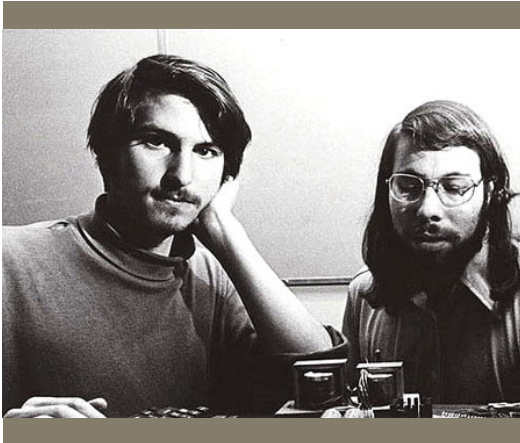


Remembering Steve Jobs

The timeline of a visionary and a creative genius



The story started in a bedroom that sketched out a history of achievements reaching all over the world; that was the birth of the 1st “Apple I”, Steve Jobs with the company of his partner, Steve Wozniak, made the first kick off.

The foundation of the Apple Computer was on 1 April 1976



and the journey began

July 1976 — June 1979

Apple growth began in the 70s, starting with building the marketable Apple I, the release of Apple II with color graphics in April 1977. Followed in June 1979 with the introduction of the Apple II.

1980 — 1984

Apple III released in 1980 which targeted the business customers. On Dec 1983, with a built-in clock, was the release of Apple III Plus.

In January 1984, with the direction of Ridley Scott, an ad campaign established for the launch of Macintosh Computer.

1985 | A step outside Apple

1985 the year when Jobs resigned from Apple, and founded NeXT; the company that developed and manufactured computer software and hardware.

In the same year Jobs bought the LucasFilm computer division which is introduced later with the name “Pixar”, the animation studios.
