**% Distribution of Male Admission by College / Place Of Residence**



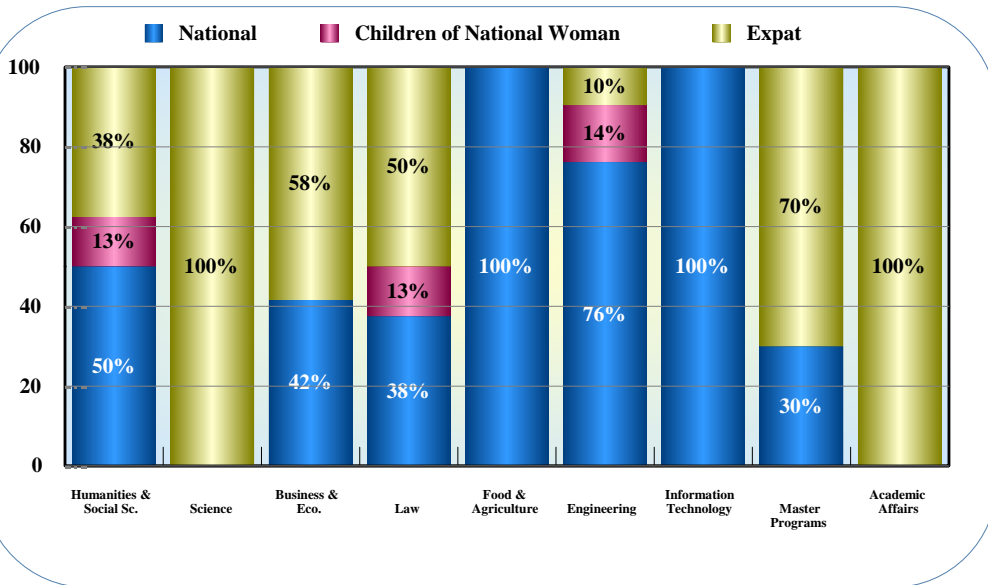
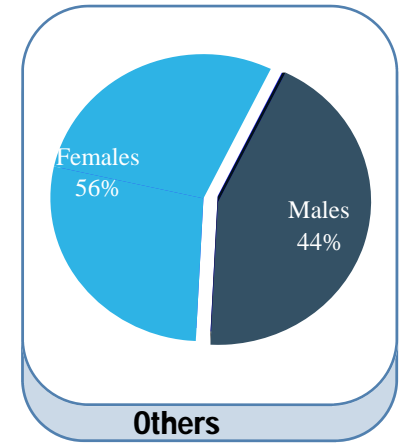
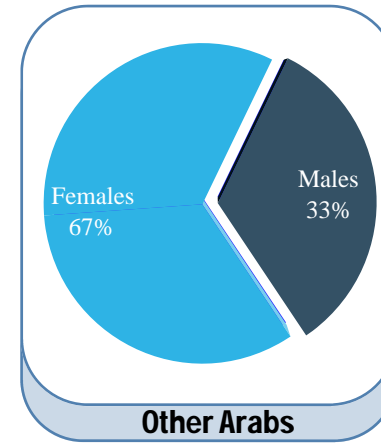
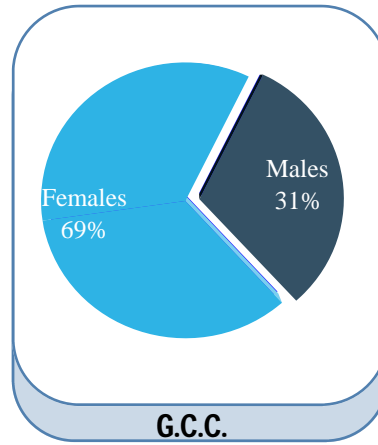
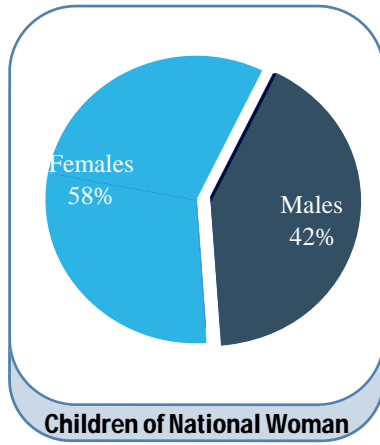
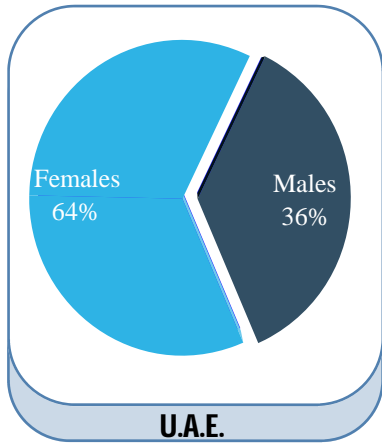

**% Distribution of Female Students by College / Nationality**





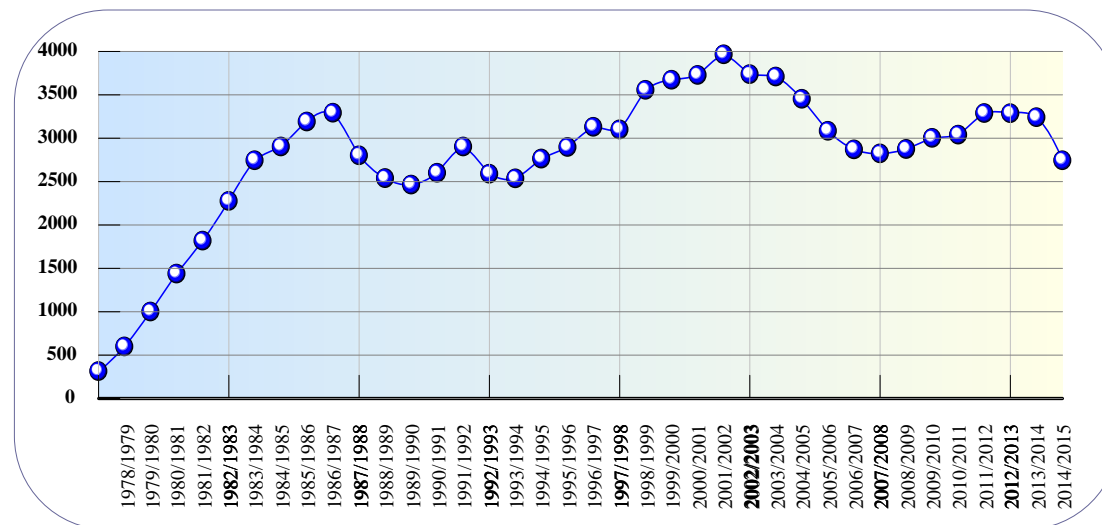

Registered Students by Gender / Nationality Groups



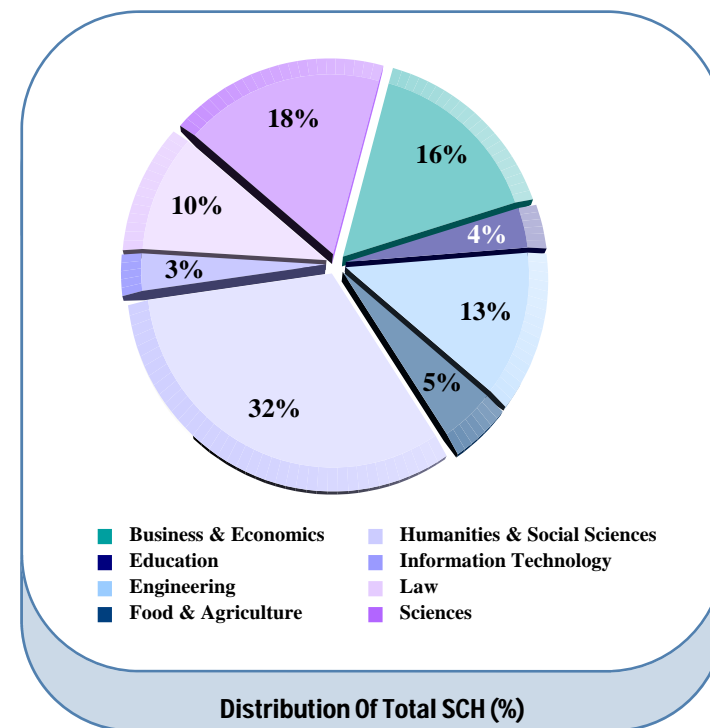
% Distribution of Male Registered by College / Nationality

% Distribution of Male Graduates by College / Nationality

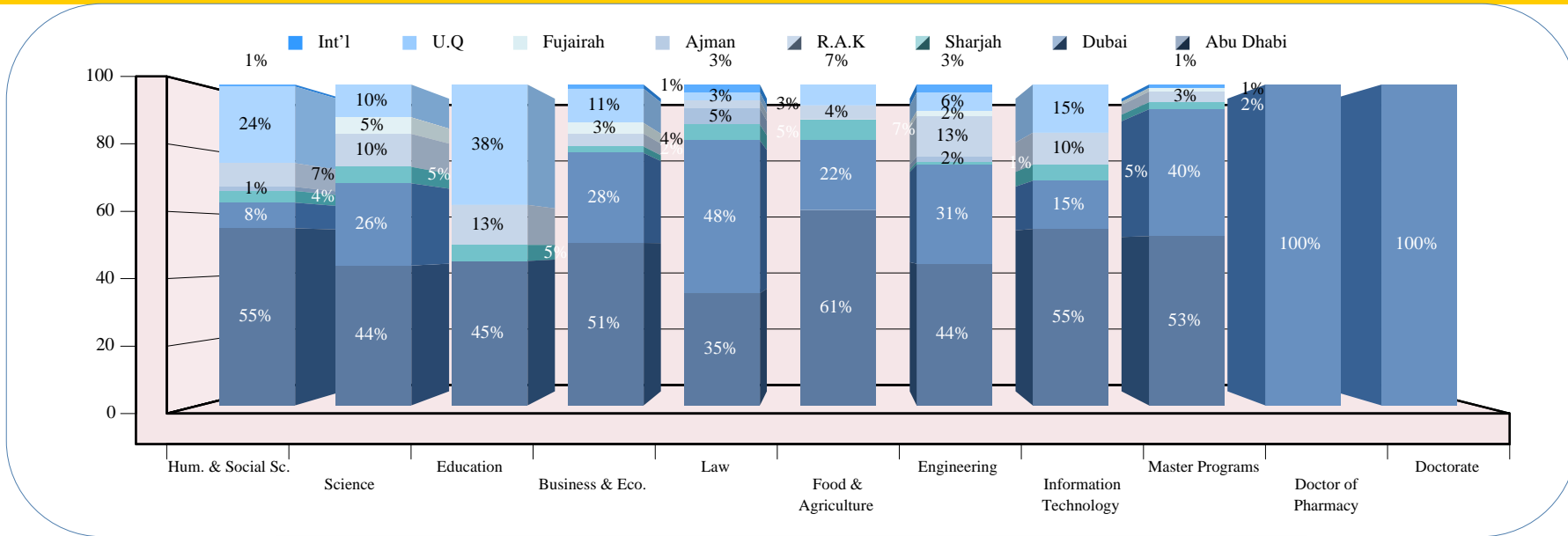


% Distribution of Female Graduates by College / Nationality

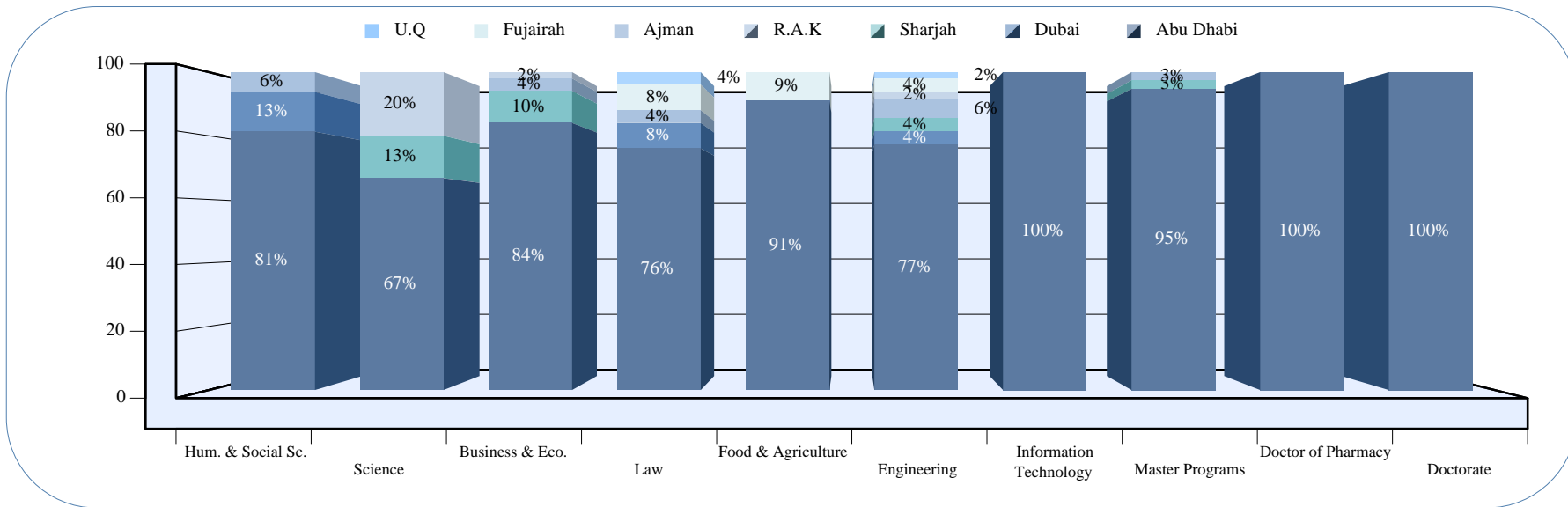

**% Distribution of Female Graduates by College / Place Of Residence**

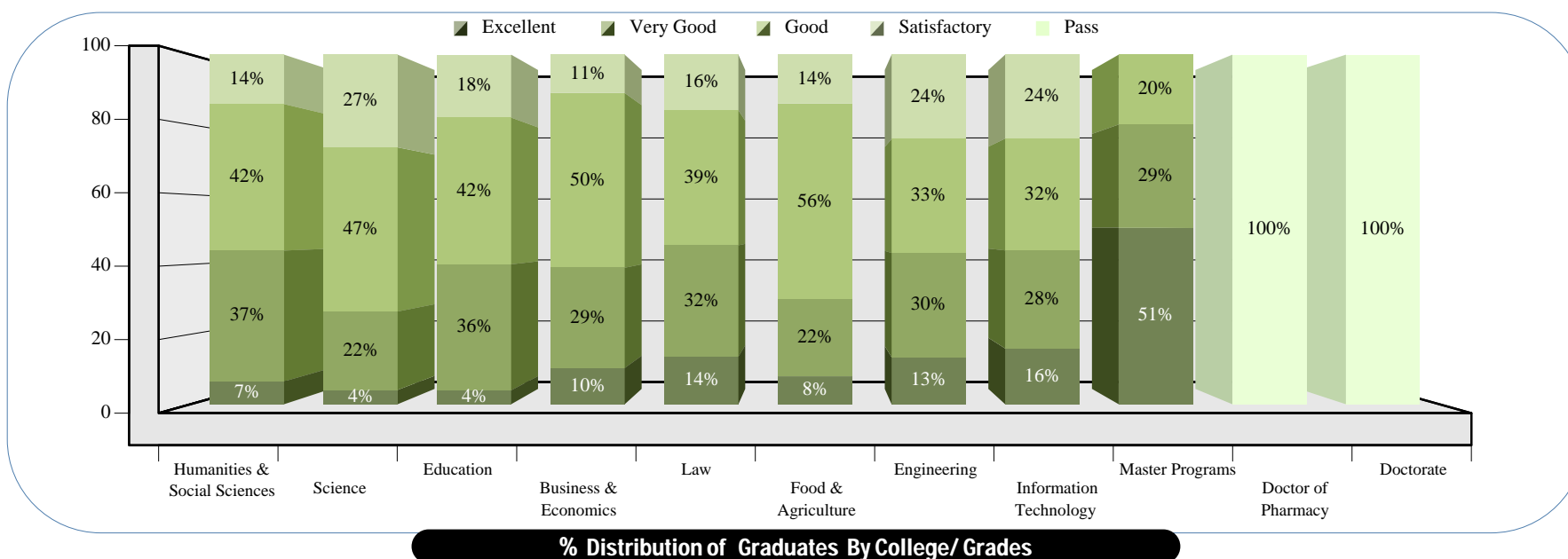


**% Distribution of Male Graduates by College / Place Of Residence**

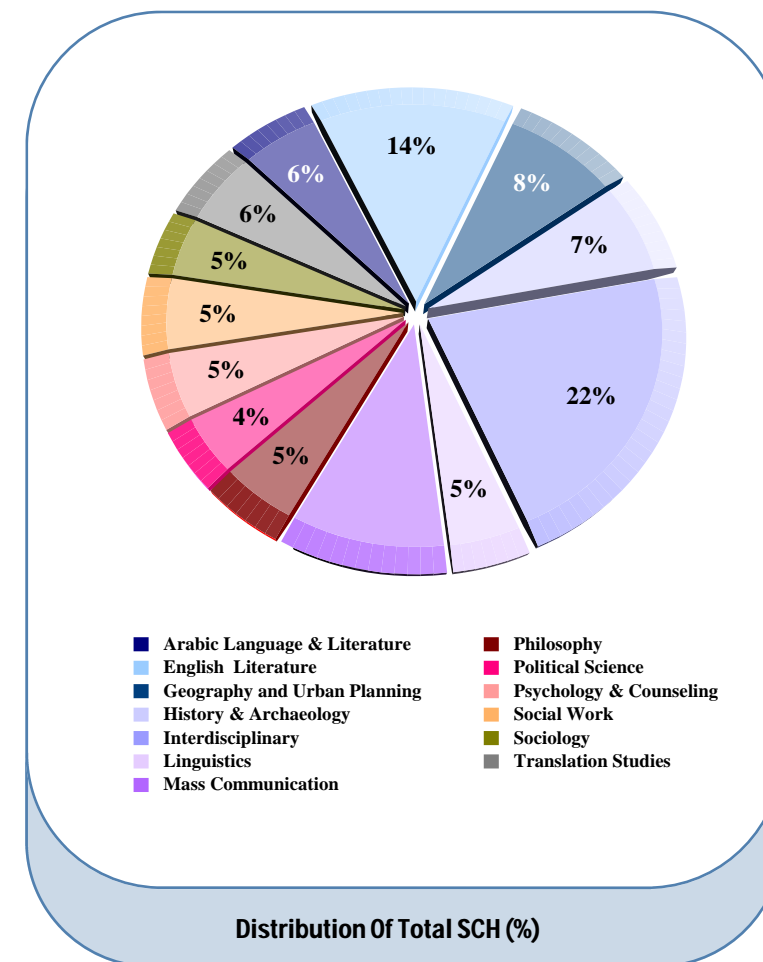
**% Distribution of Male Registered**

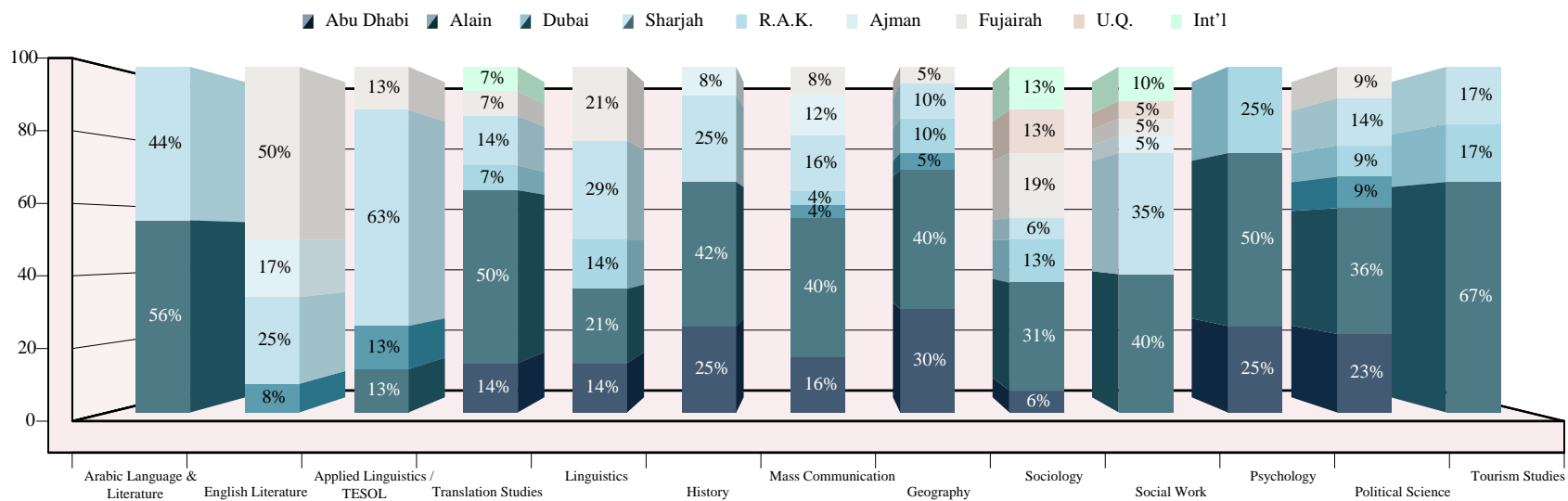
% Distribution of Graduates by Major / Nationality Groups



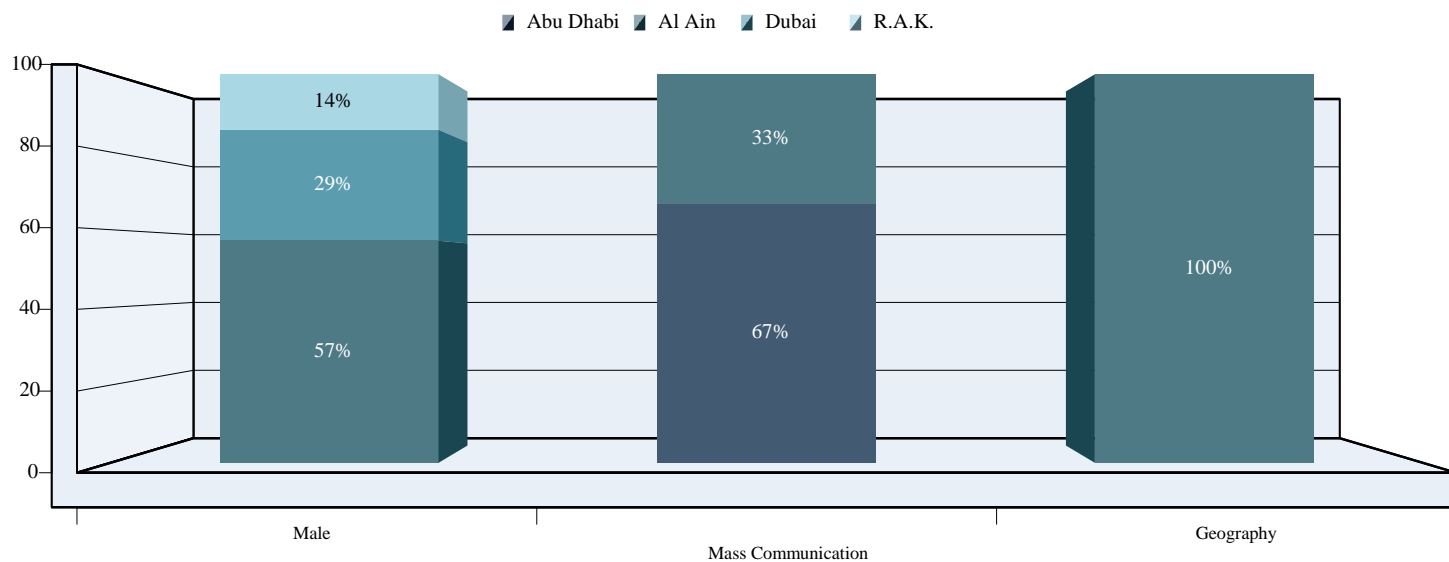

**% Distribution of Female Student Graduates**

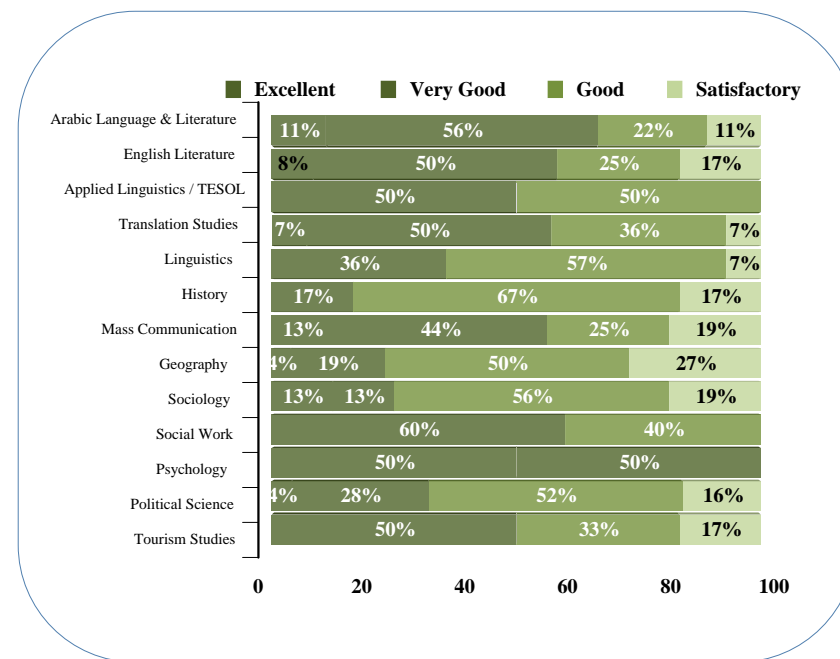

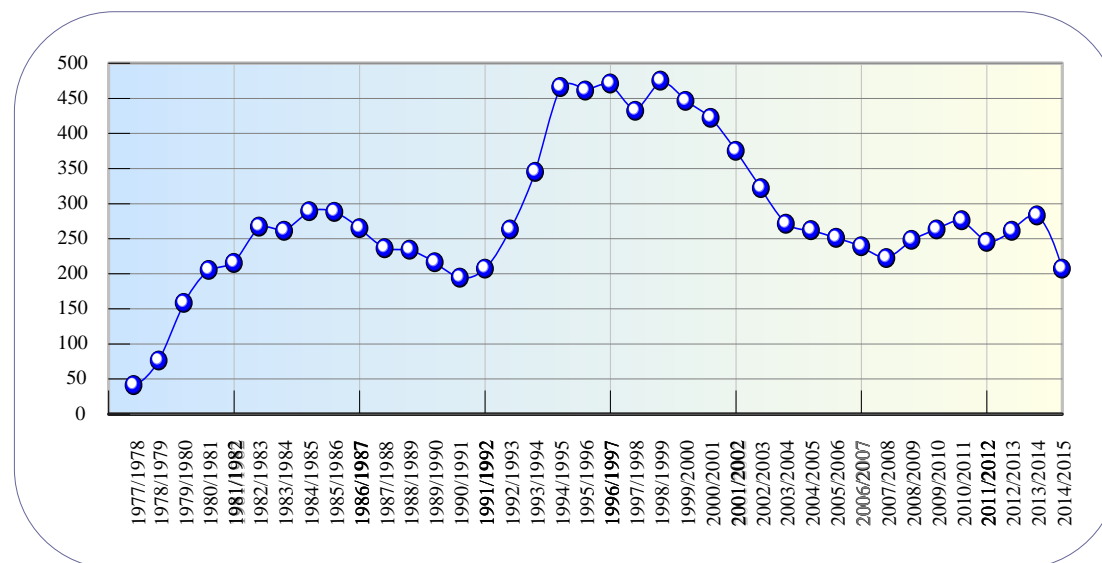


% Distribution of Expected Graduates by Major / Nationality Groups

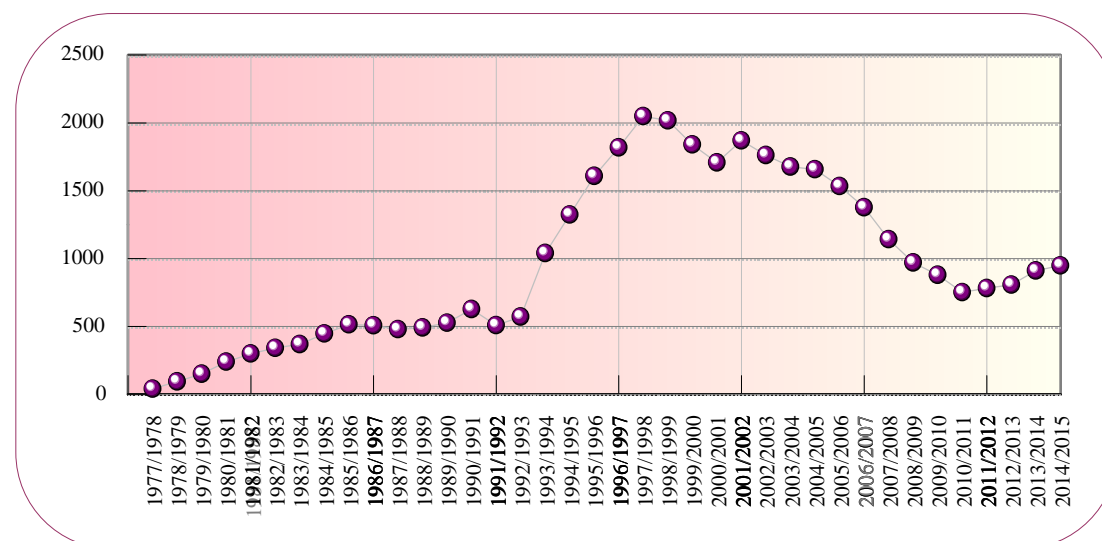

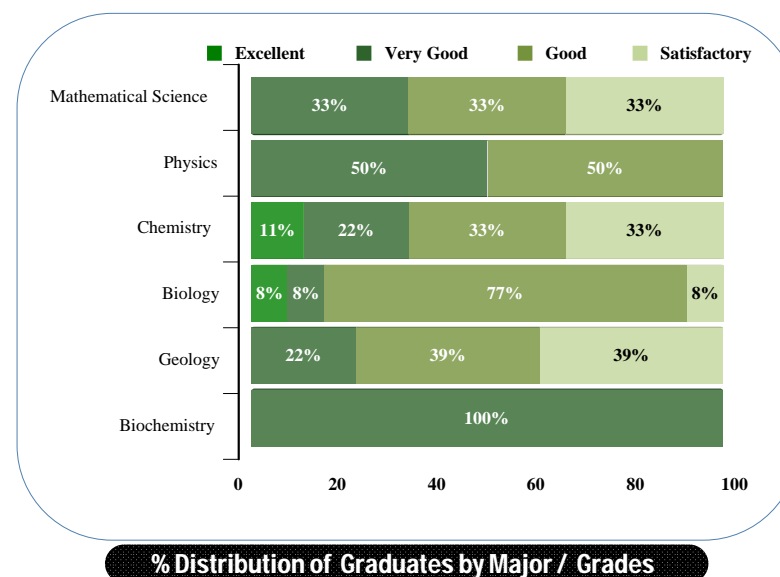
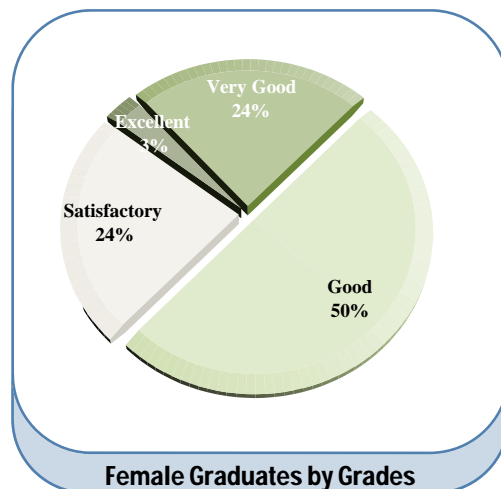
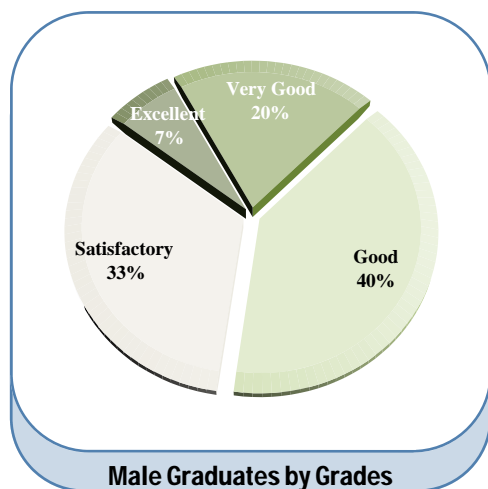
% Distribution of Male Student Graduates

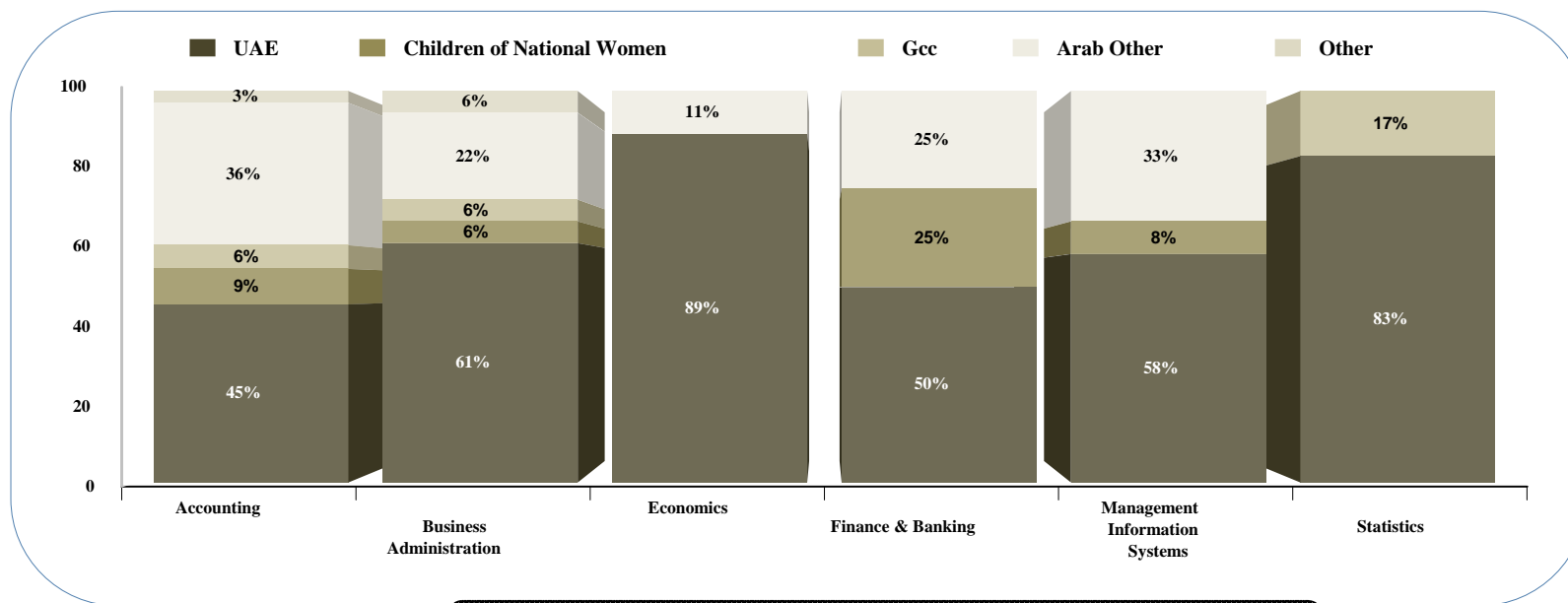


% Distribution of Graduates by Major / Grades

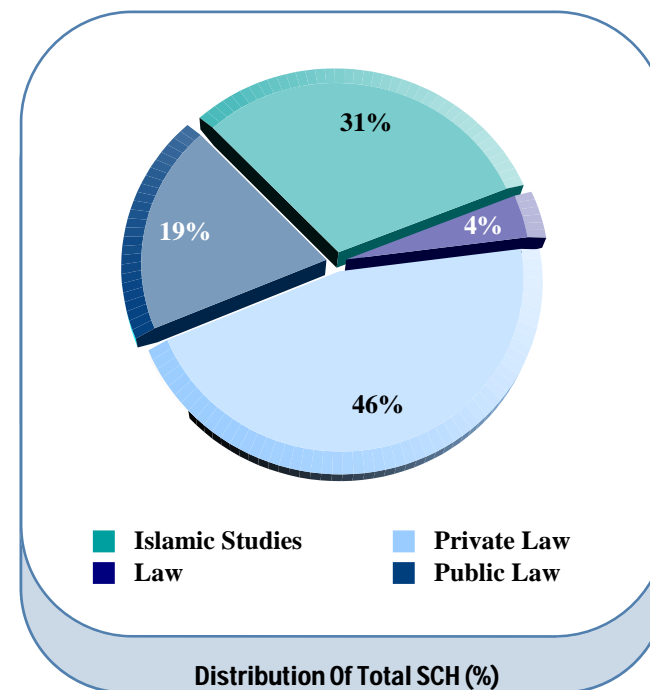
% Distribution of Male Registered

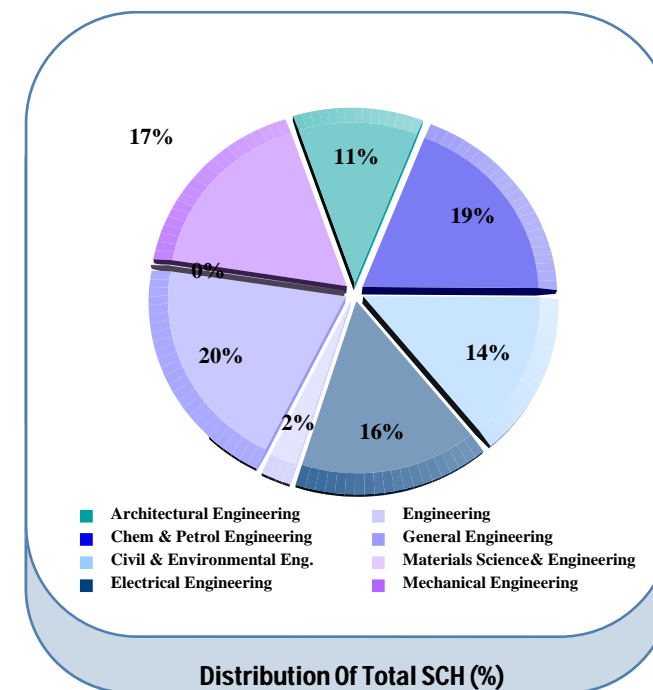
% Distribution of Male Registered

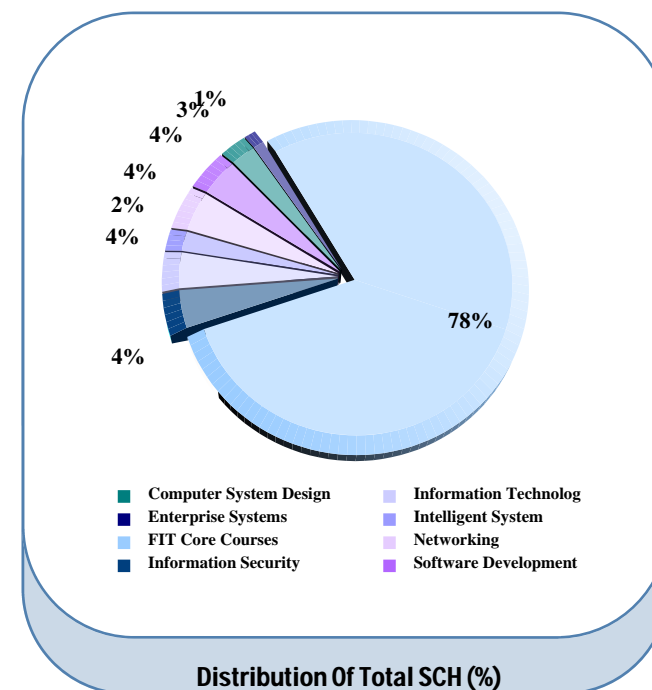
% Distribution of Male Registered

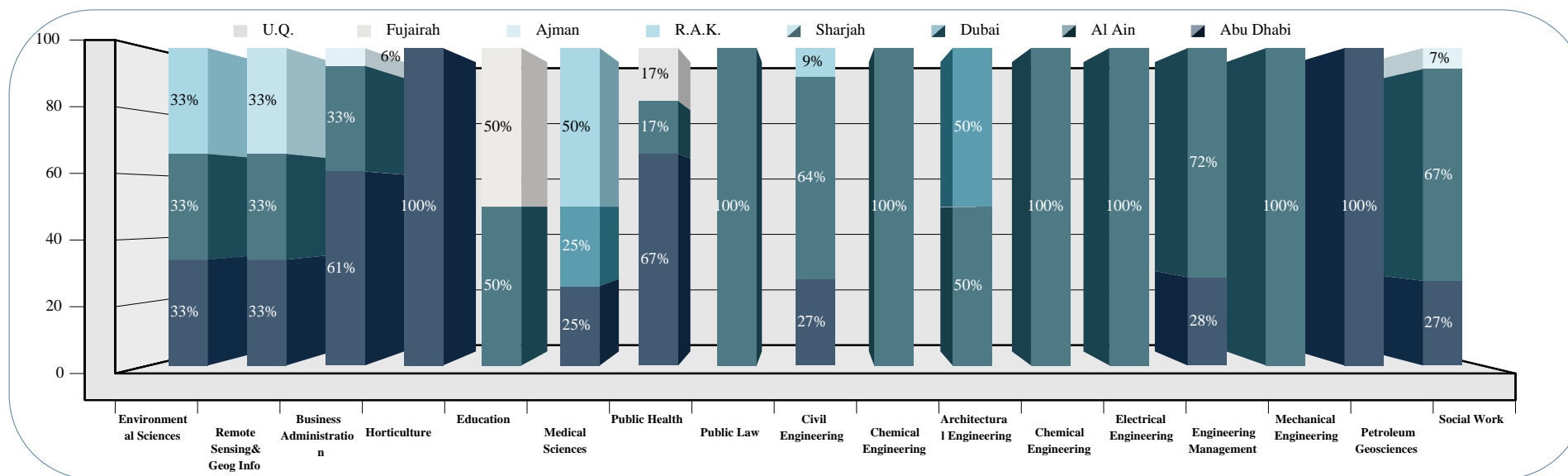
**% Distribution of Graduates by Major/ Nationality Groups**

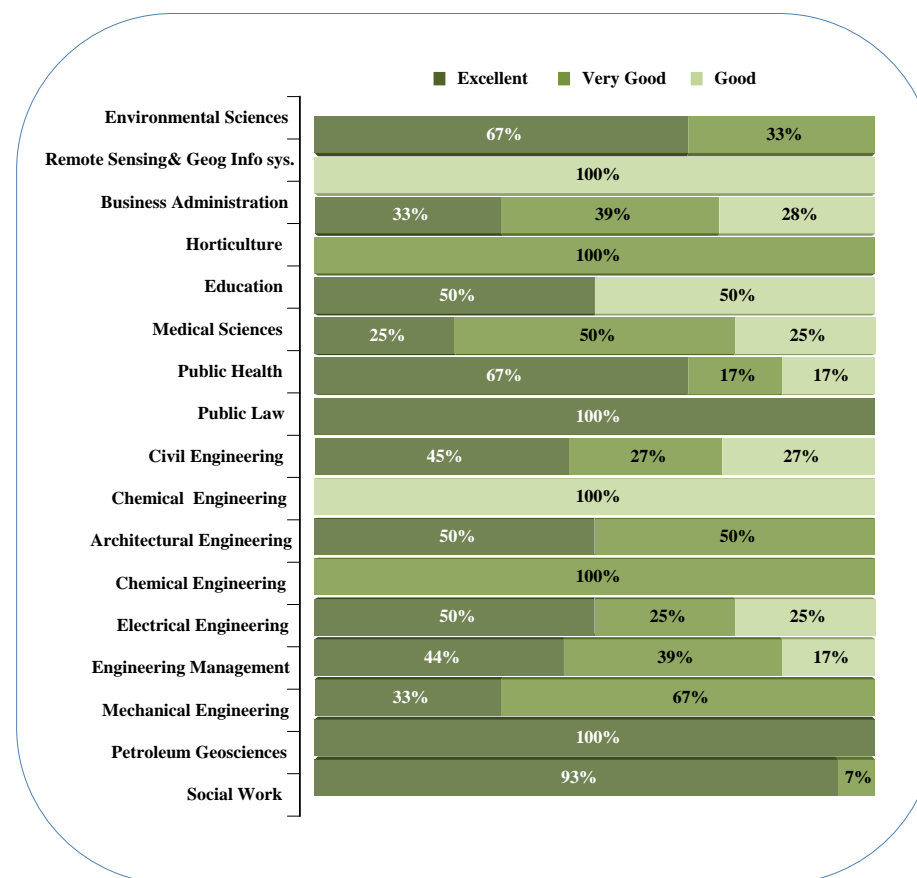

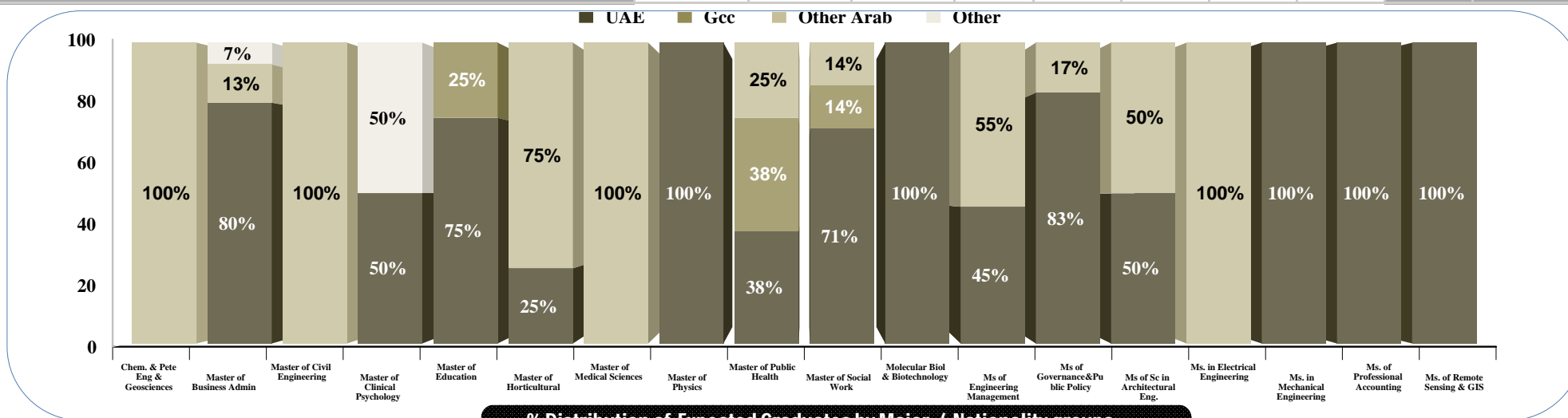


% Distribution of Graduates by Major / Grades

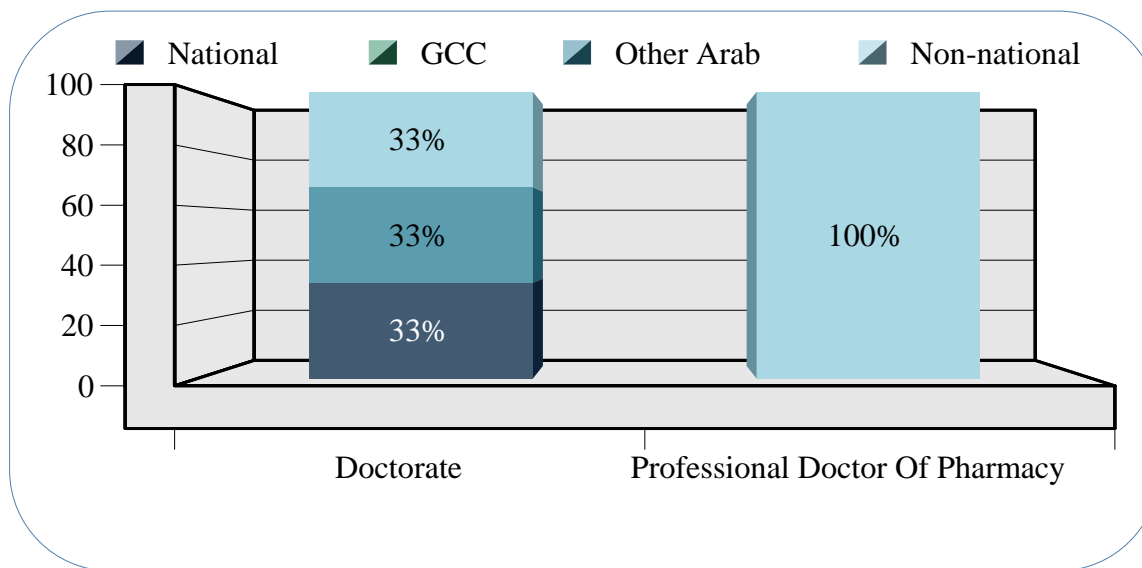
