documents in the interest of obtaining new assignments.
- Provide such further assistance to senior management, DP+E team as may be required from time to time.
- Provide effective representation for the organisation, developing and managing relationships with the client and other local
