- Before opening any link given in the email, type them into the browser to ensure you are opening the right site.

Avoiding scams and hoaxes

- Scam and hoax emails are designed to trick user into disclosing personal information, such as account detail, passwords etc.
- Scam emails are also often used to get your attention into paying money for fake get-rich-quick offers, prize or lottery wins etc.
- Be careful about emails received from people or businesses you don't know, particularly ones that promise you money.
- Remember - Banks never ask for confidential information via email. So, you should be careful about email received from banks discussing your account details etc.
- Scammers put a lot of time and money into making email and website look real. Don't be fooled.
