% Distribution of Male Admission by Faculty / Place Of Residence



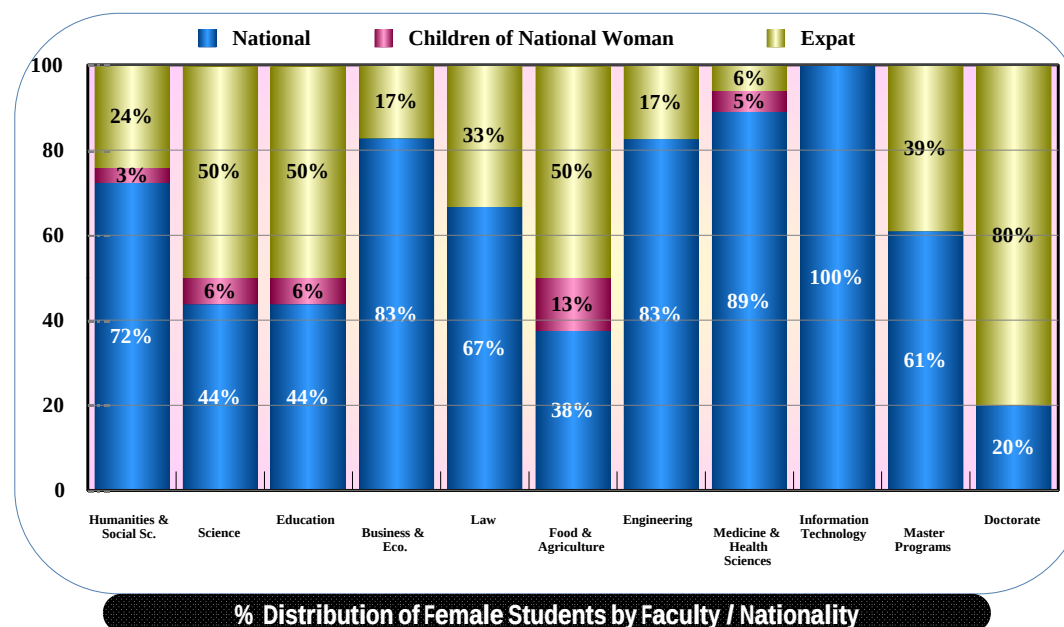
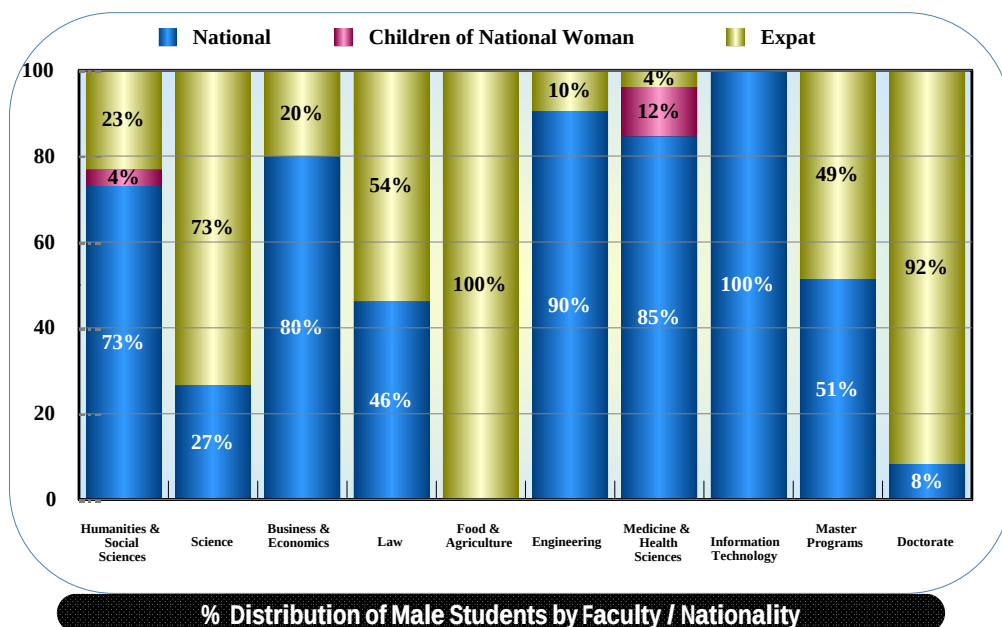
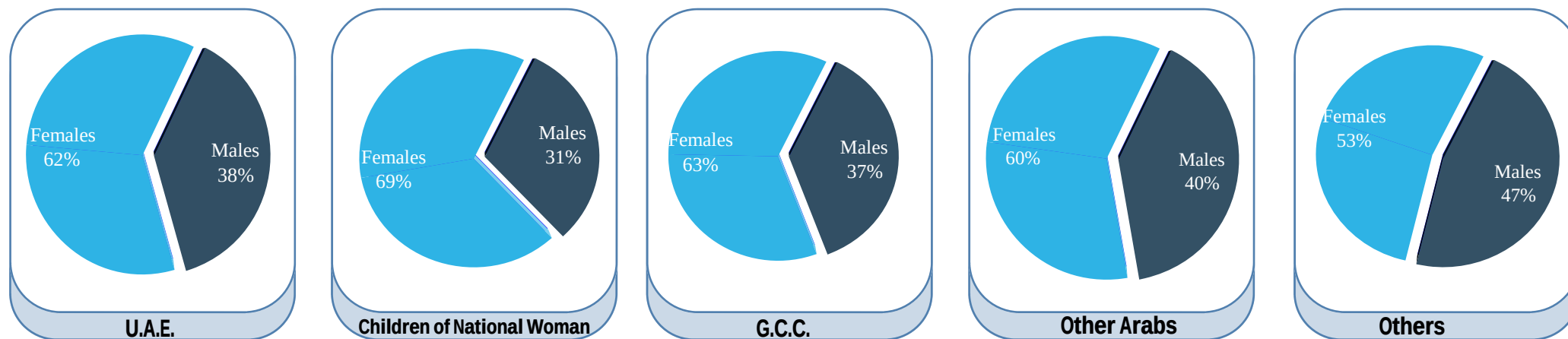

% Distribution of Male Registered by Faculty / Nationality

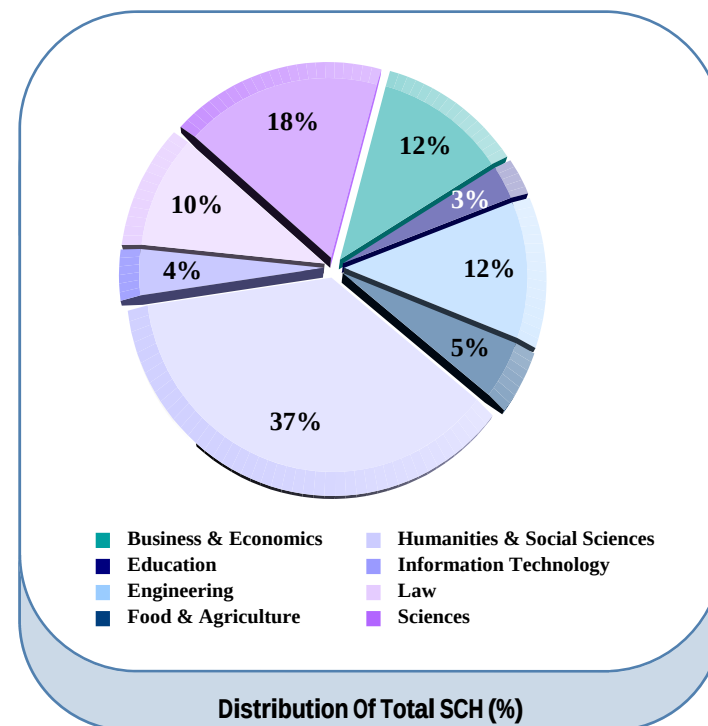


% Distribution of Female Registered by Faculty / Nationality

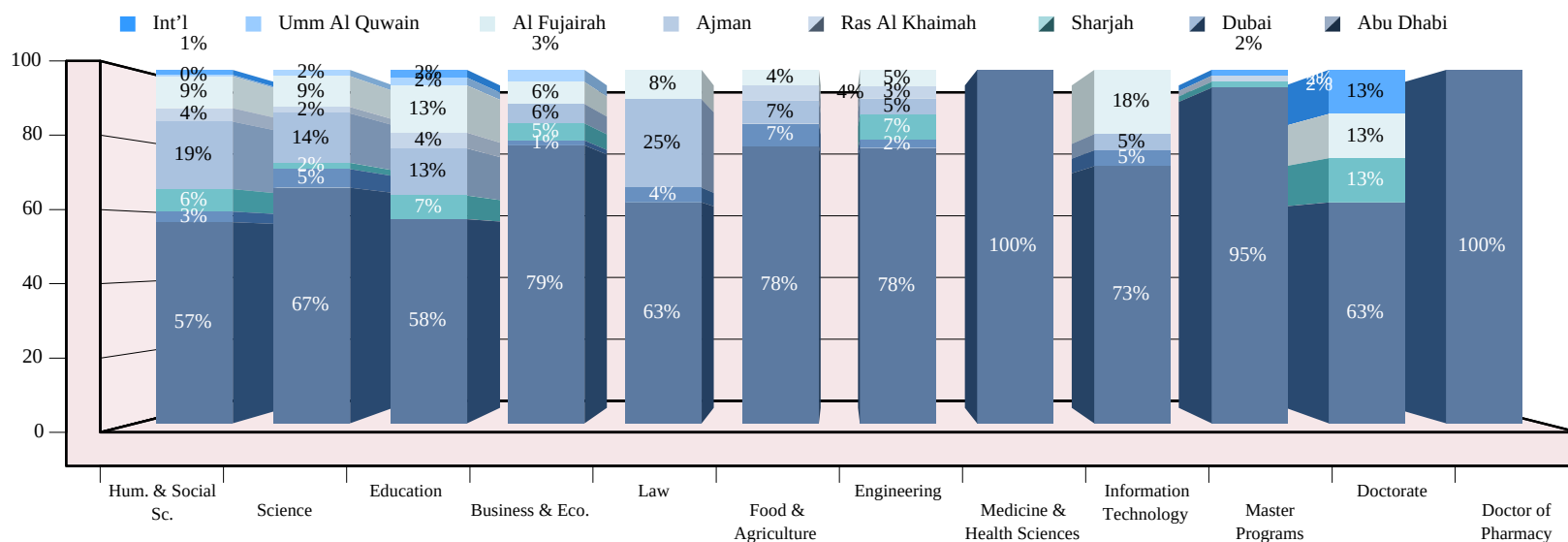
Graduate Students by Gender / Nationality Groups



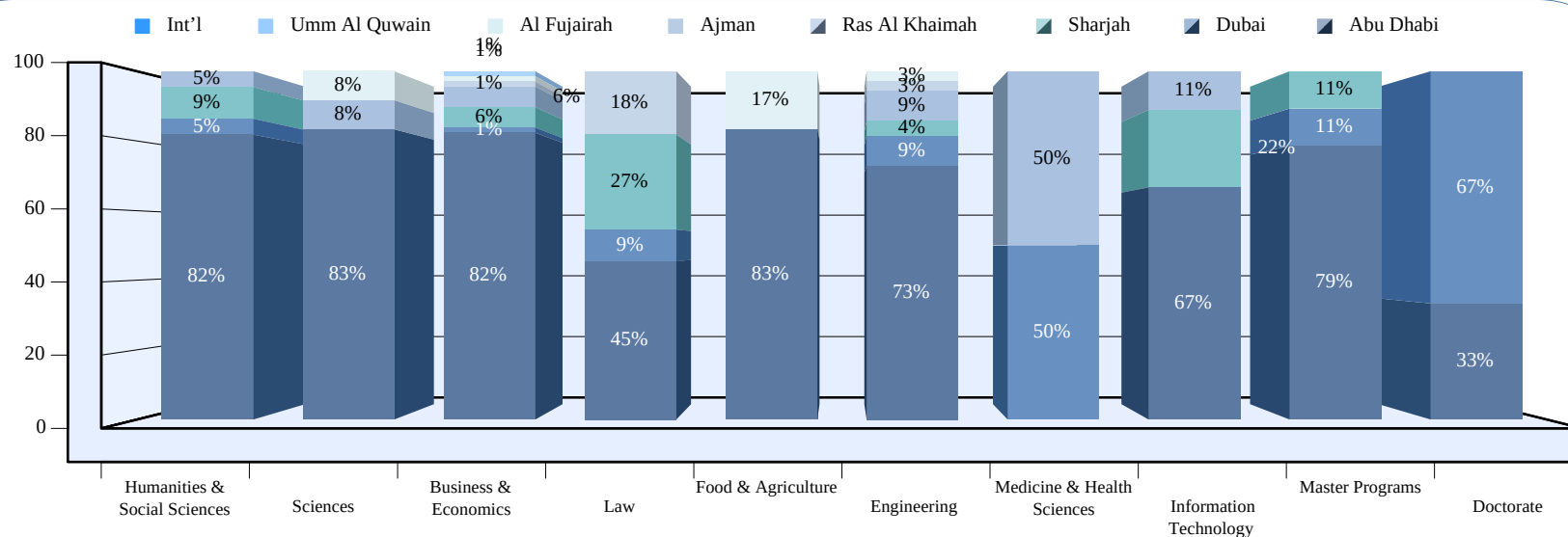

% Distribution of Female Graduates by Faculty/ Place Of Residence

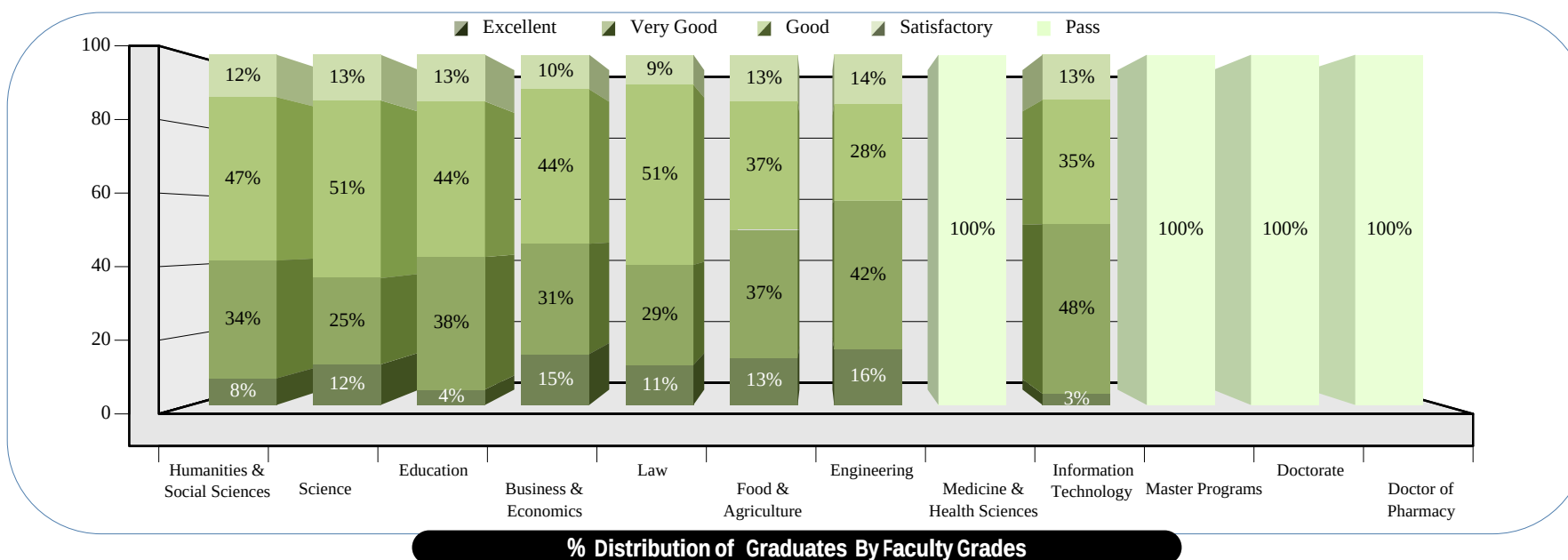


% Distribution of Male Graduates by Faculty / Place Of Residence

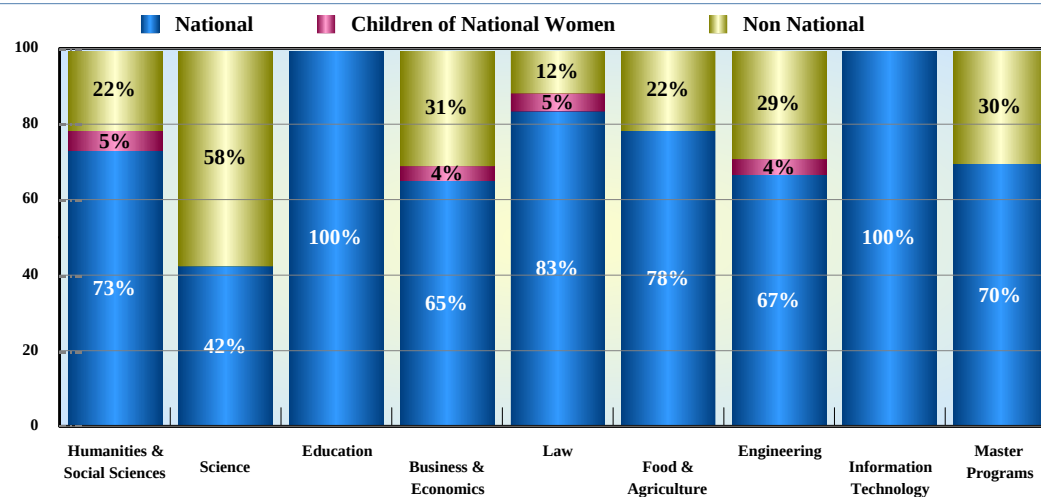

% Distribution of Graduates by Faculty / Nationality

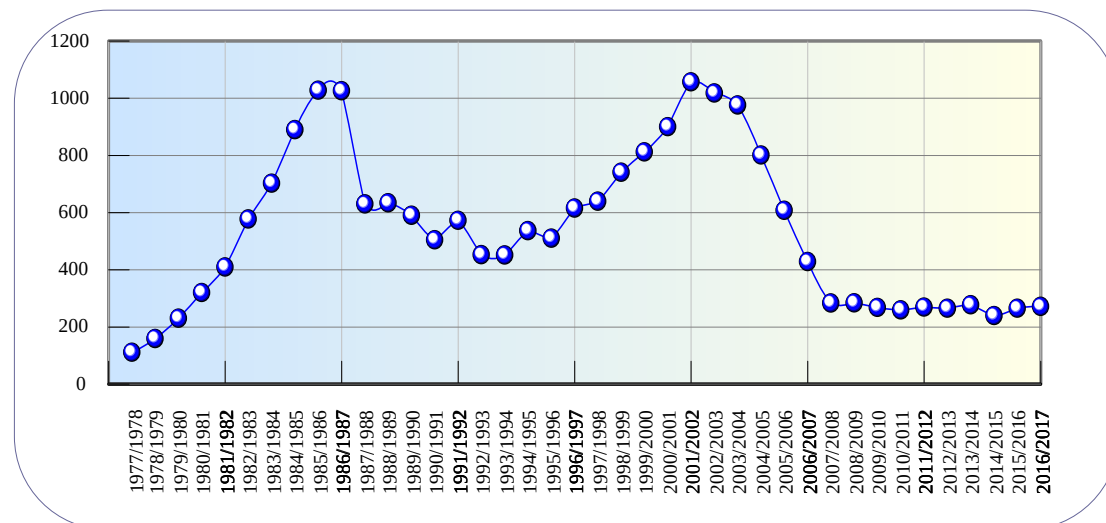

% Distribution of Male Registered

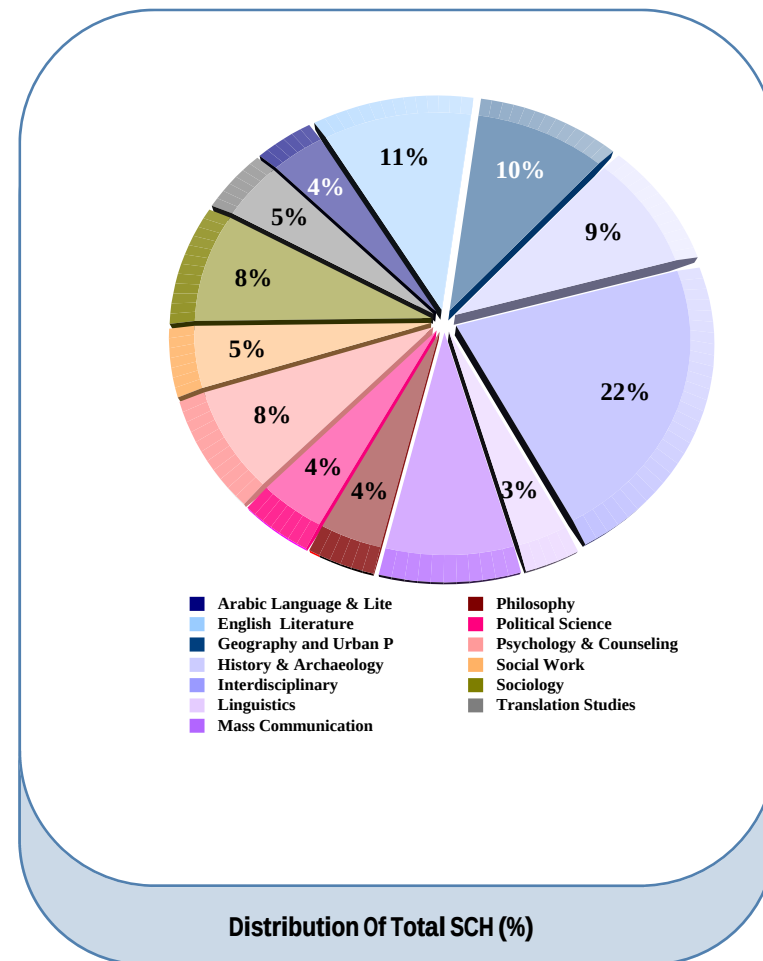


% Distribution of Female Registered

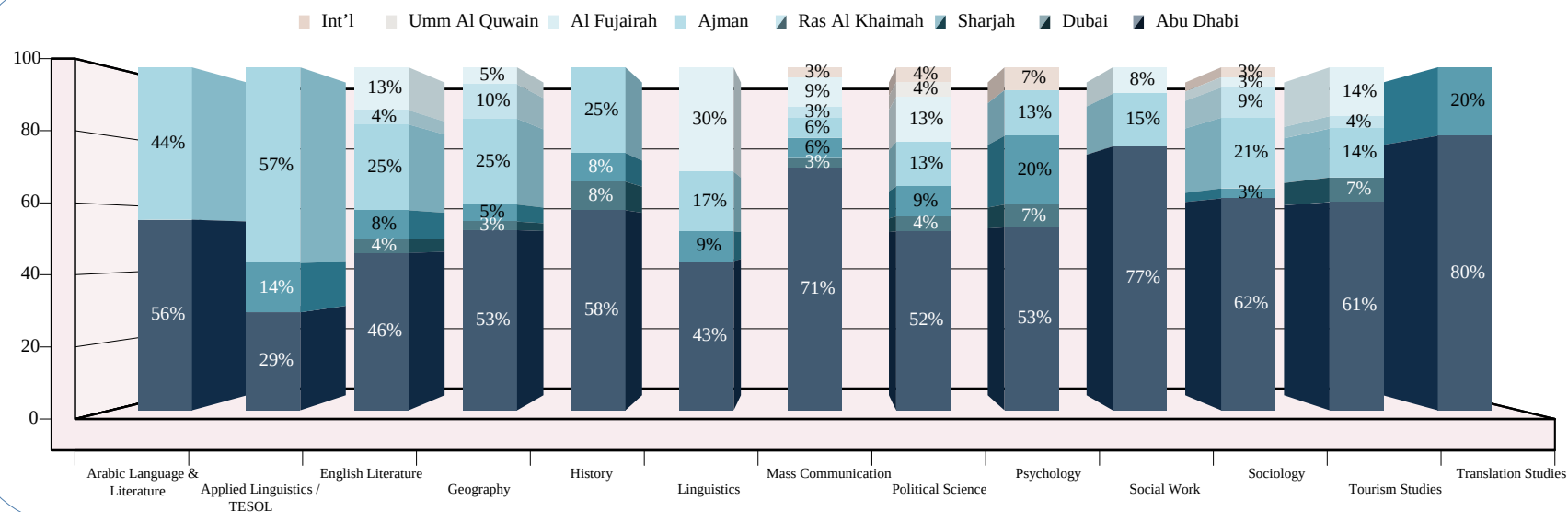
% Distribution of Graduates by Major/ Nationality Groups



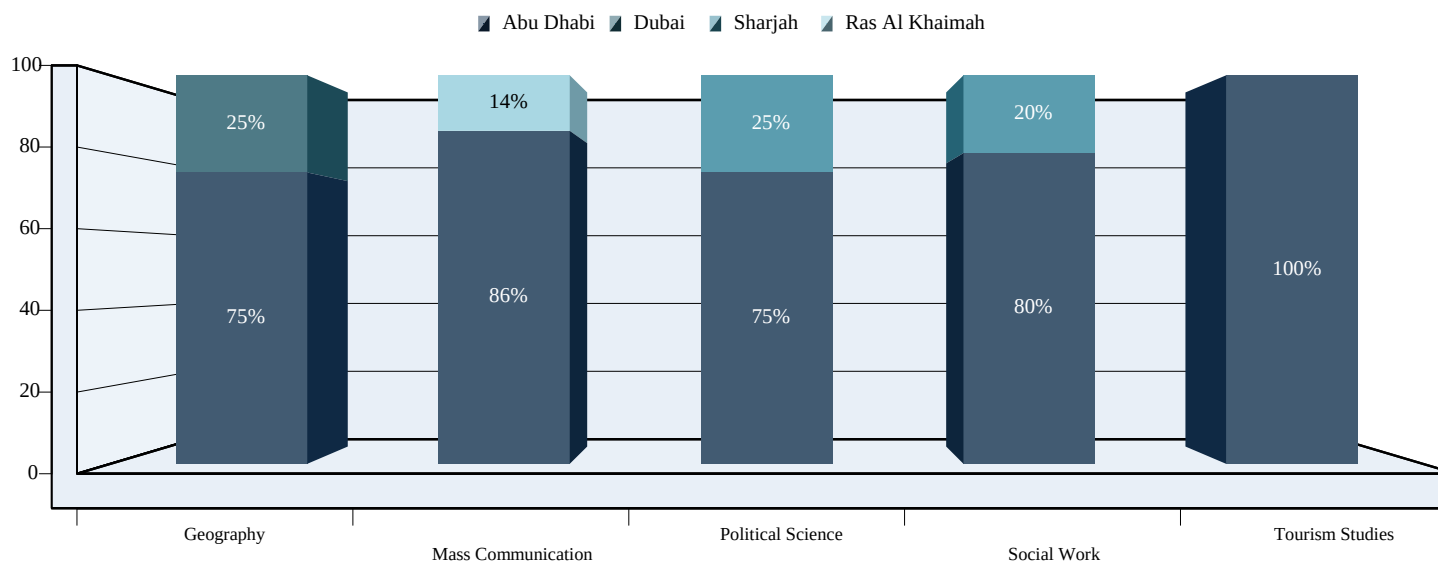

% Distribution of Female Student Graduates

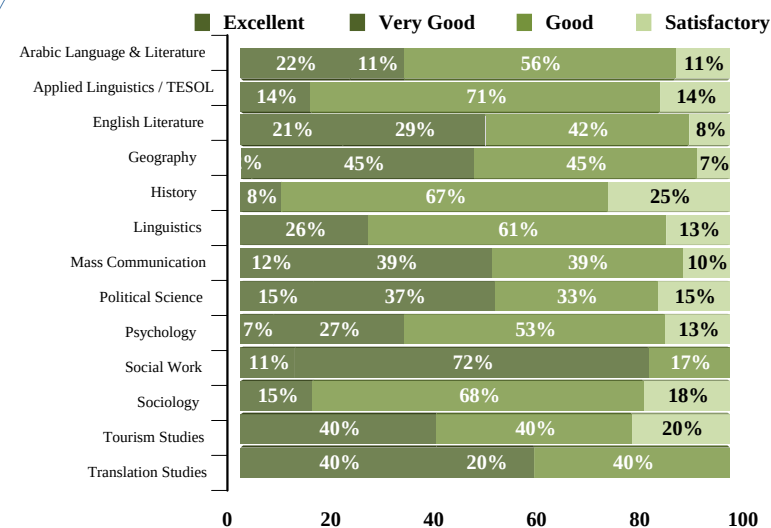

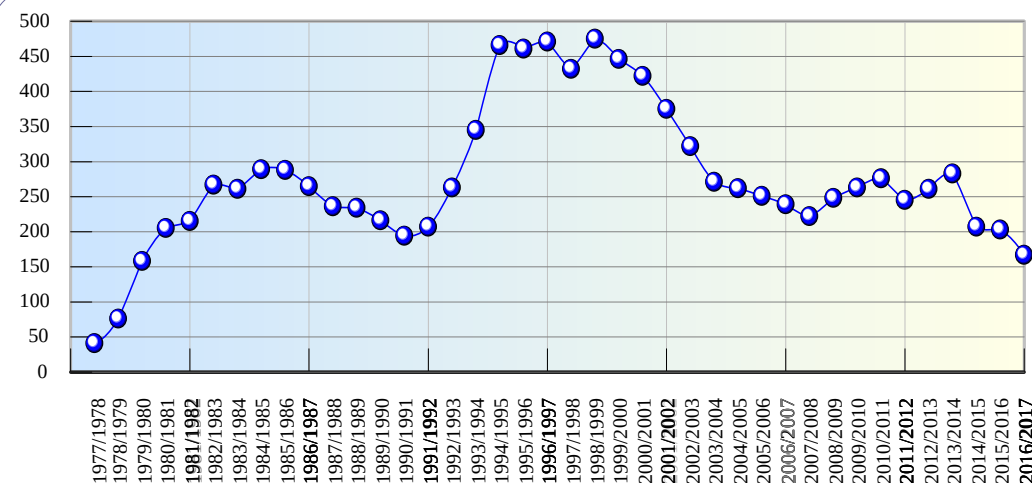


% Distribution of Expected Graduates by Major / Nationality Groups

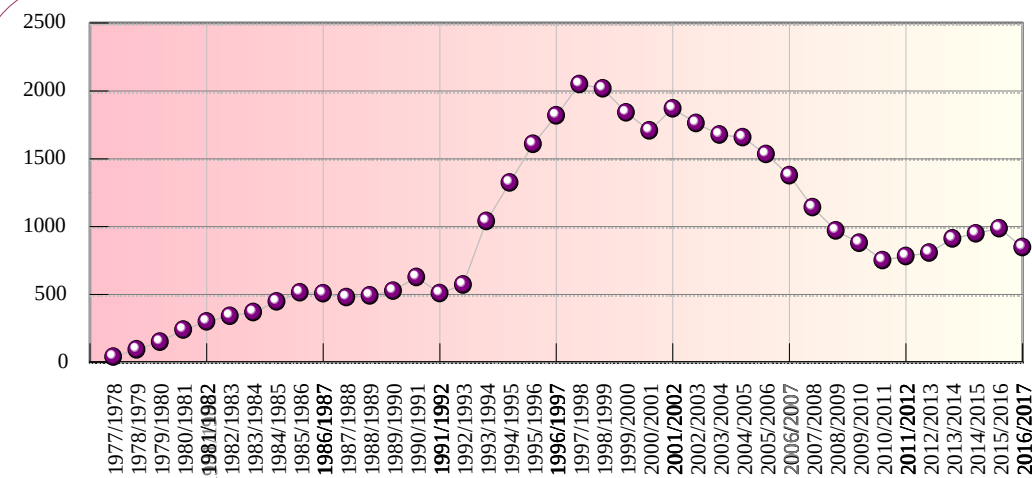

% Distribution of Male Registered

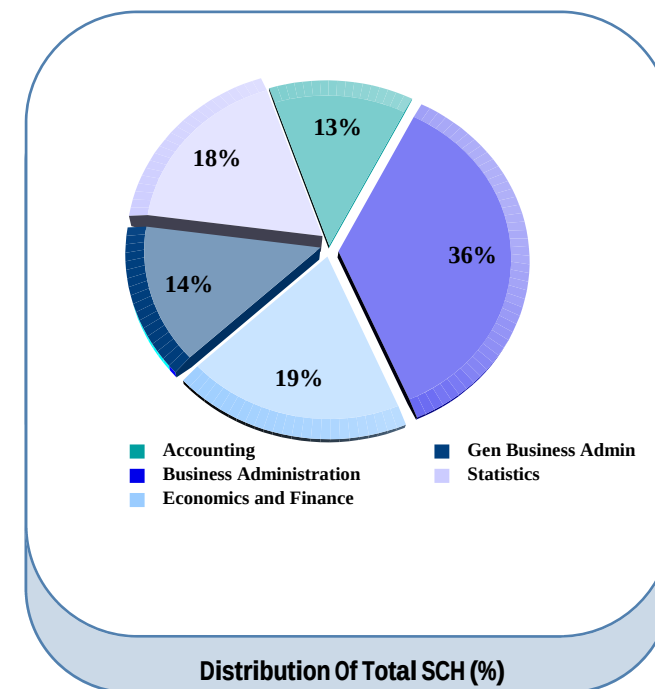

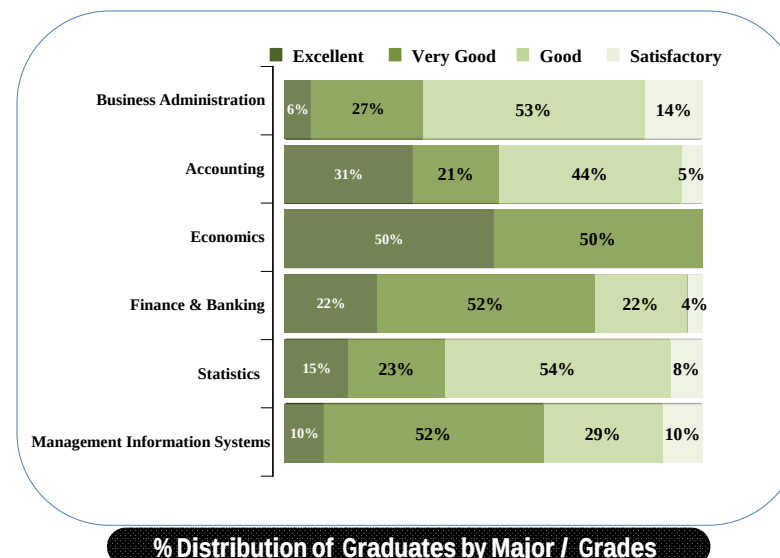
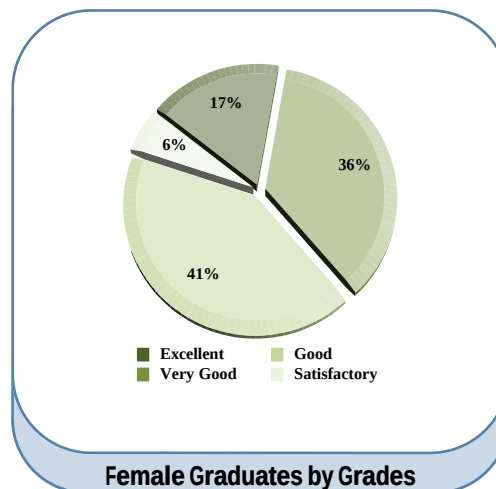
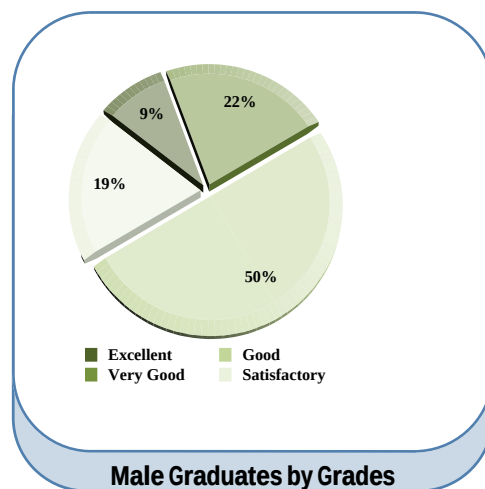
% Distribution of Male Student Graduates

% Distribution of Male Registered

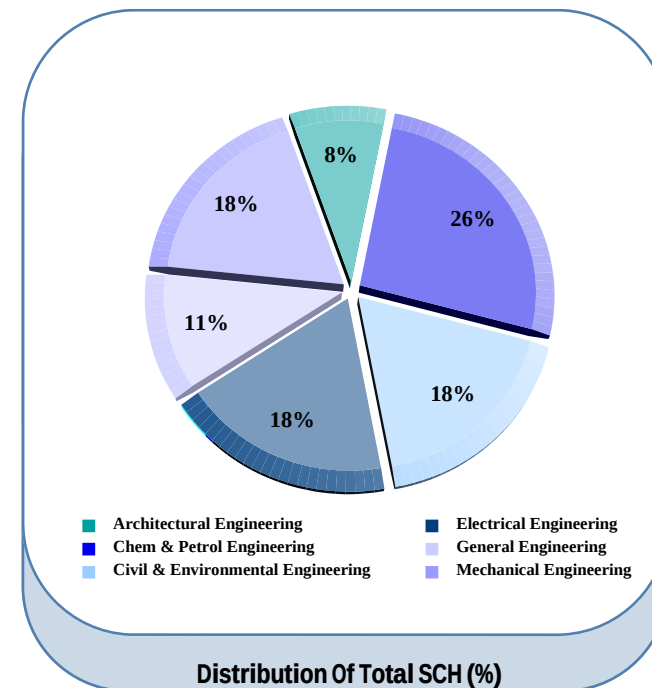


% Distribution of Female Registered

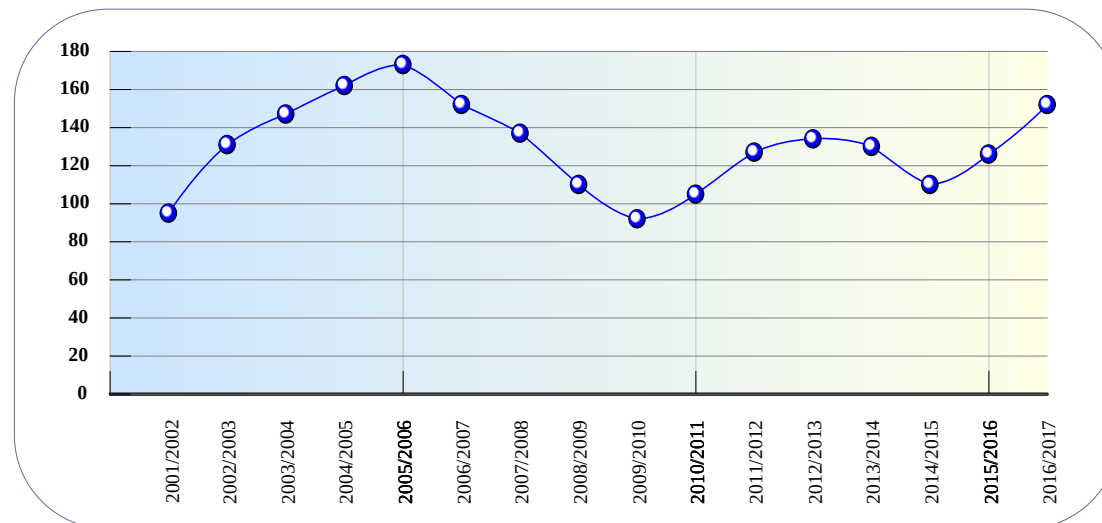
% Distribution of Male Student Graduates



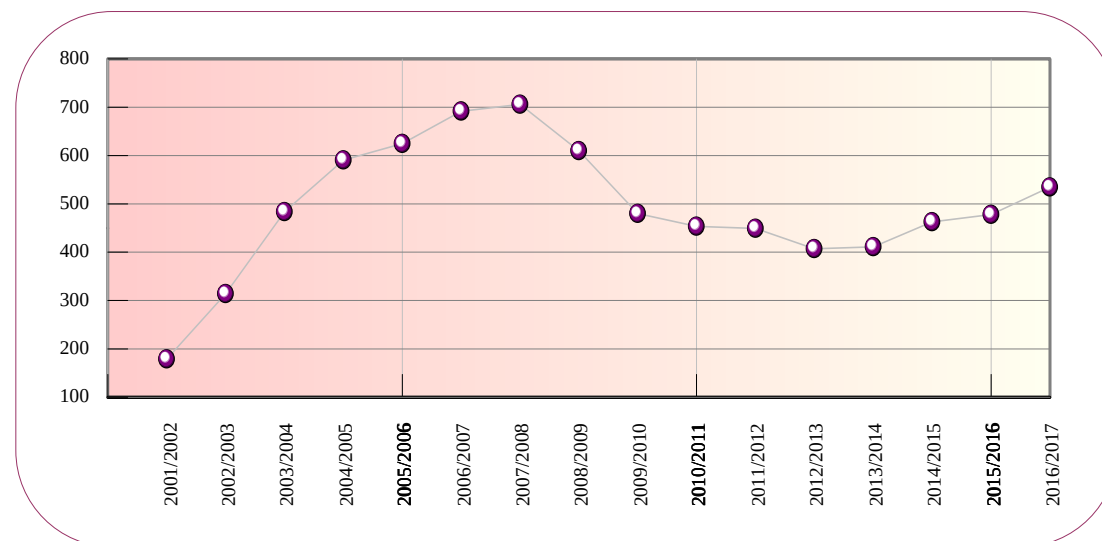

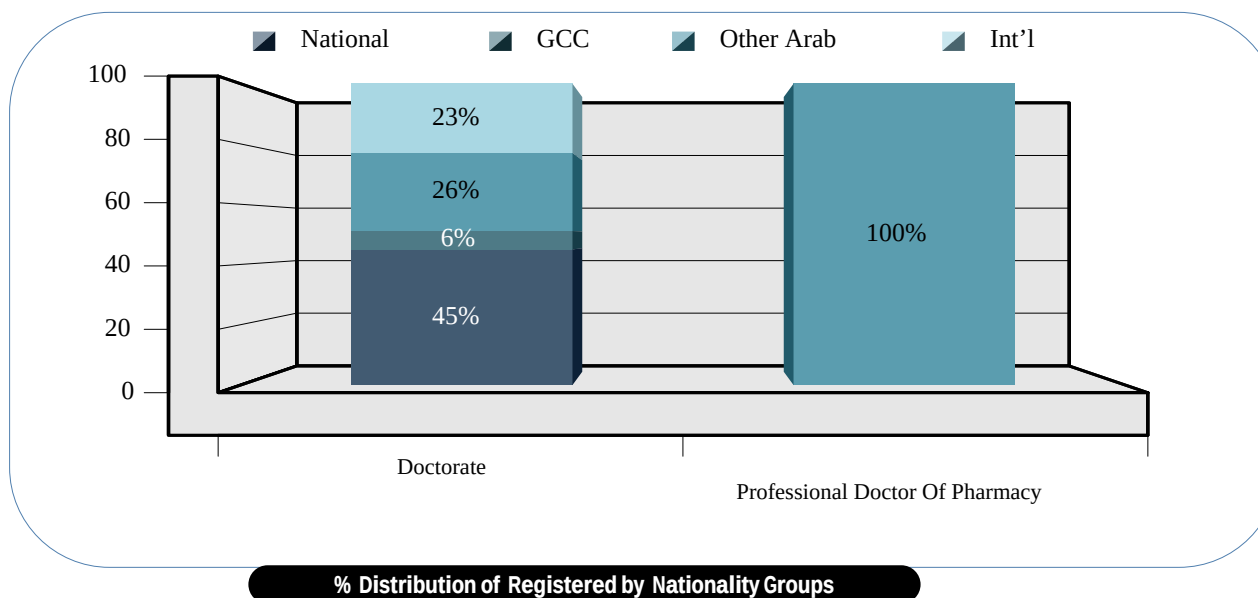


% Distribution of Registered

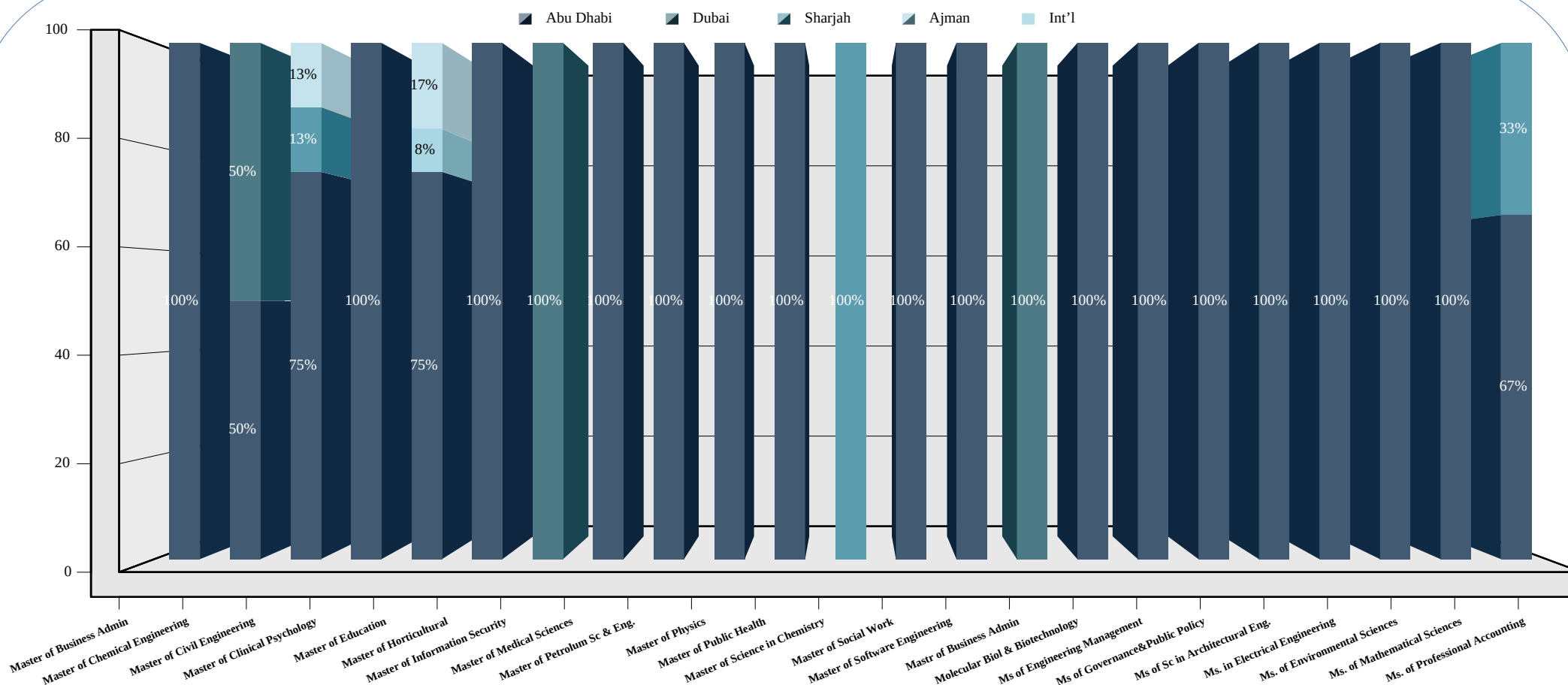
% Distribution of Graduates by Major/ Nationality Groups

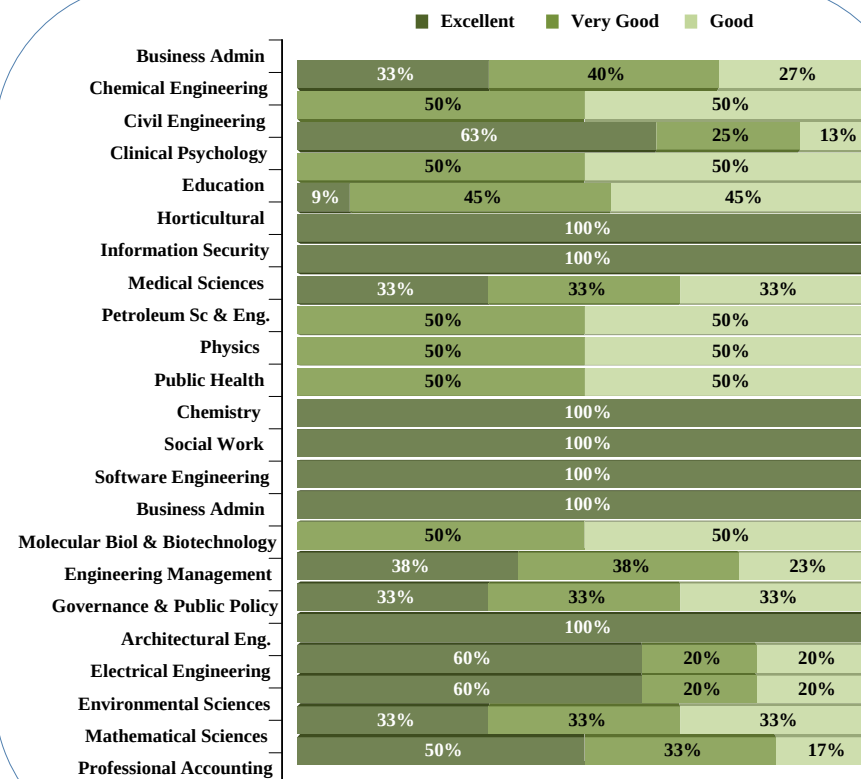

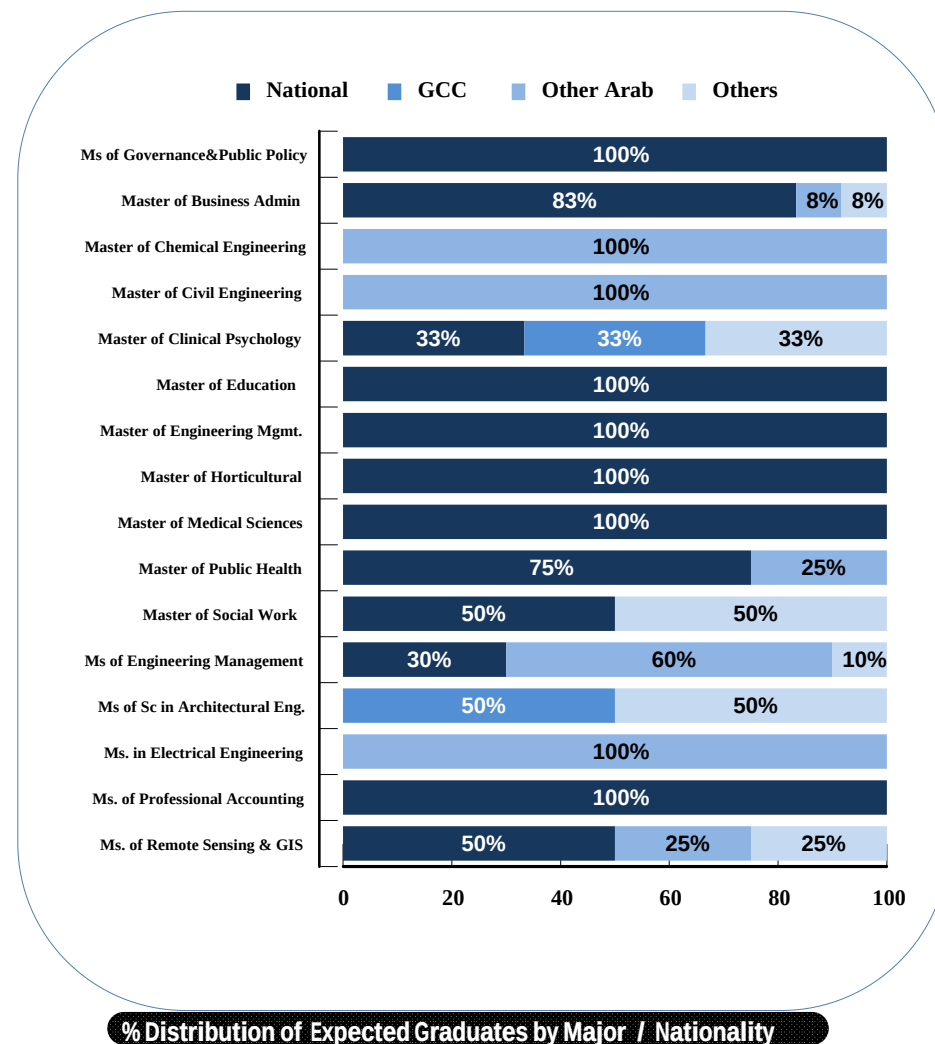


% Distribution of Graduates by Major / Grades
