% Distribution of Male Admission by College / Place Of Residence



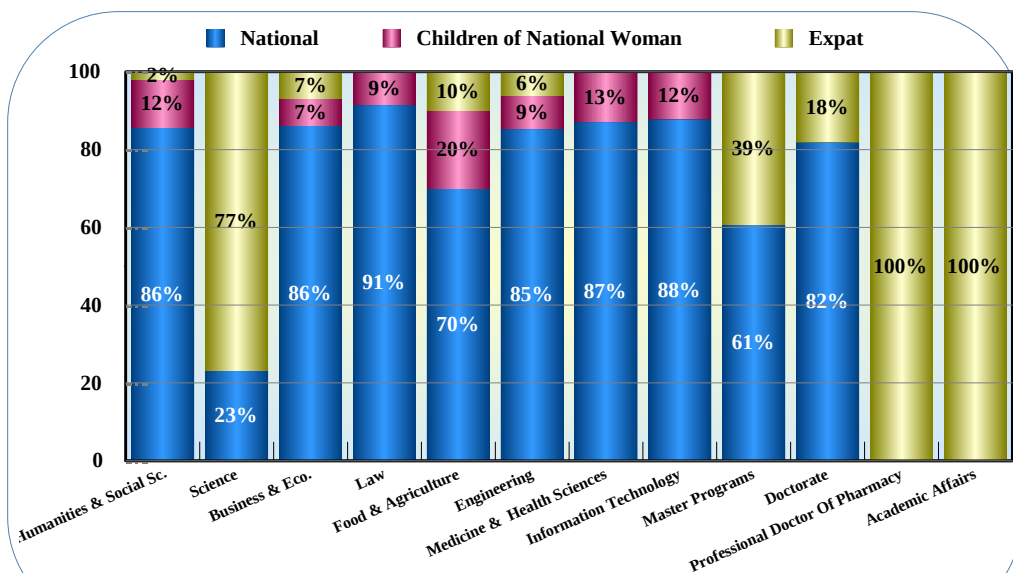
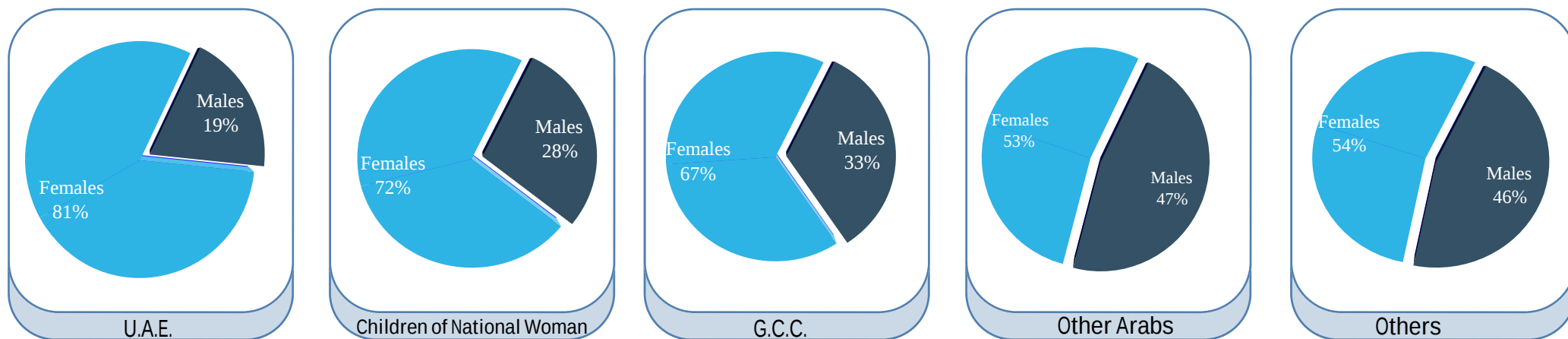

% Distribution of Male Registered by College

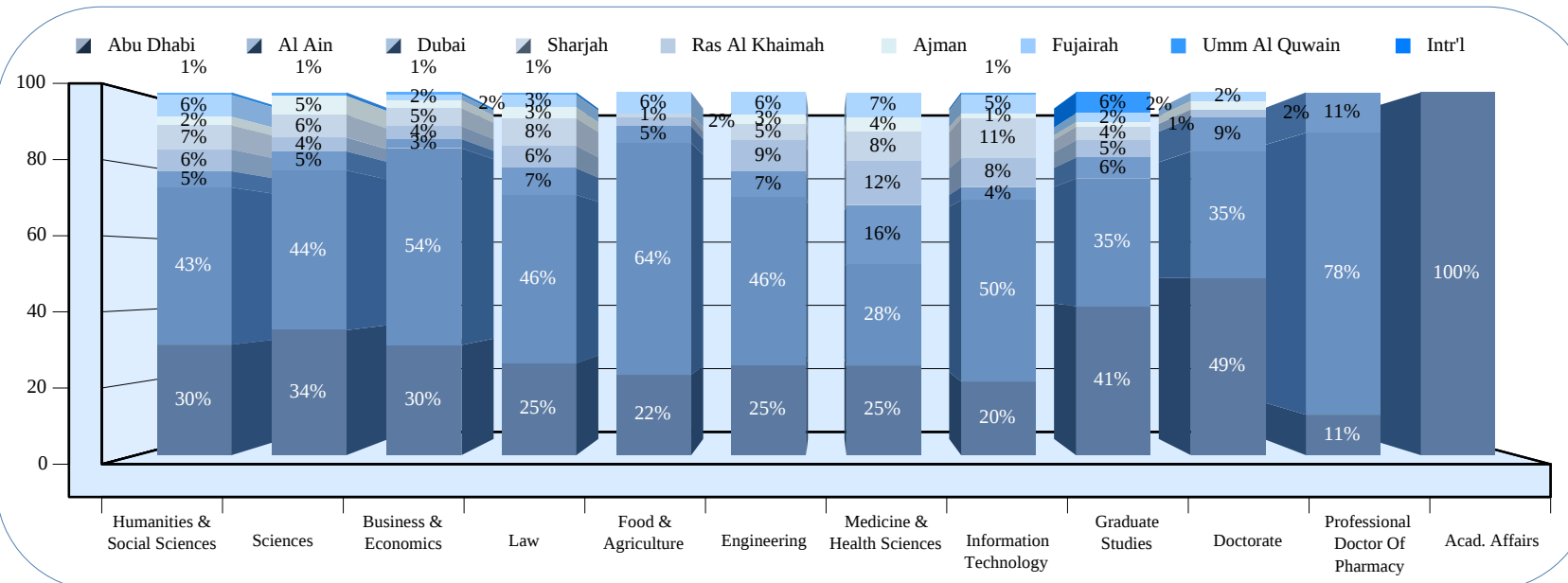


% Distribution of Female Registered by College

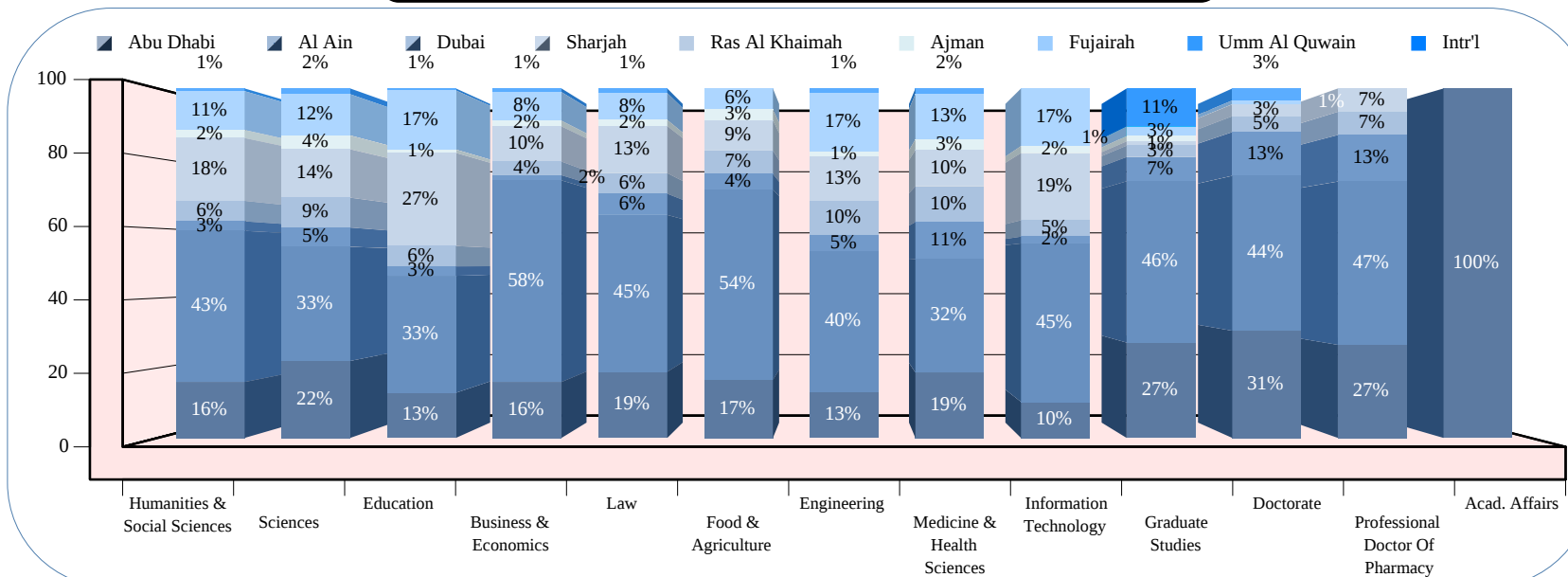

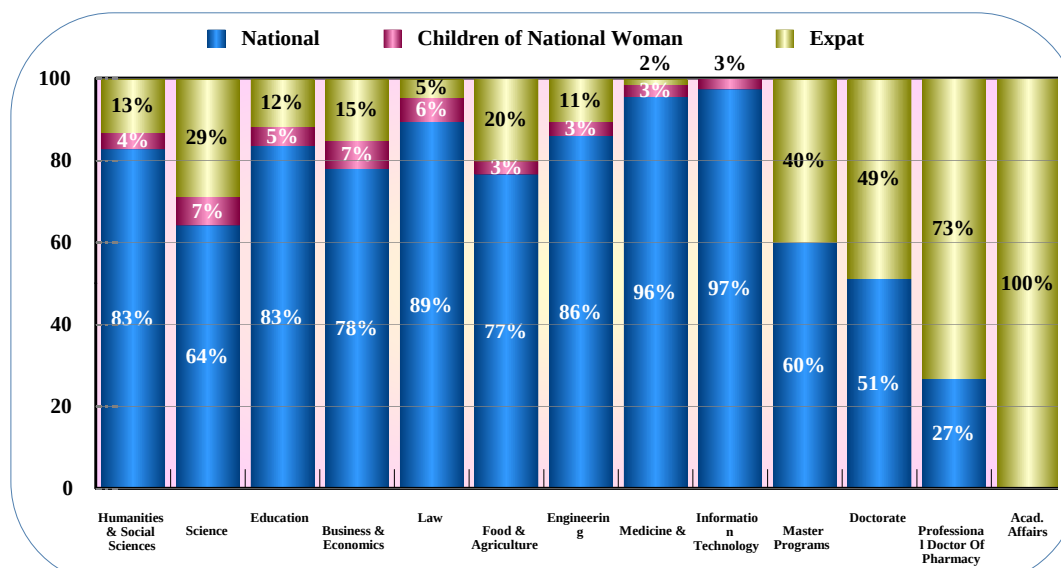

% Distribution of Male Registered by College / Nationality

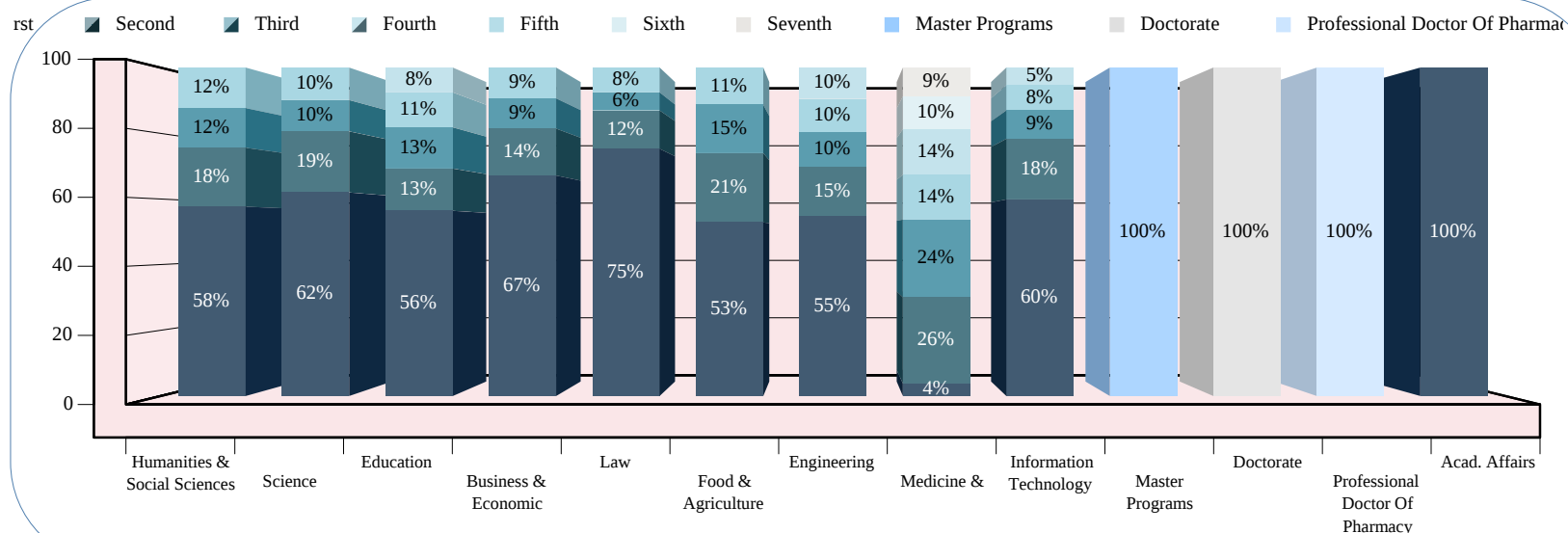


% Distribution of Female Registered by College / Nationality

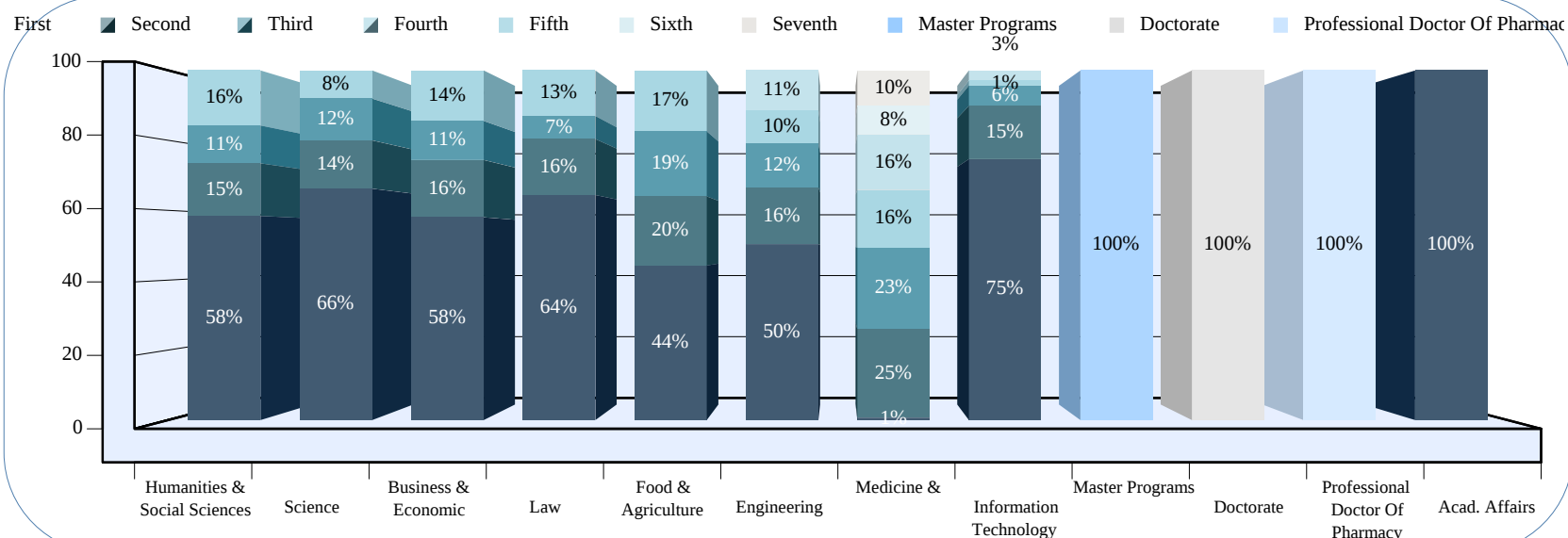

% Distribution of Female Registered by College / Student Level

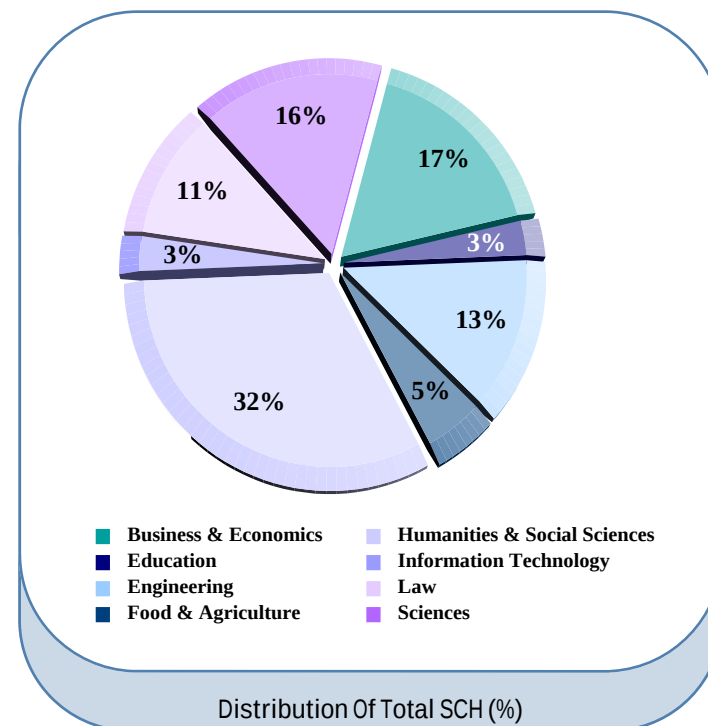


% Distribution of Male Registered by College / Student Level

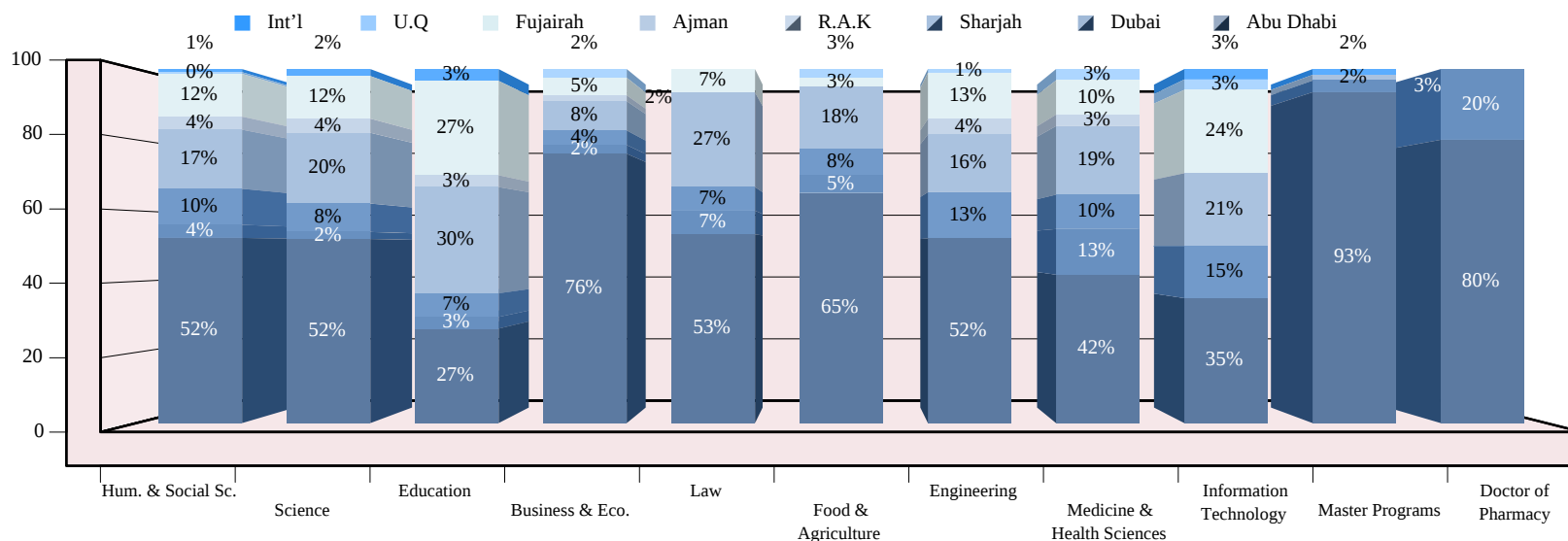
Graduate Students by Gender / Nationality Groups



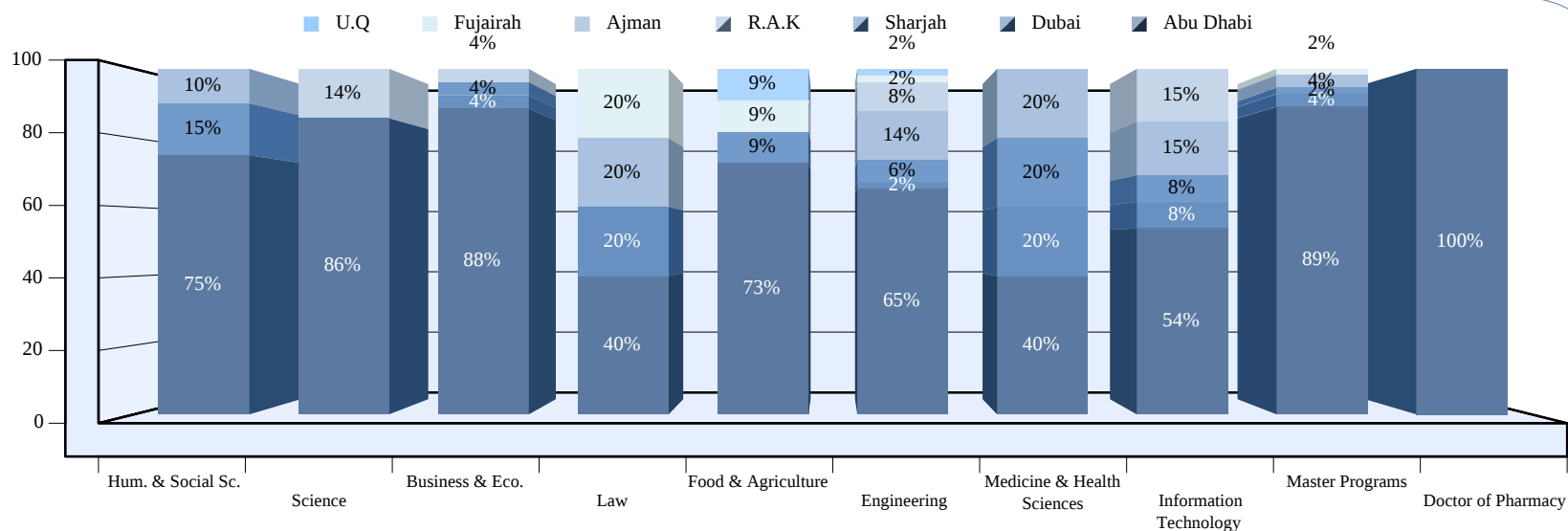

% Distribution of Female Graduates by College / Place Of Residence

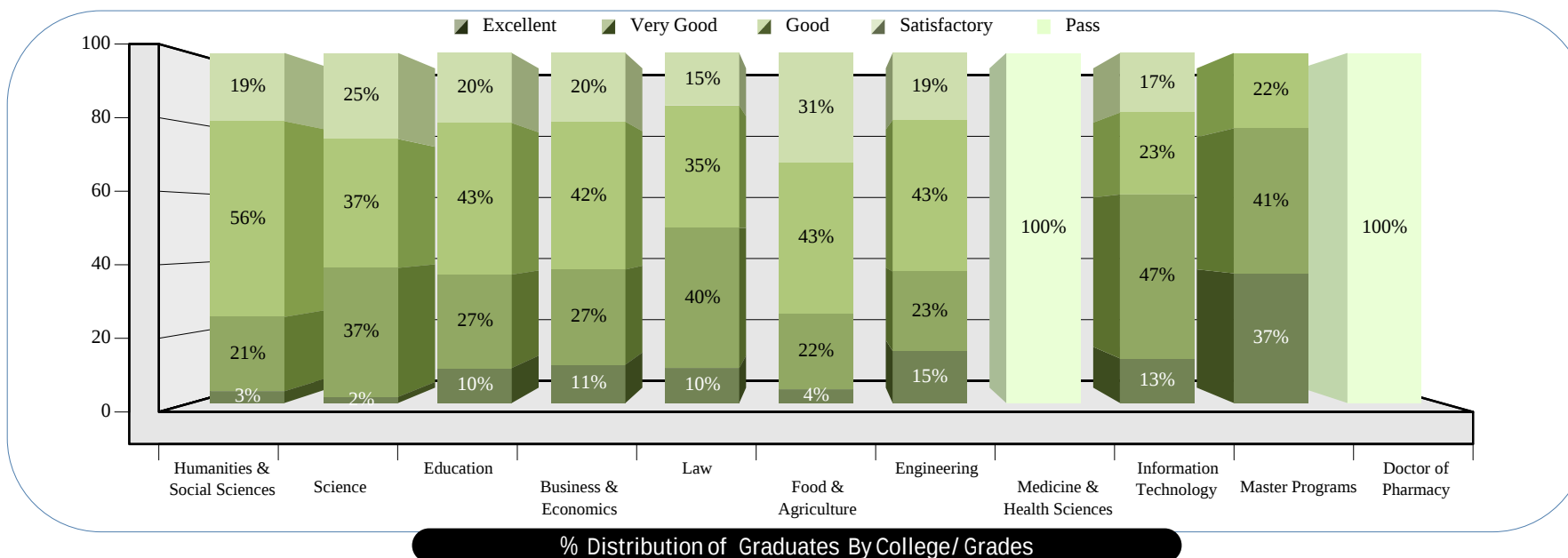


% Distribution of Male Graduates by College / Place Of Residence

% Distribution of Male Registered

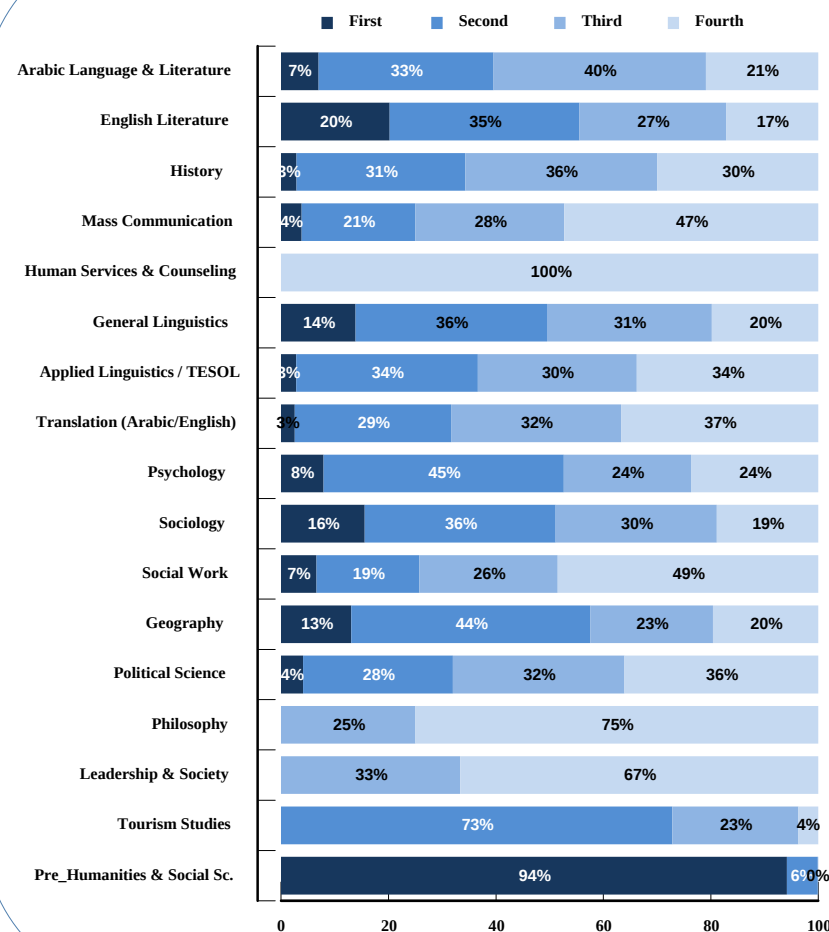


% Distribution of Female Registered

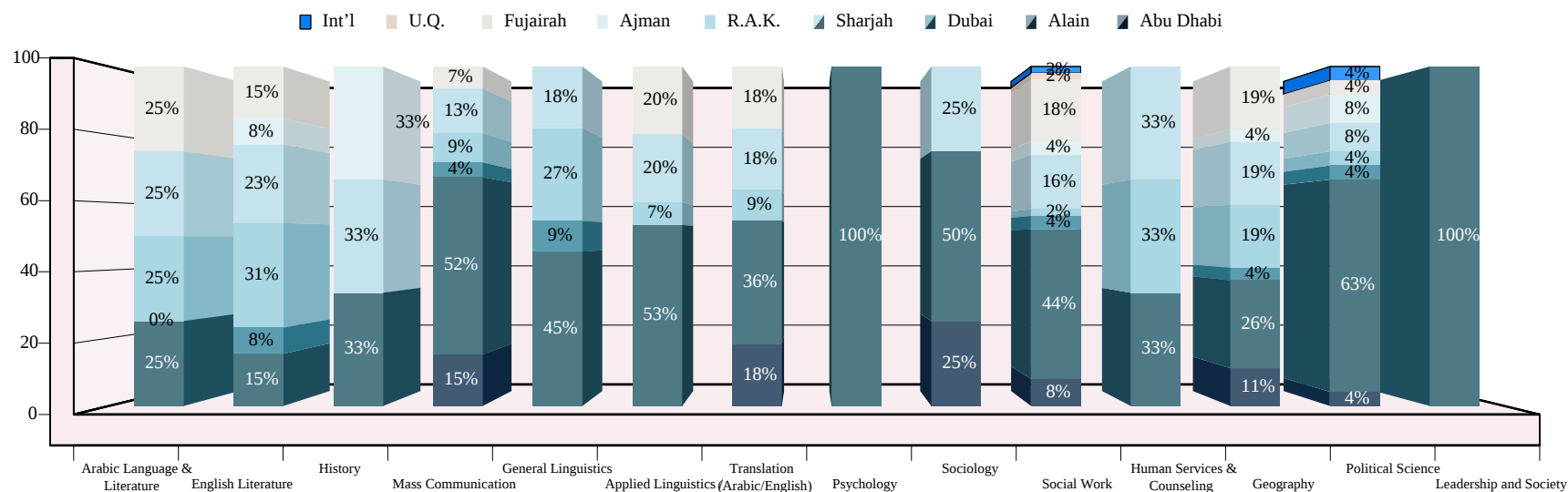


% Distribution of Graduates by Major / Nationality Groups

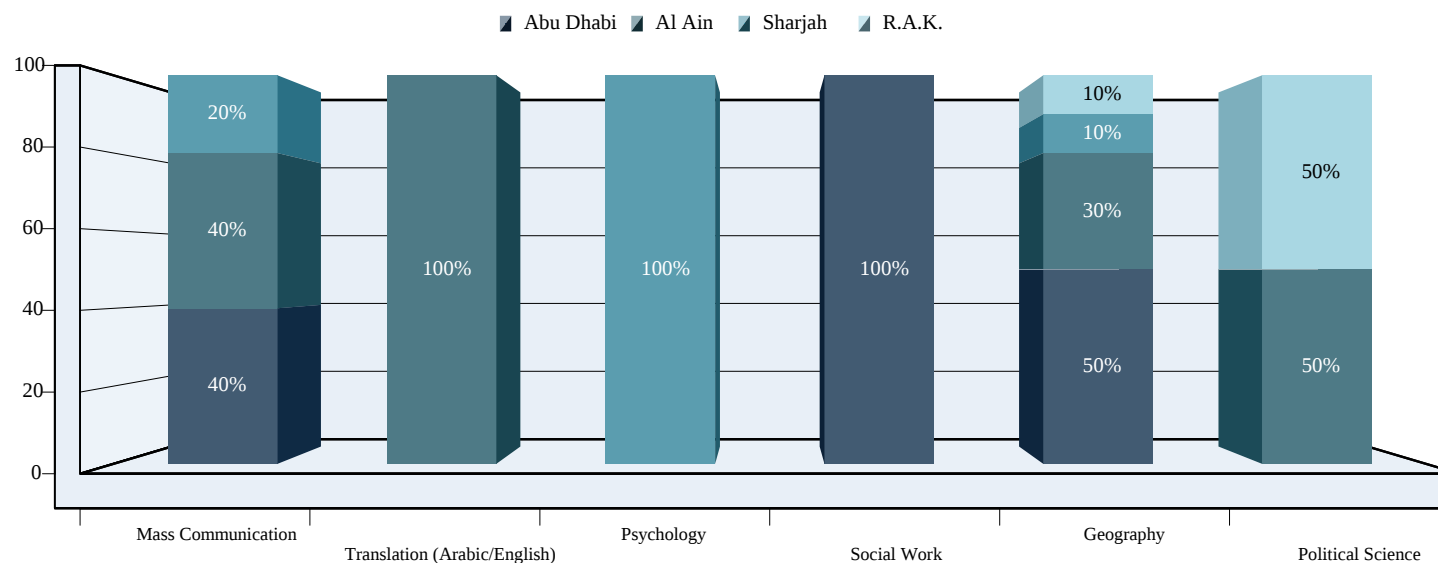

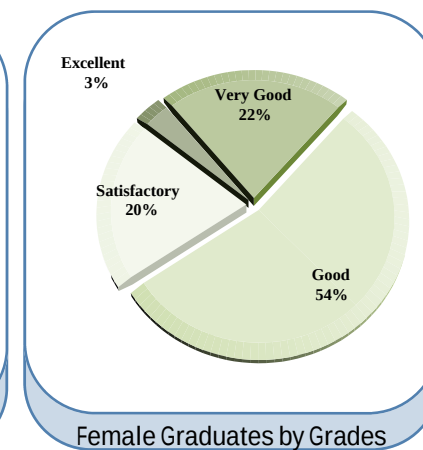
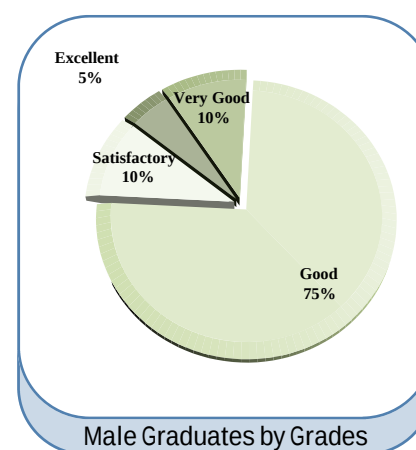
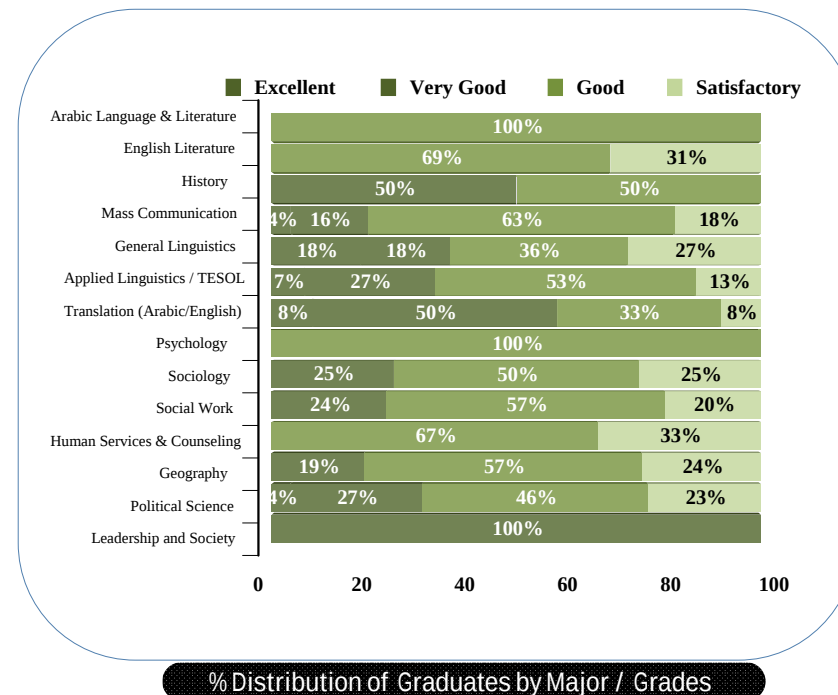


% Distribution of Male Student Graduates

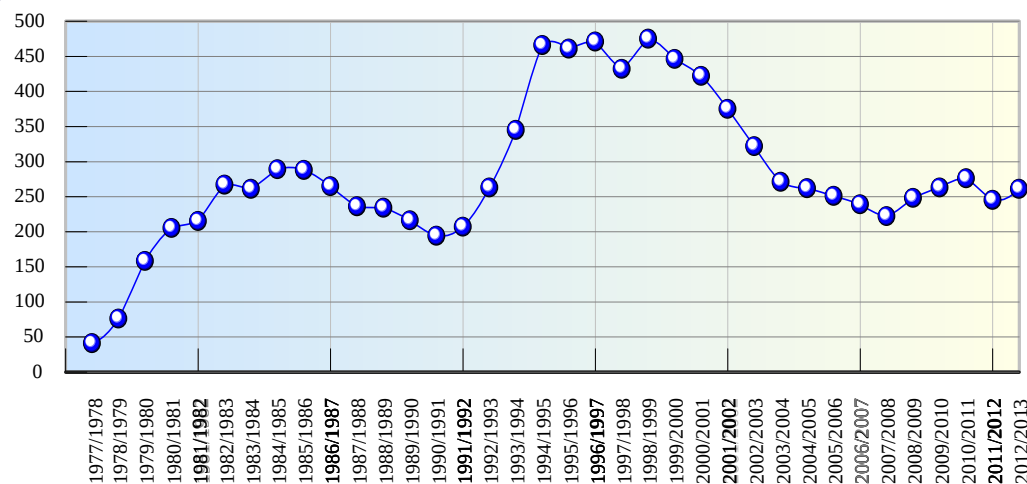


% Distribution of Expected Graduates by Major / Nationality Groups

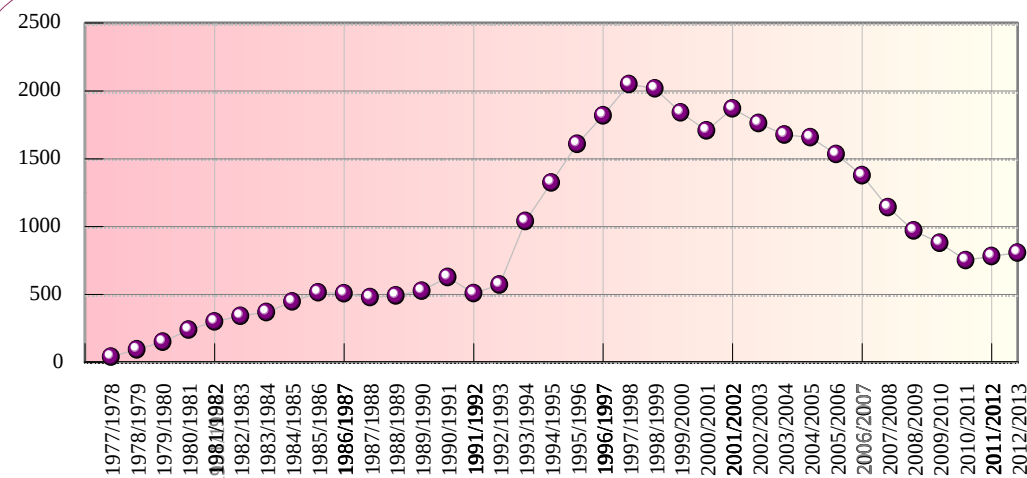

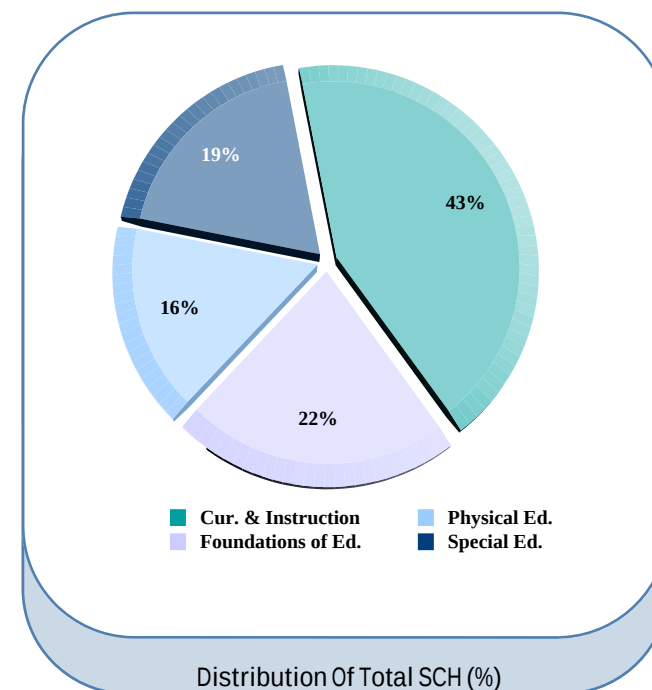
% Distribution of Female Registered by Major / Student Level

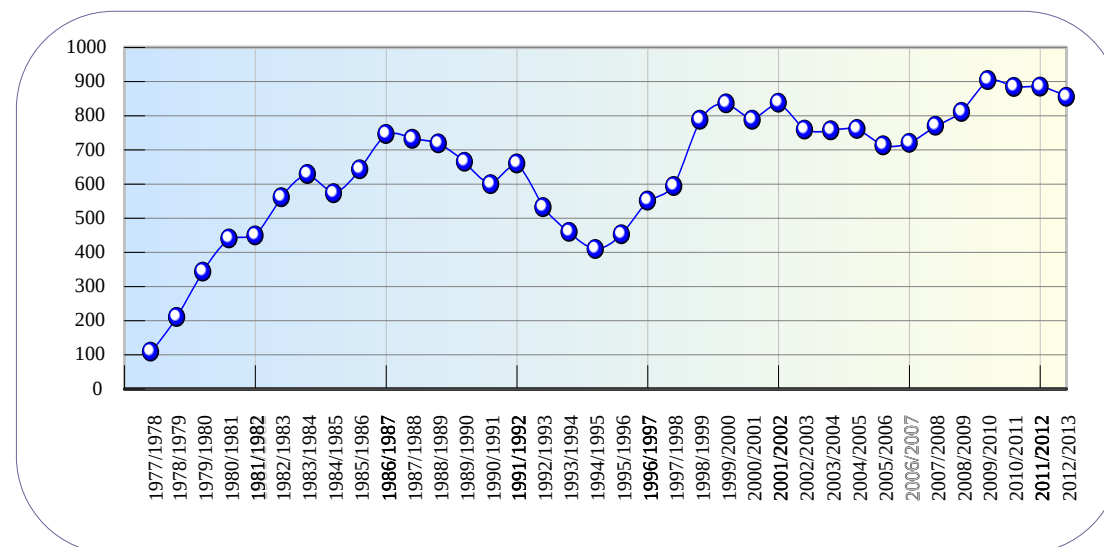


% Distribution of Expected Graduates by Major / Nationality groups

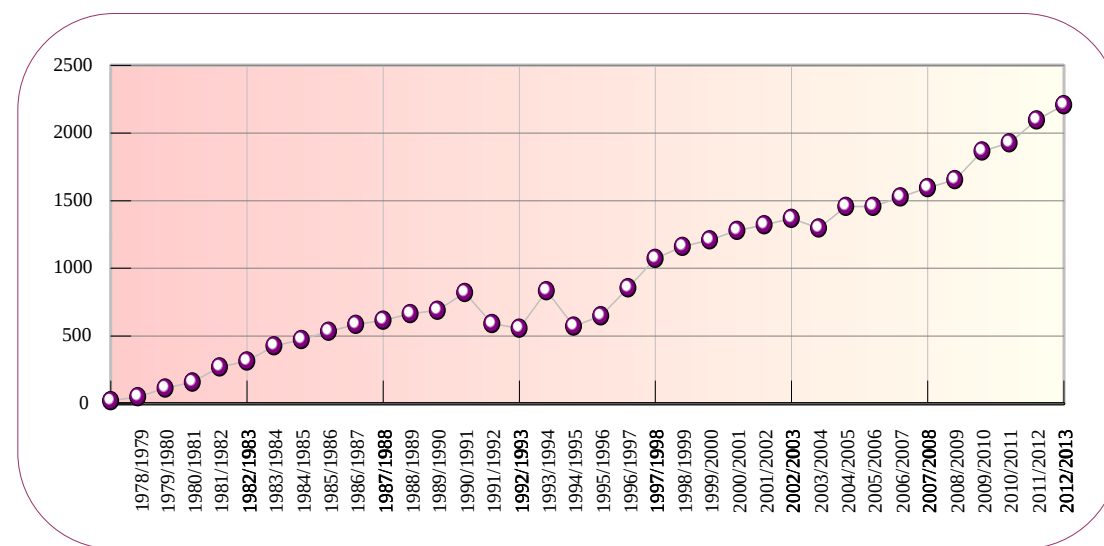

% Distribution of Male Registered

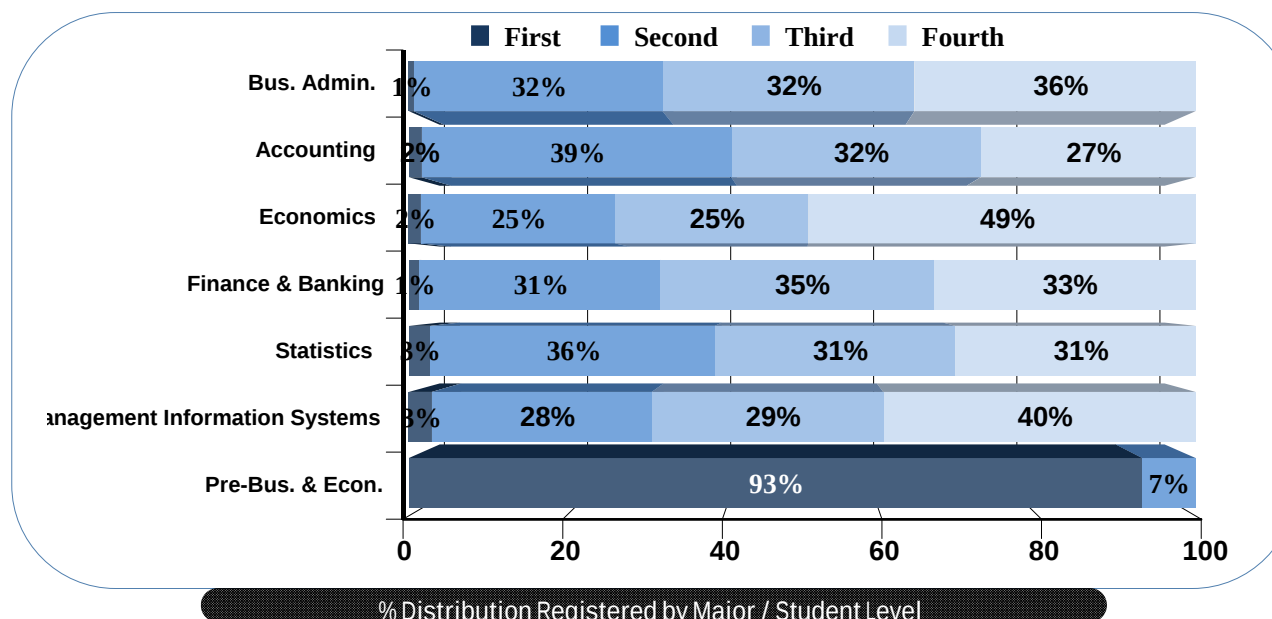

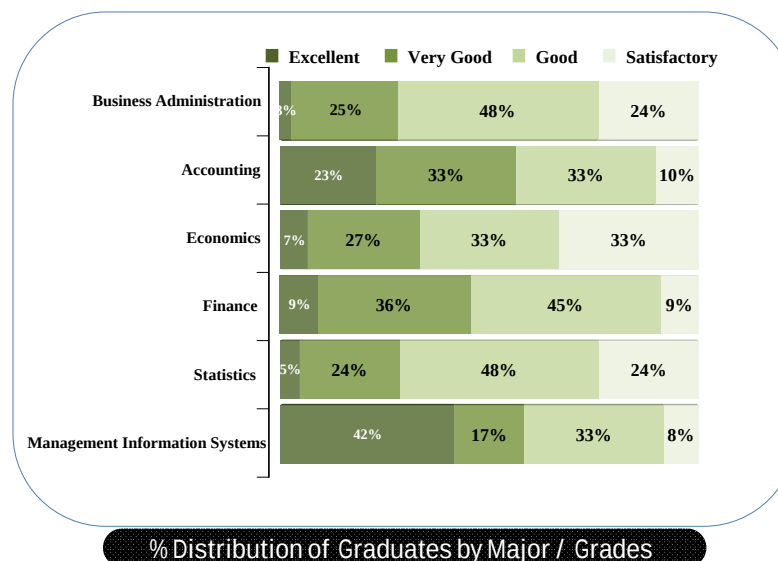
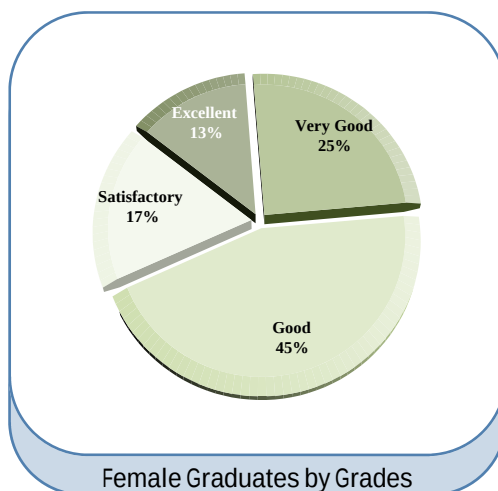
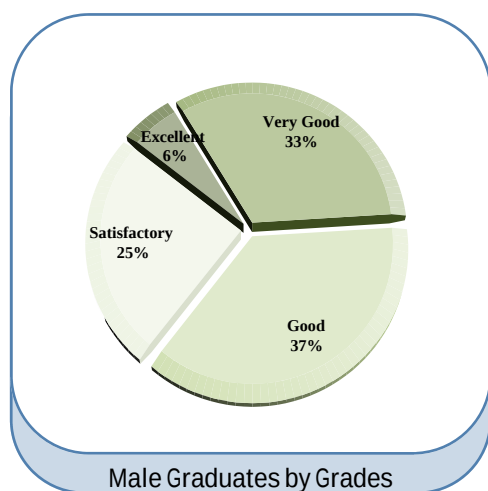
% Distribution of Male Student Graduates

% Distribution of Male Student Graduates

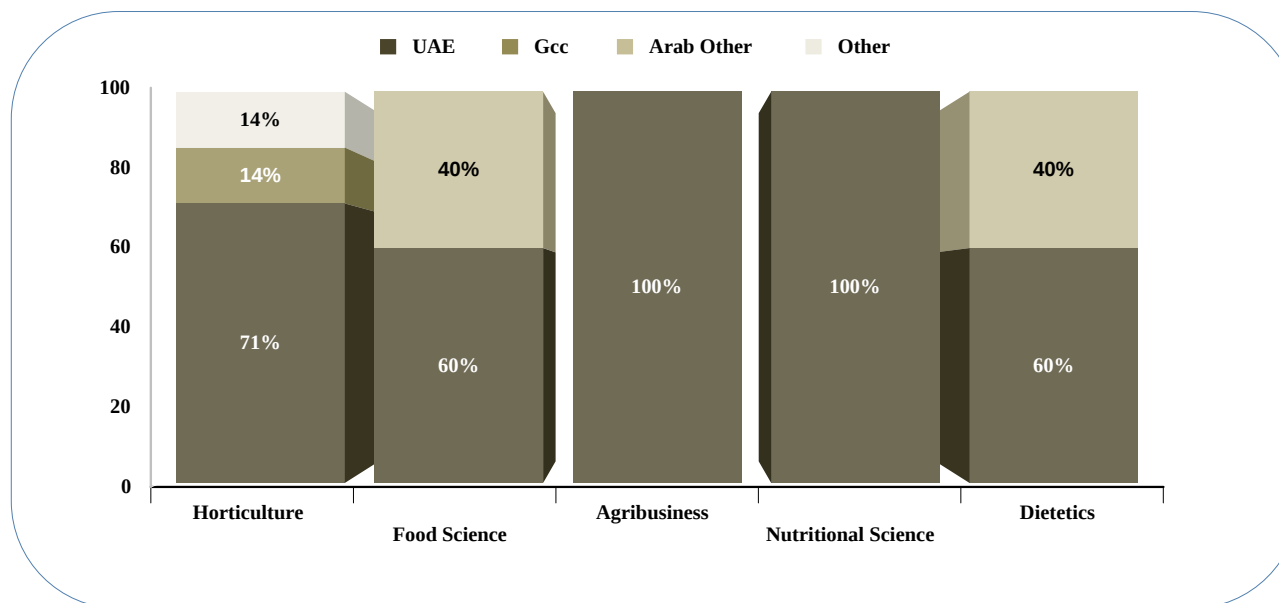

% Distribution of Male Registered

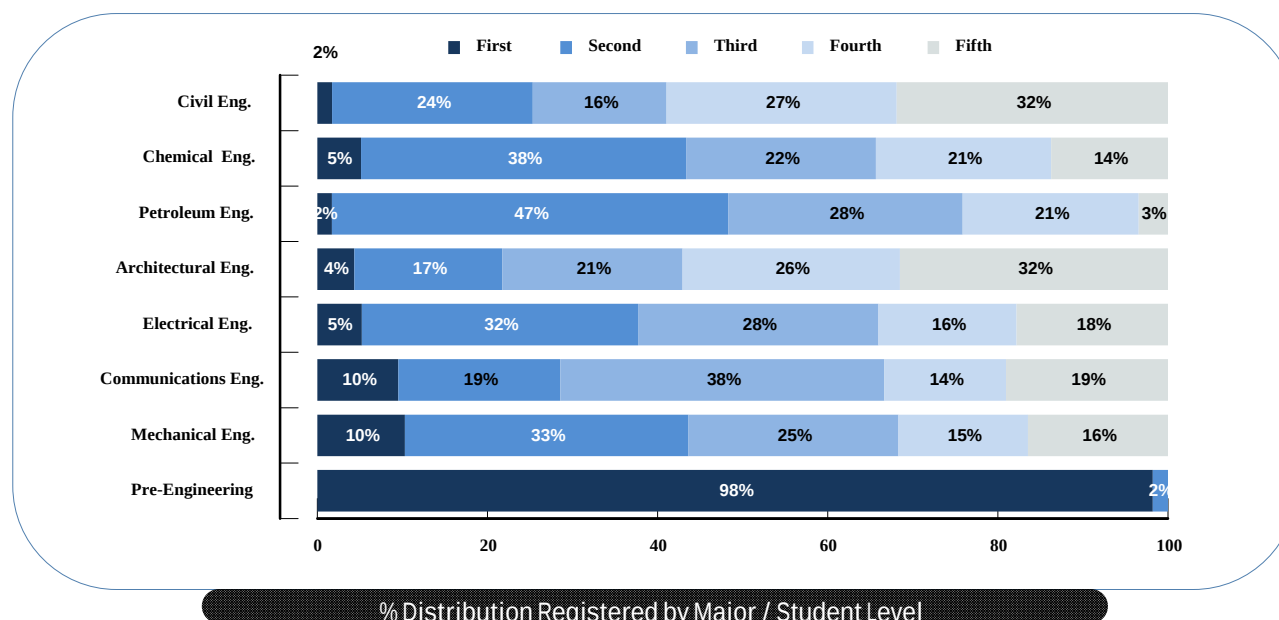

% Distribution of Male Registered

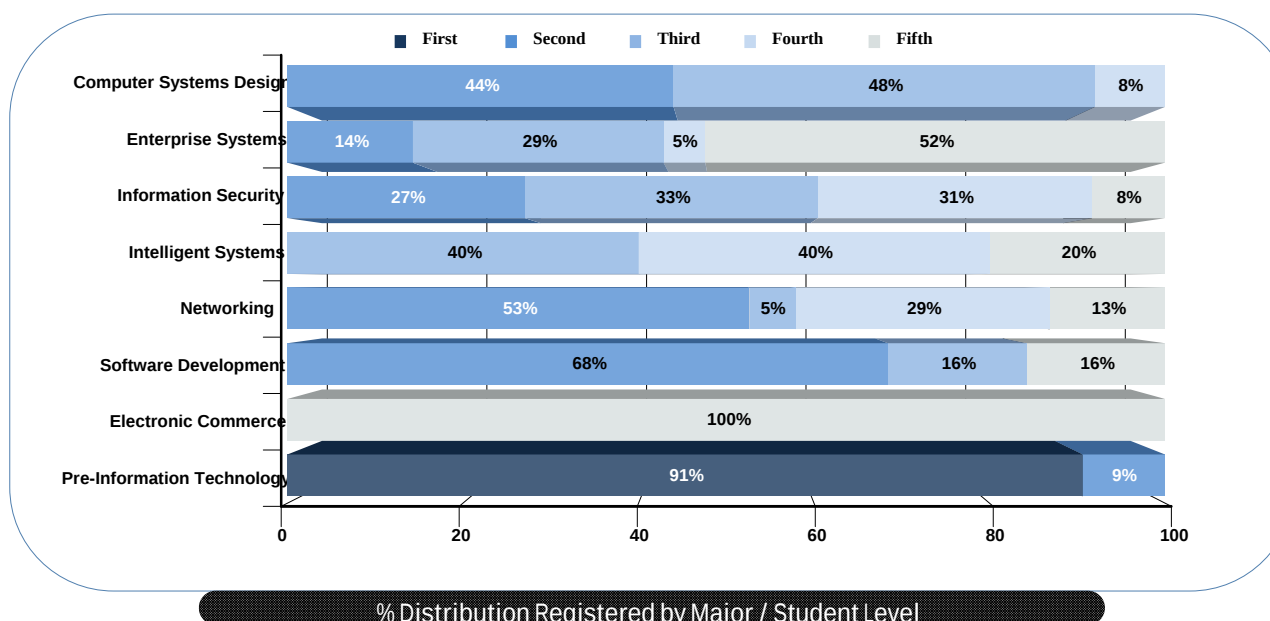

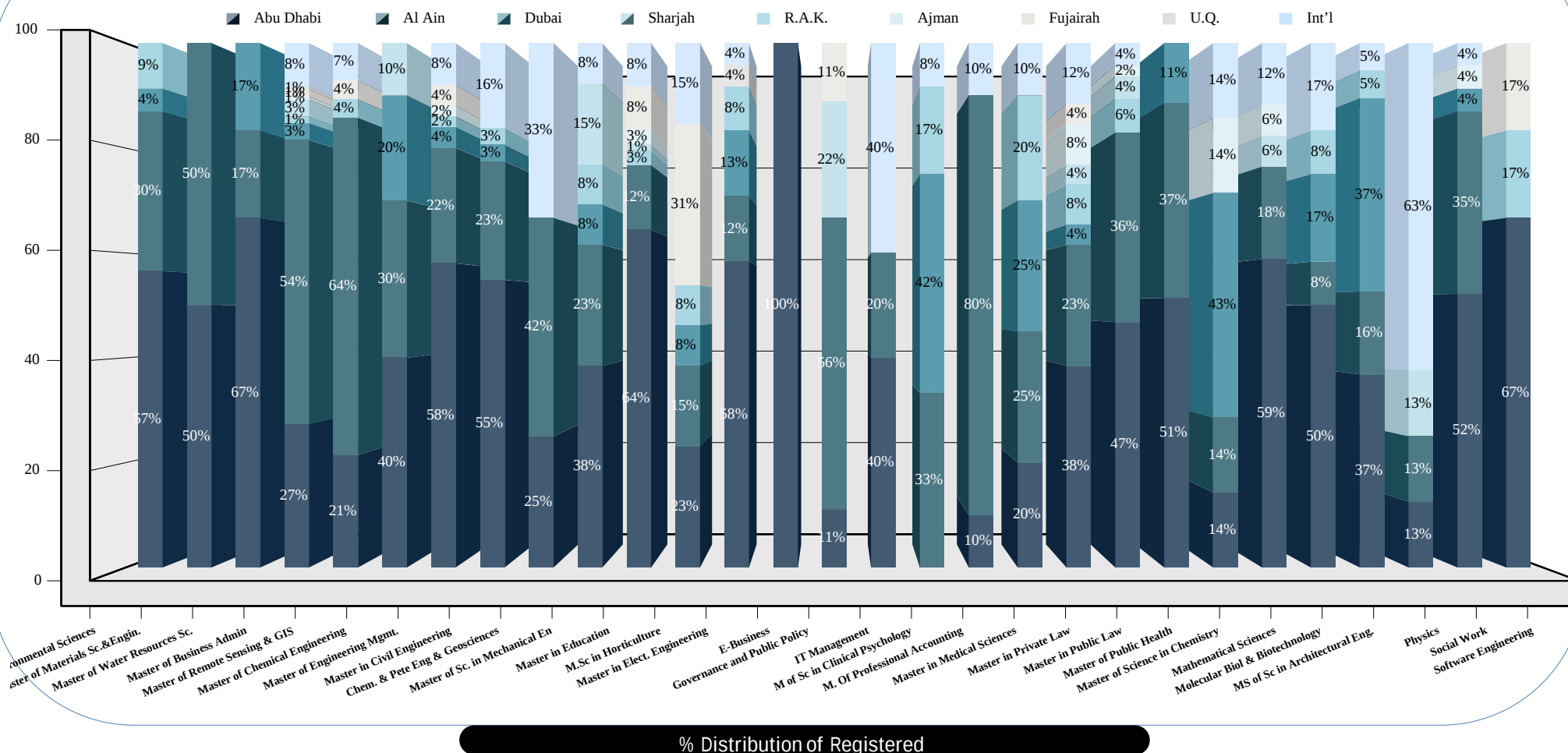
% Distribution of Registered by Major / Nationality Groups

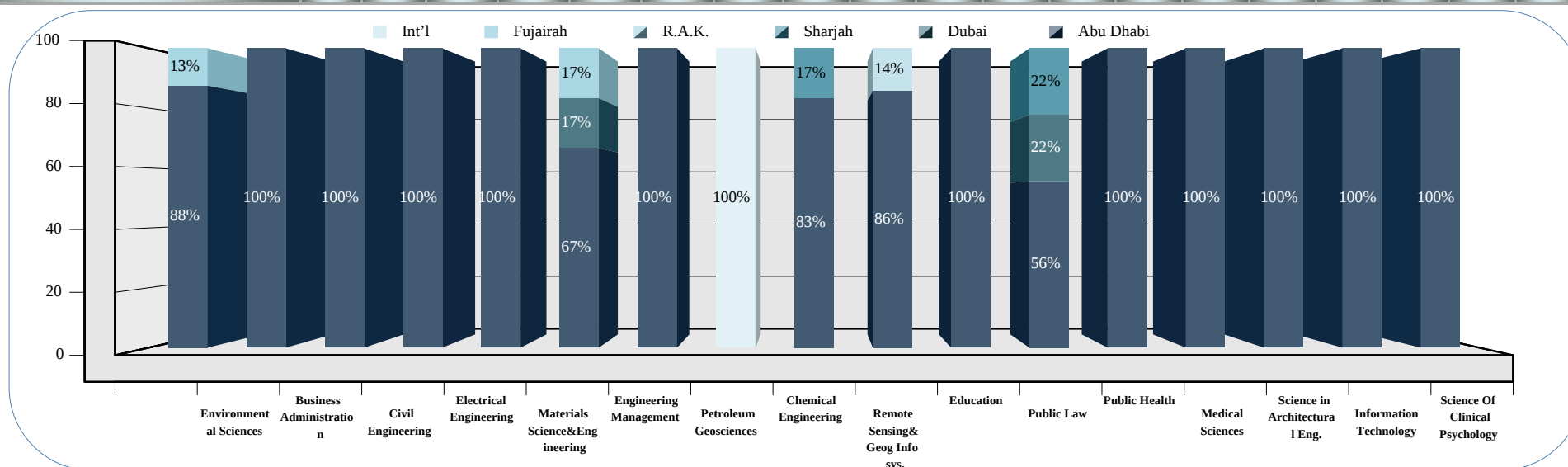


% Distribution of Graduates by Major / Grades

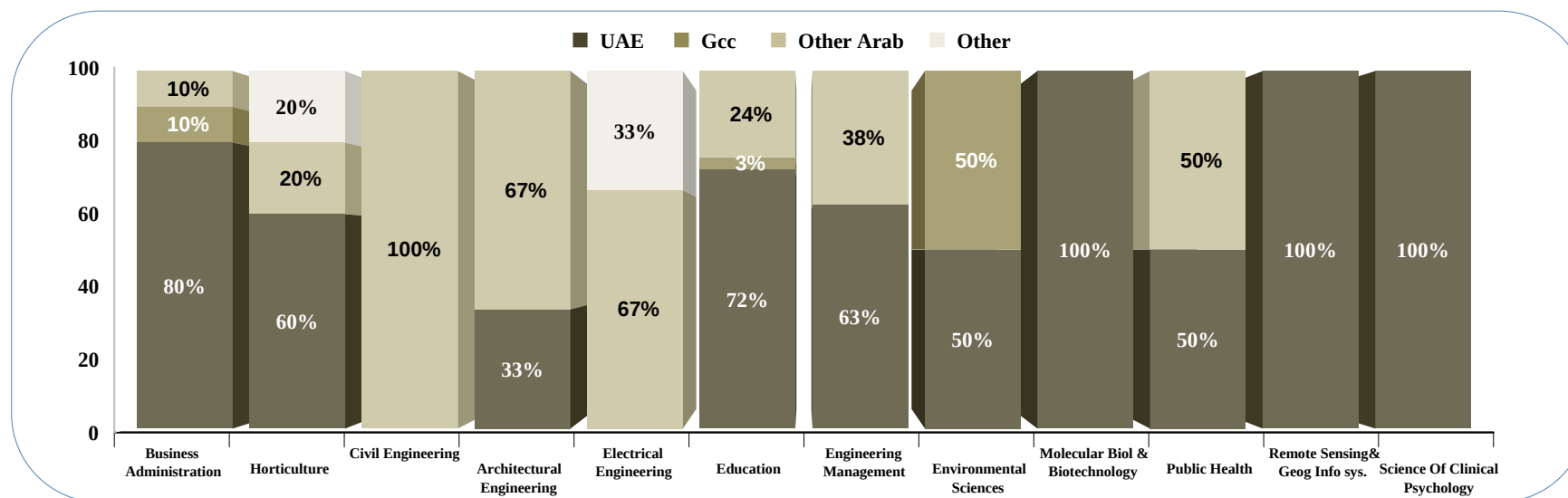
