Wireless infrastructure upgrade to support modern mobile devices

Wireless networks are becoming commonplace on university campuses around the world. Their popularity stems from the "out of the box" experience of immediate and easy access to resources everywhere on campuses.

UAE University (UAEU) has a wireless network in place, providing coverage for the whole campus for a while. However, given the rapid shift towards the use of mobile technology by the university community, it became evident that the wireless network and its underlying infrastructure needed to be enhanced to meet student, faculty and staff expectations.

Indeed, in November 2012 University Information Technology Services (UITS) initiated the upgrade of its wireless network infrastructure and completed it on 4th of Jan 2013.

With the view of staying competitive and encouraging innovation, this latest upgrade achieves high data rates of 300 MBps based on IEEE 802.11a/b/g/n standards, thus enabling the infrastructure to support Bonjour services and Airplay services for projection via Apple devices i.e. iPad and Mac books in accordance with the UAEU iPad project.

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
