Student Admission by Gender / Nationality Groups



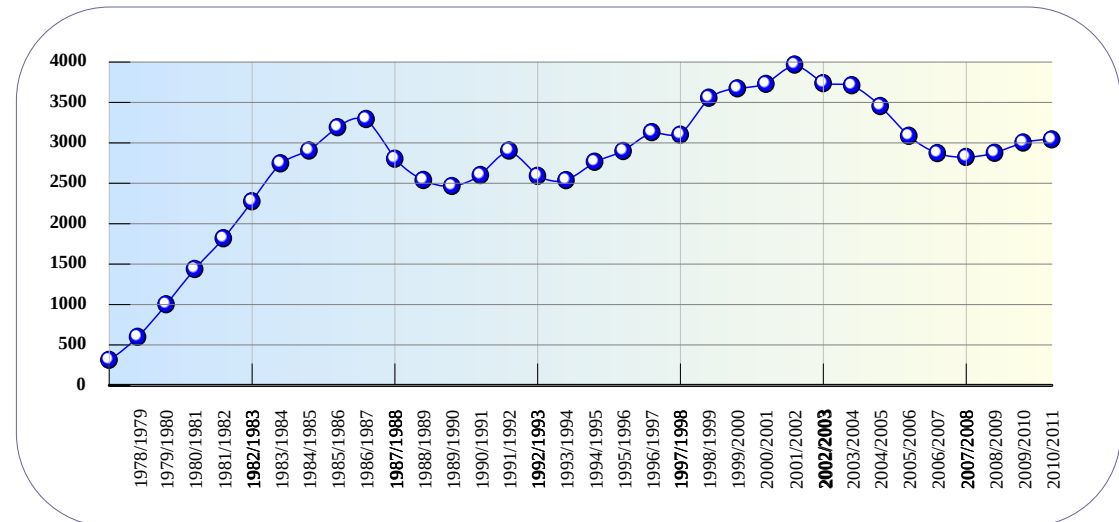

% Distribution of Male Registered by Faculty / Place Of Residence



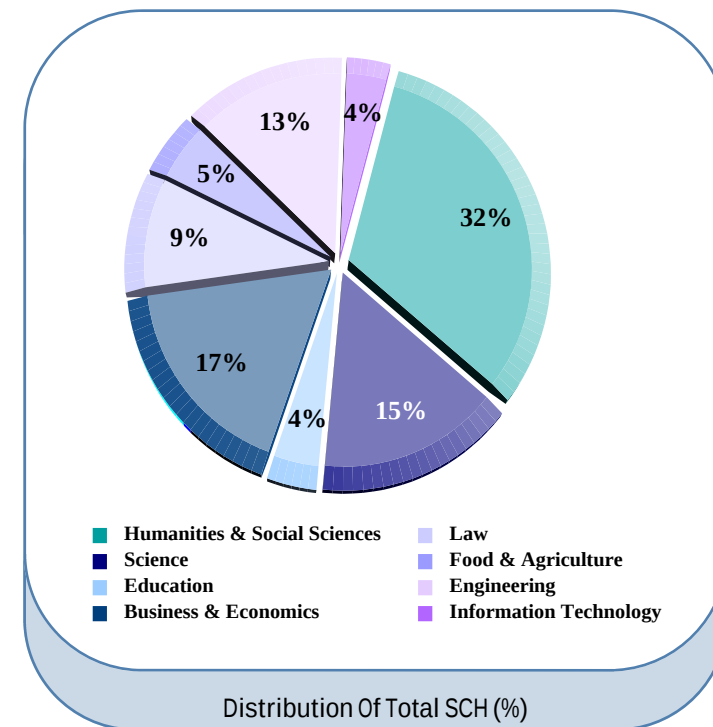

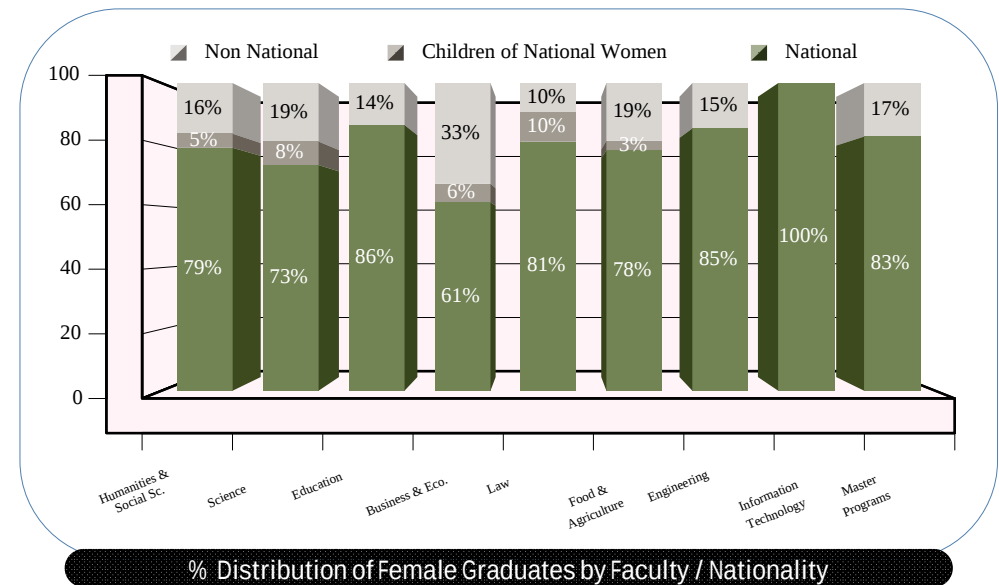
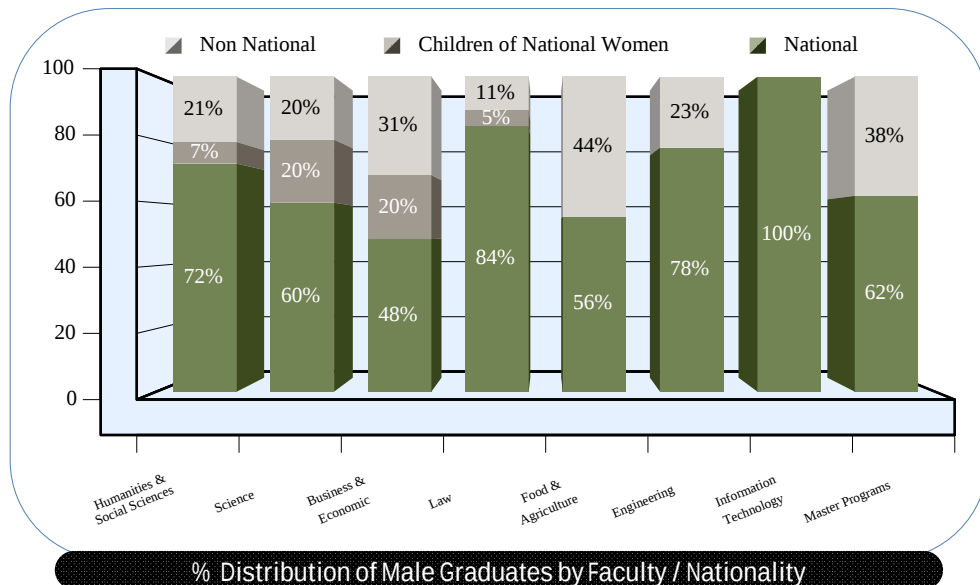


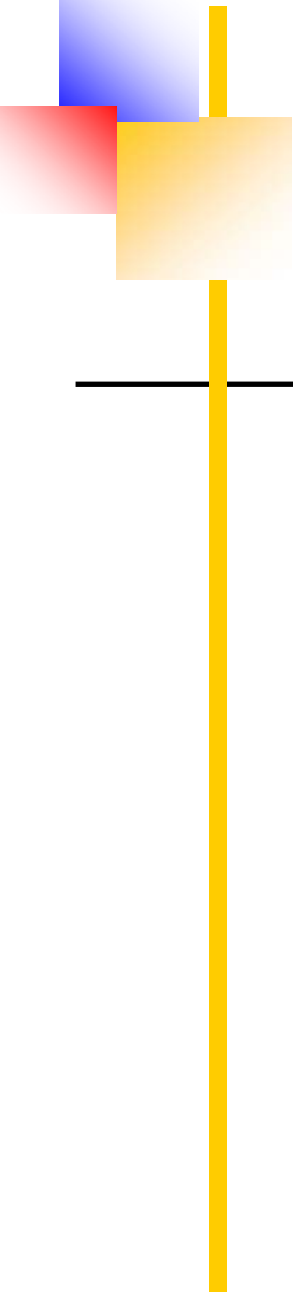
% Distribution of Graduates By Faculty/ Grades

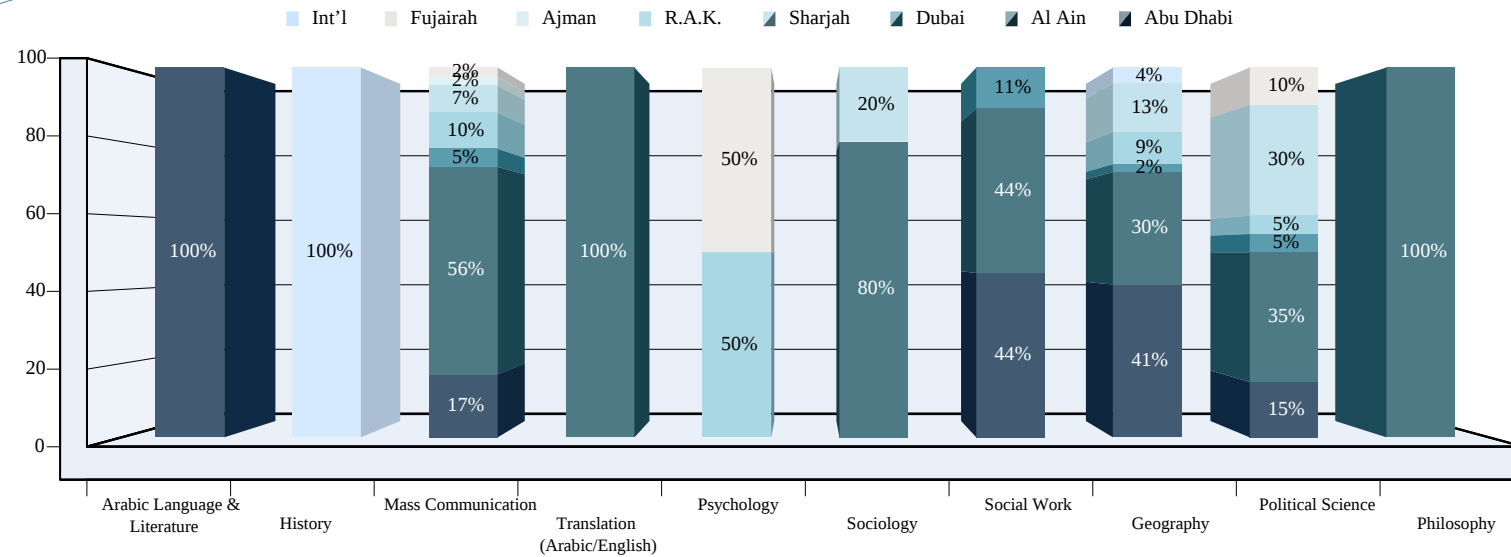
% Distribution of Registered by Major / Nationality Groups



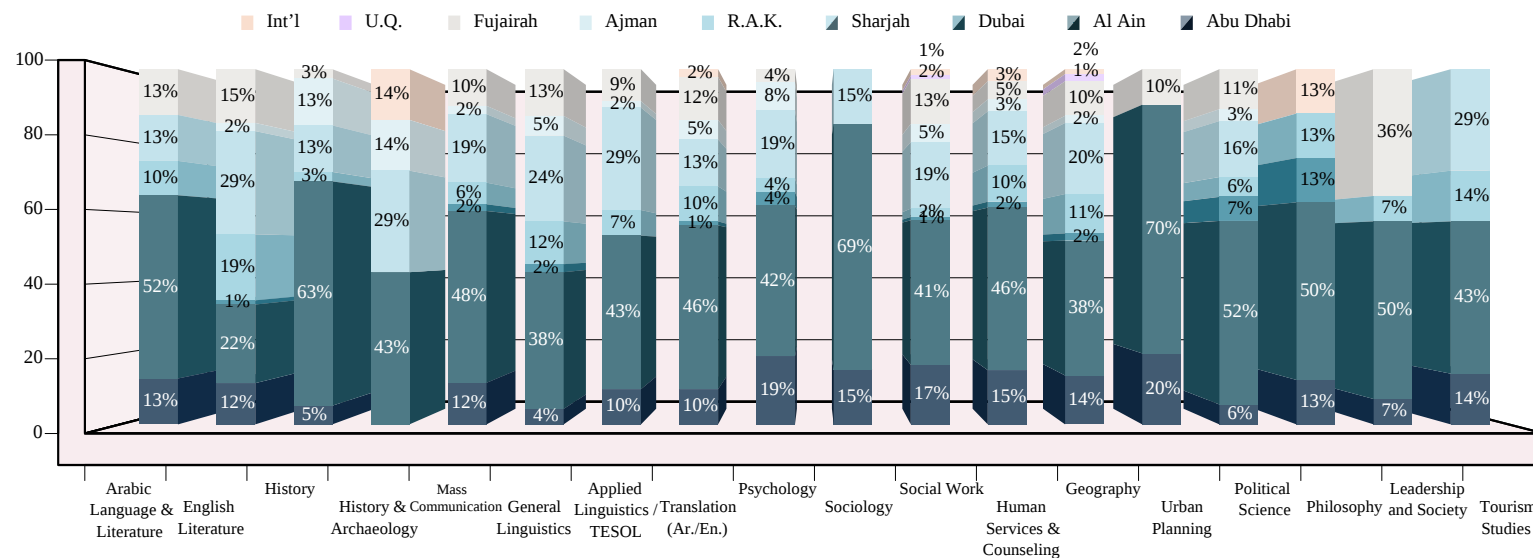

% Distribution of Male Registered

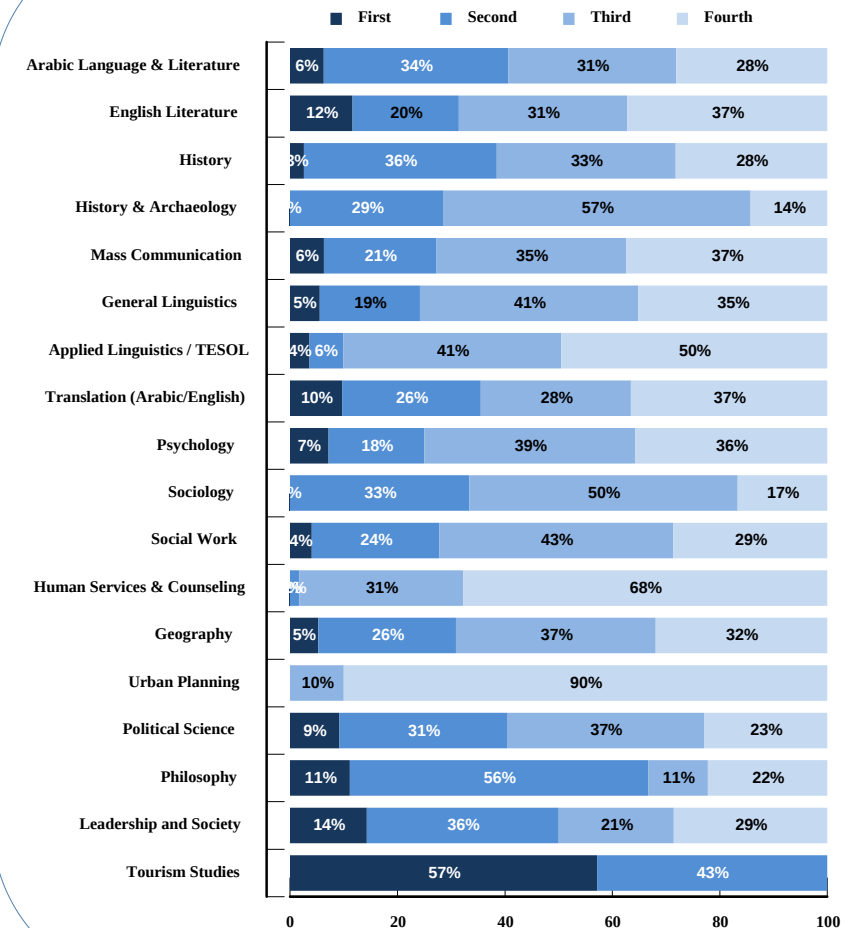


% Distribution of Female Registered

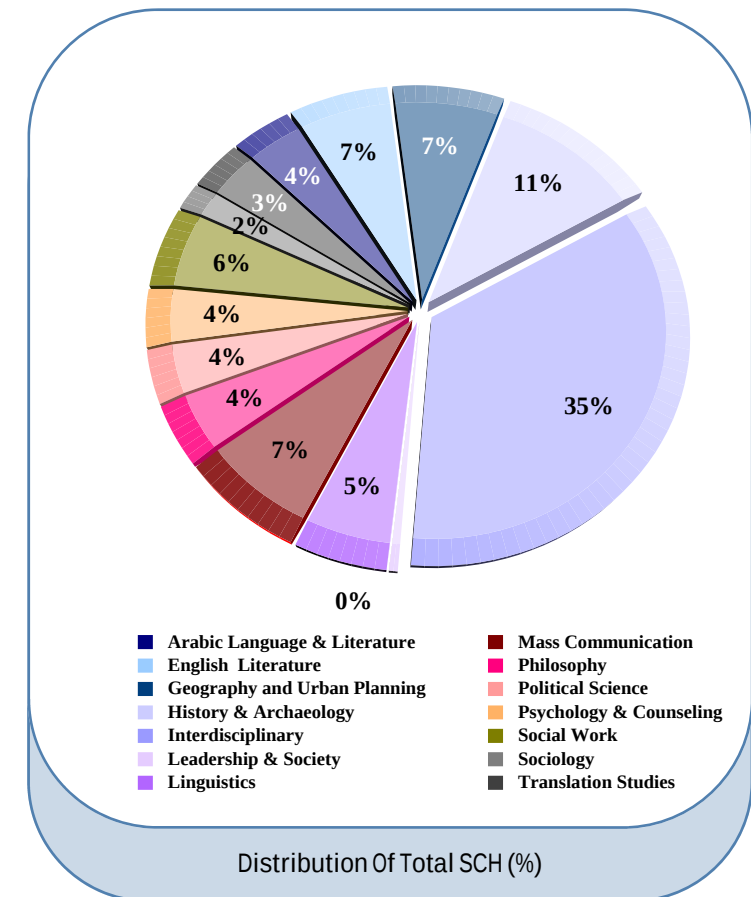


% Distribution of Female Registered by Major / Student Level

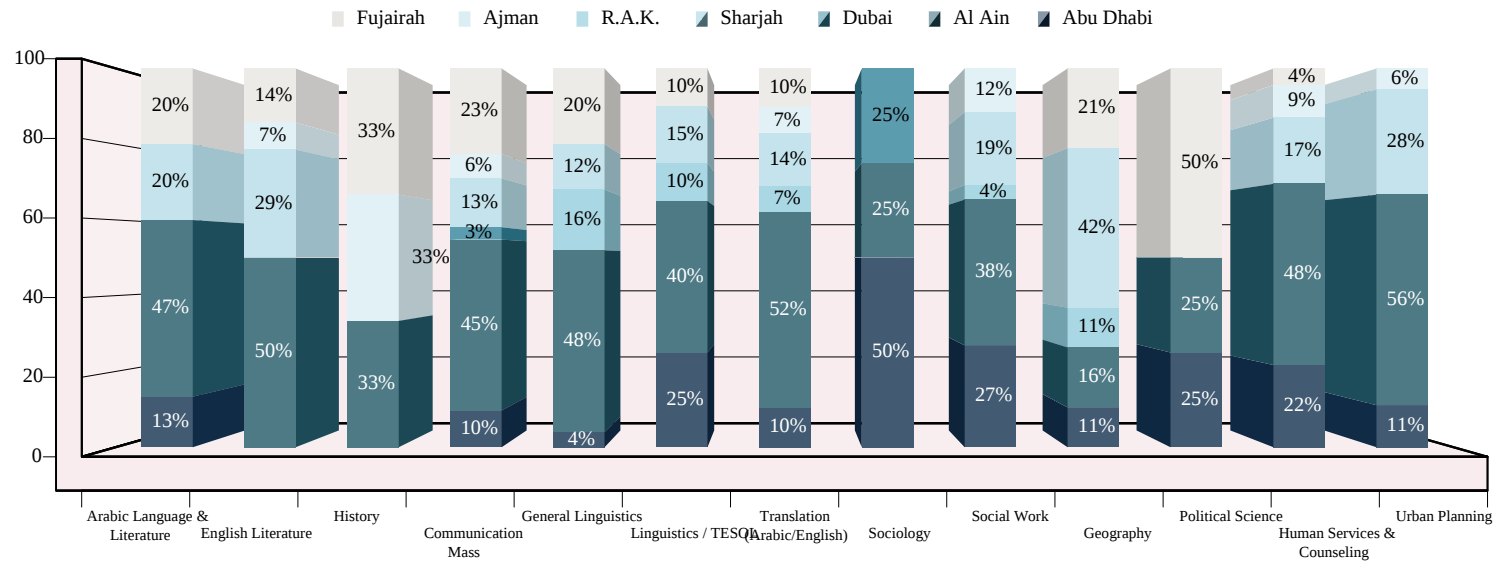
% Distribution of Graduates by Major/ Nationality Groups



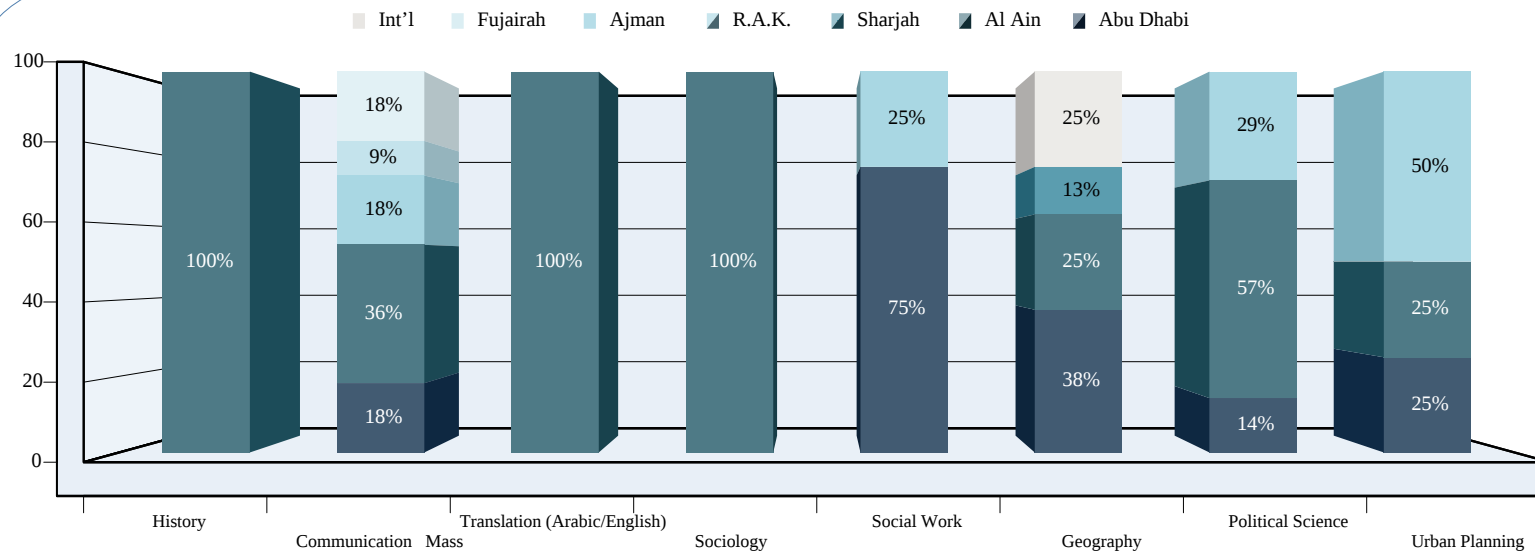

% Distribution of Female Student Graduates

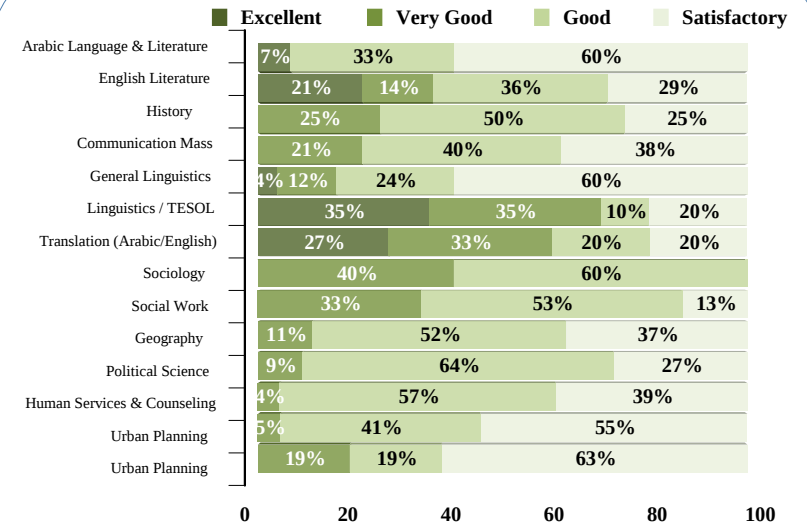

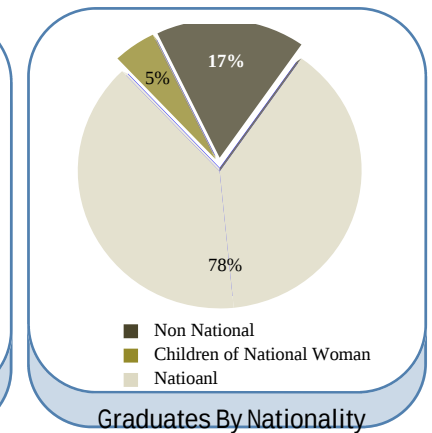
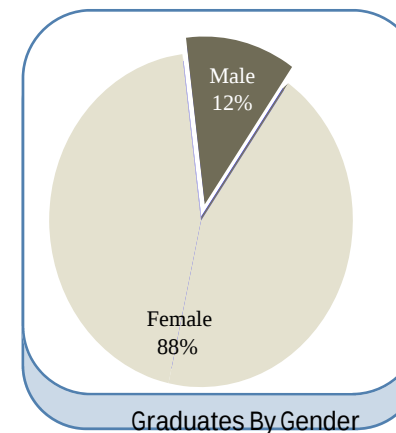
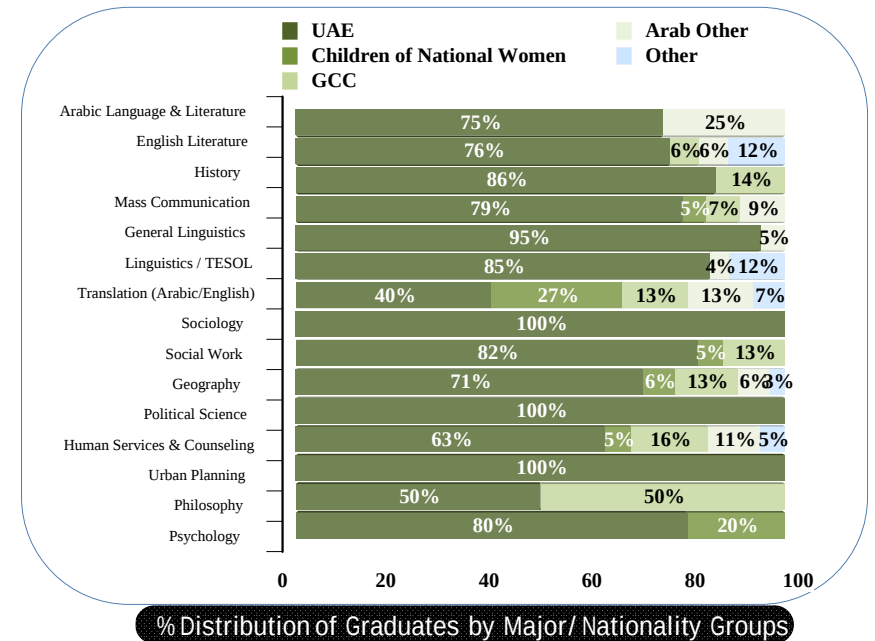
% Distribution of Graduates by Major / Grades

% Distribution of Male Registered

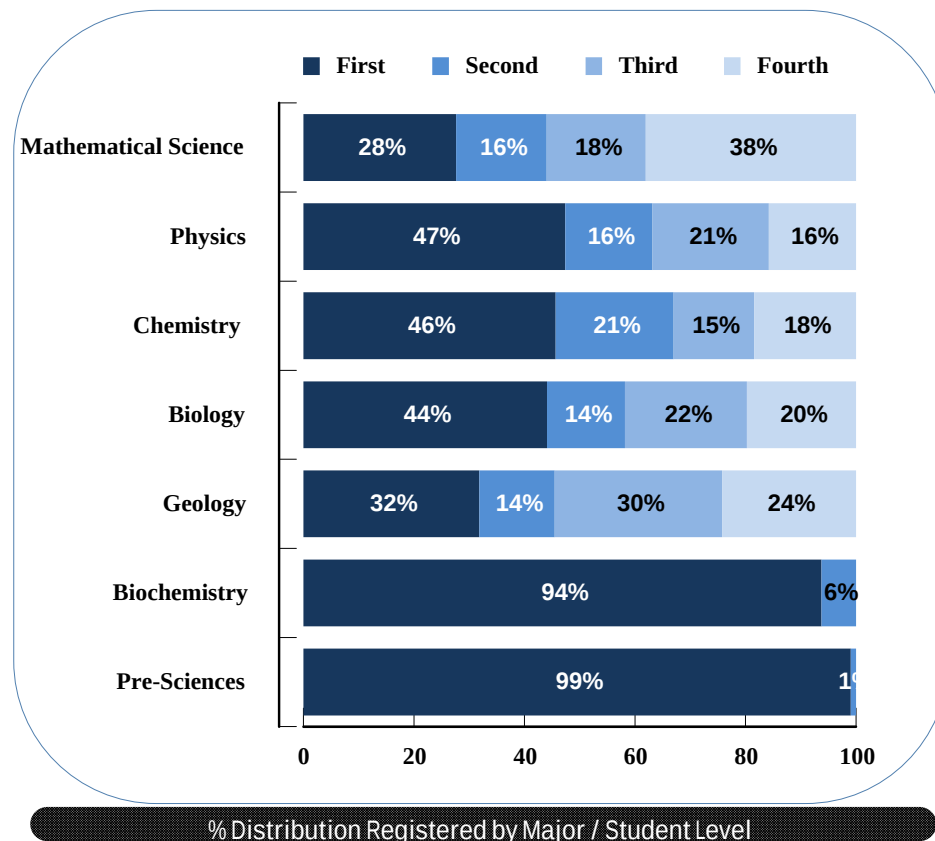

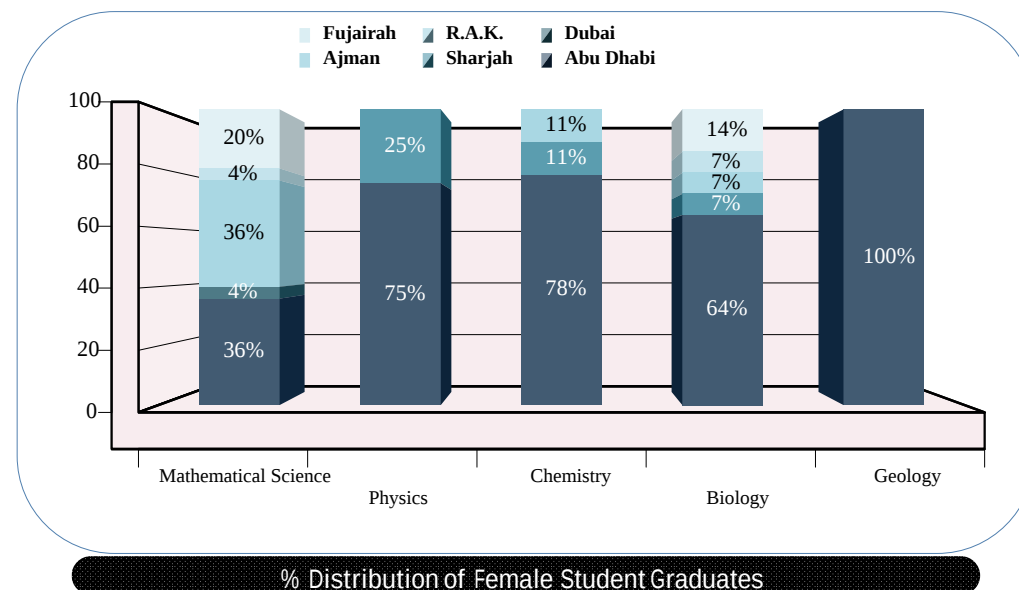
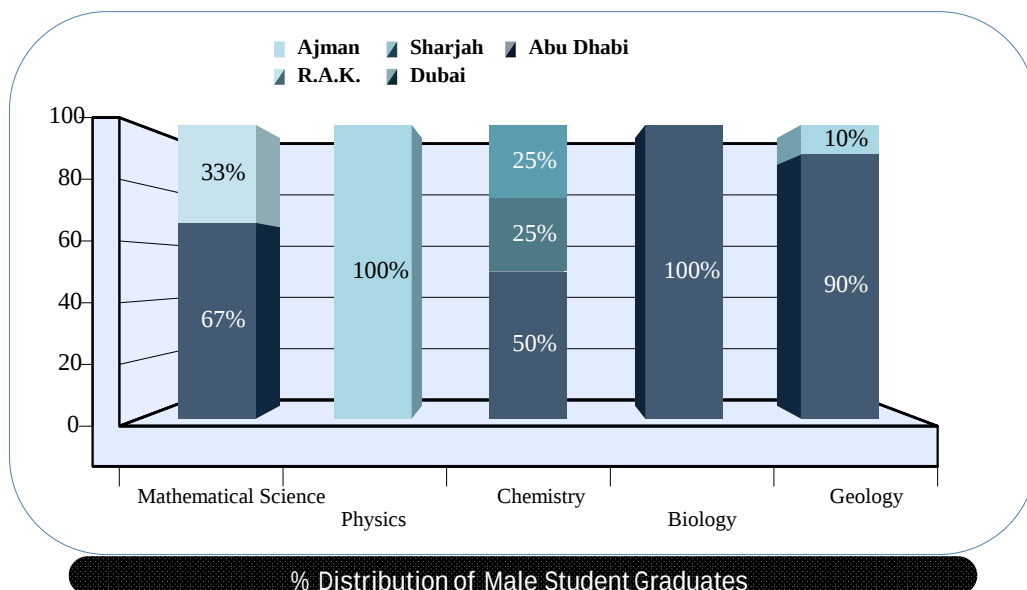


% Distribution of Graduates by Major/ Nationality Groups

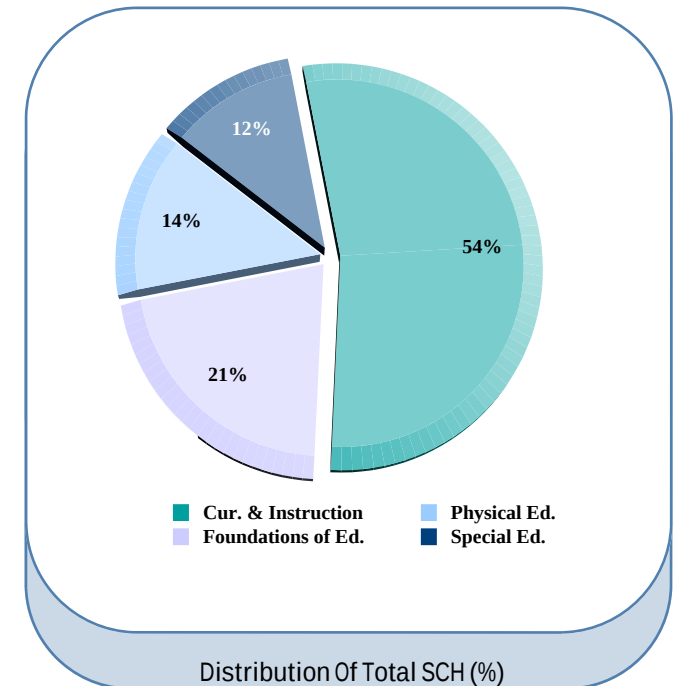
% Distribution of Female Registered by Major / Student Level

% Distribution of Male Registered

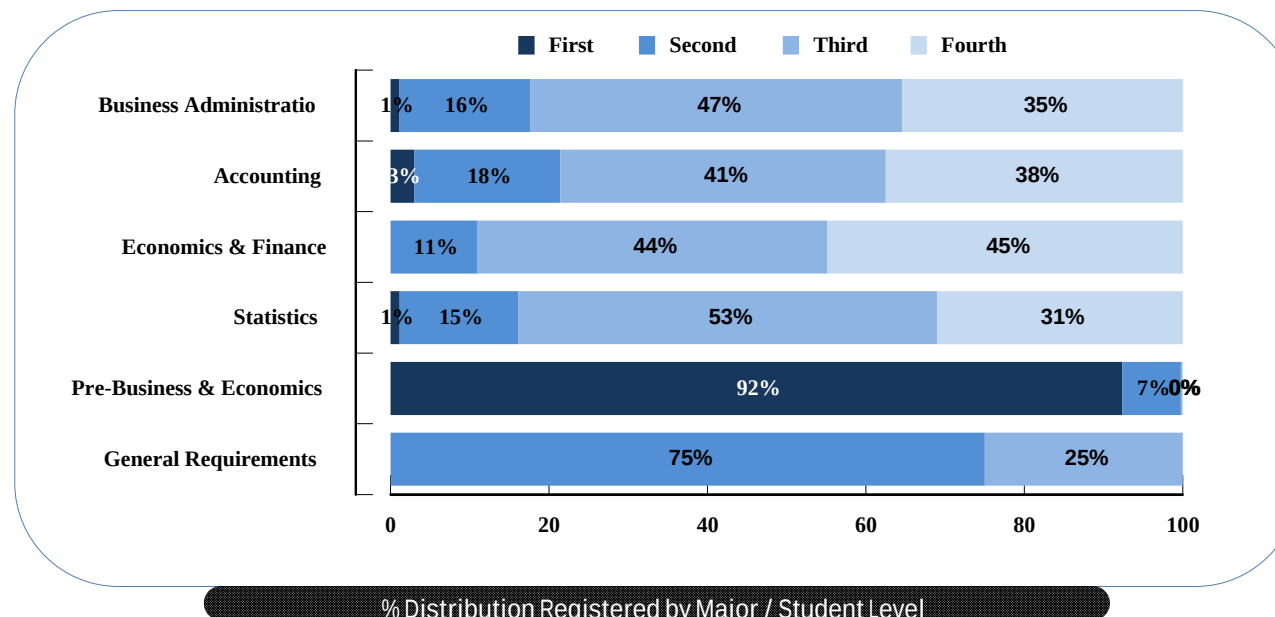

% Distribution of Male Student Graduates

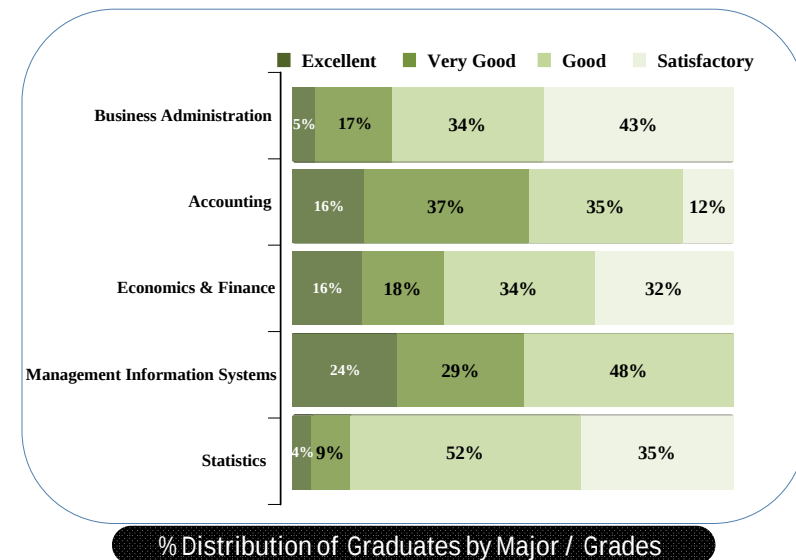
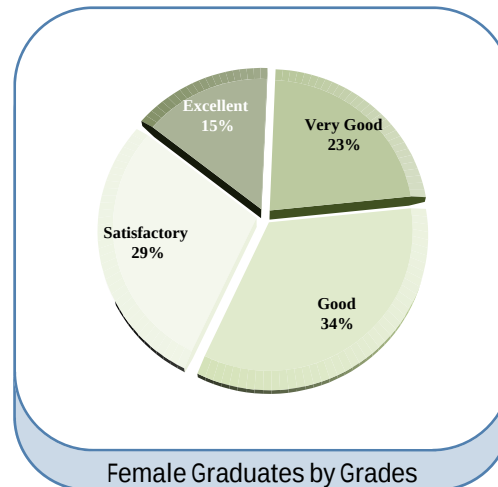
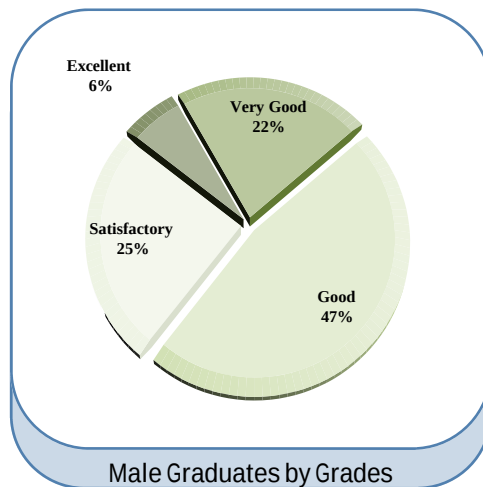


% Distribution of Female Student Graduates

% Distribution of Male Registered

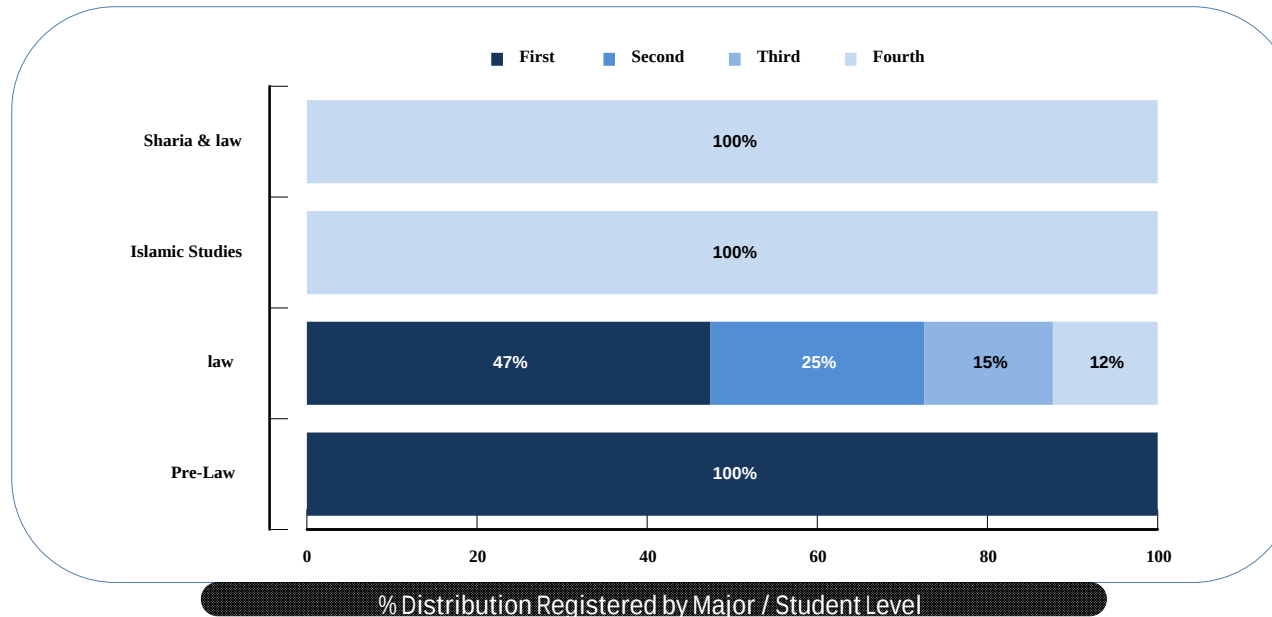


% Distribution of Female Registered

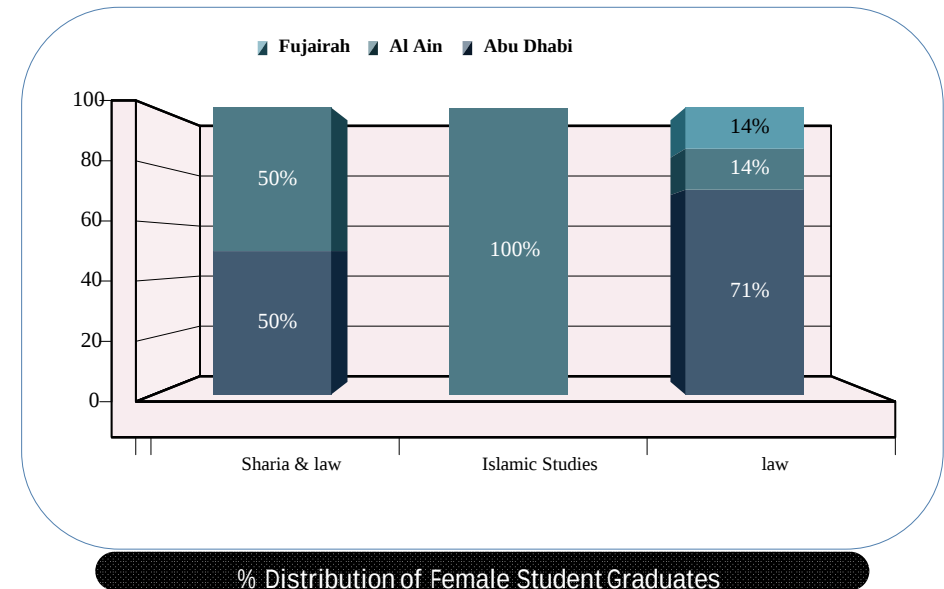
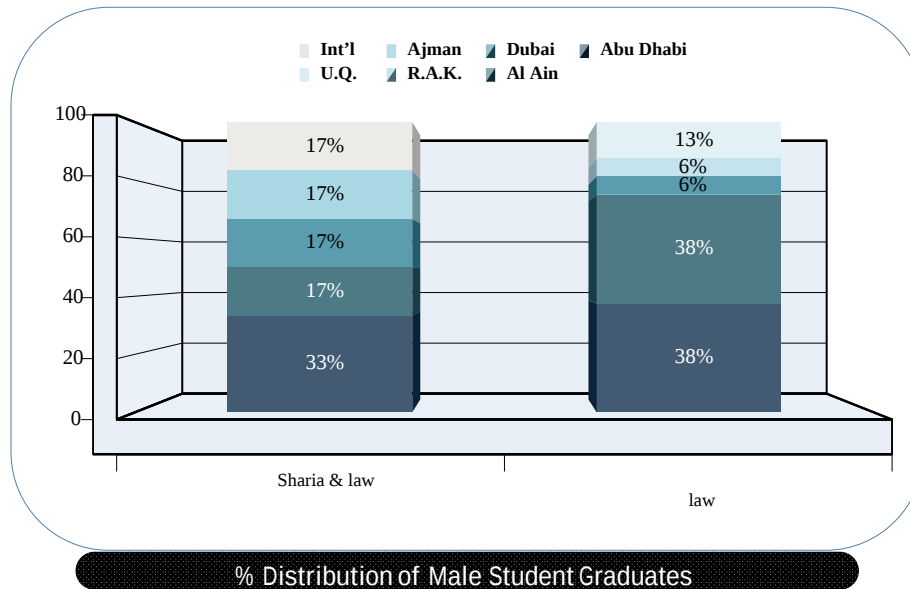


% Distribution of Graduates by Major / Grades

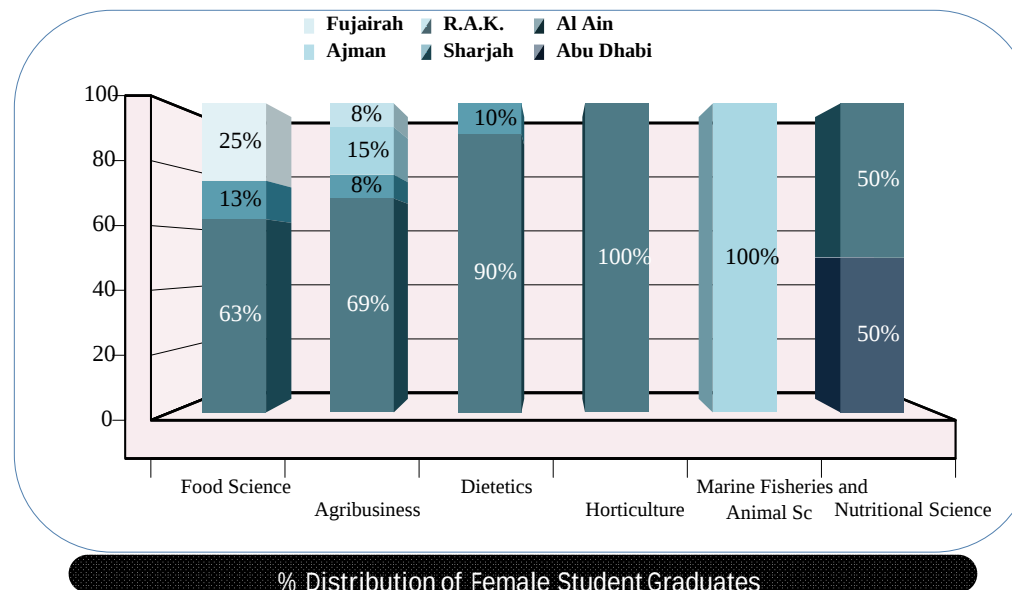
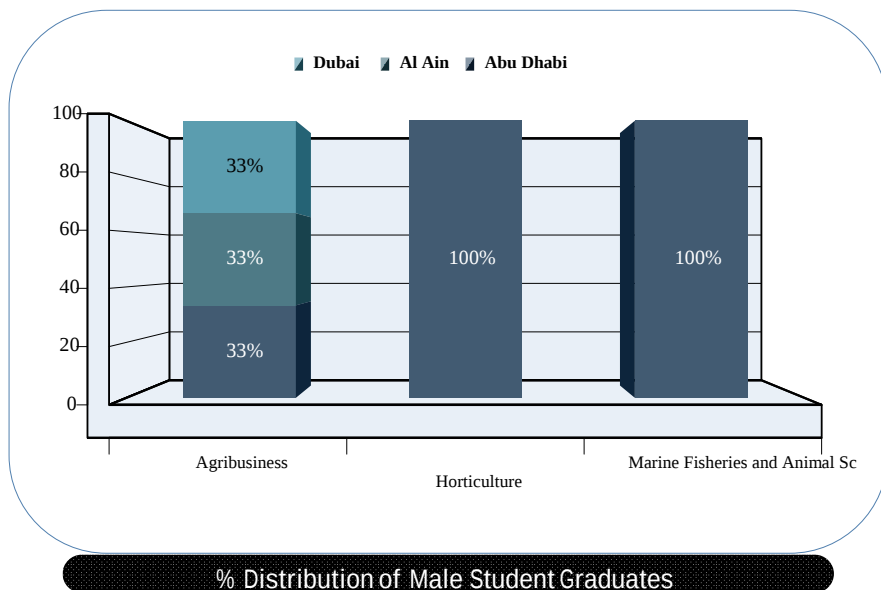


% Distribution of Graduates by Major / Grades

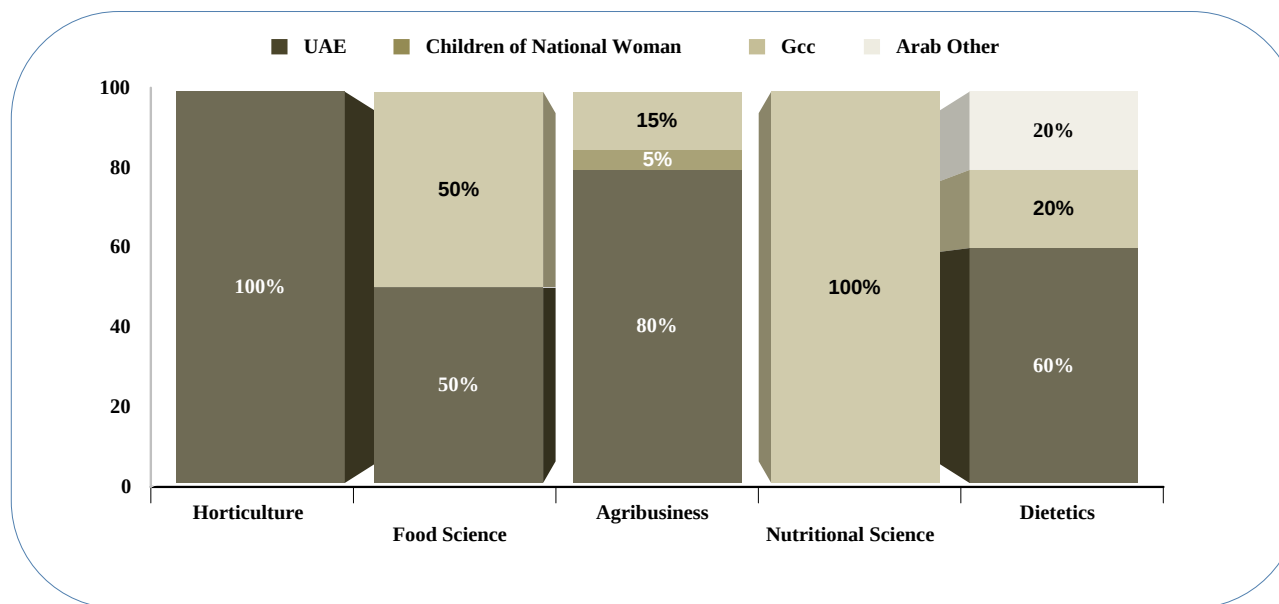

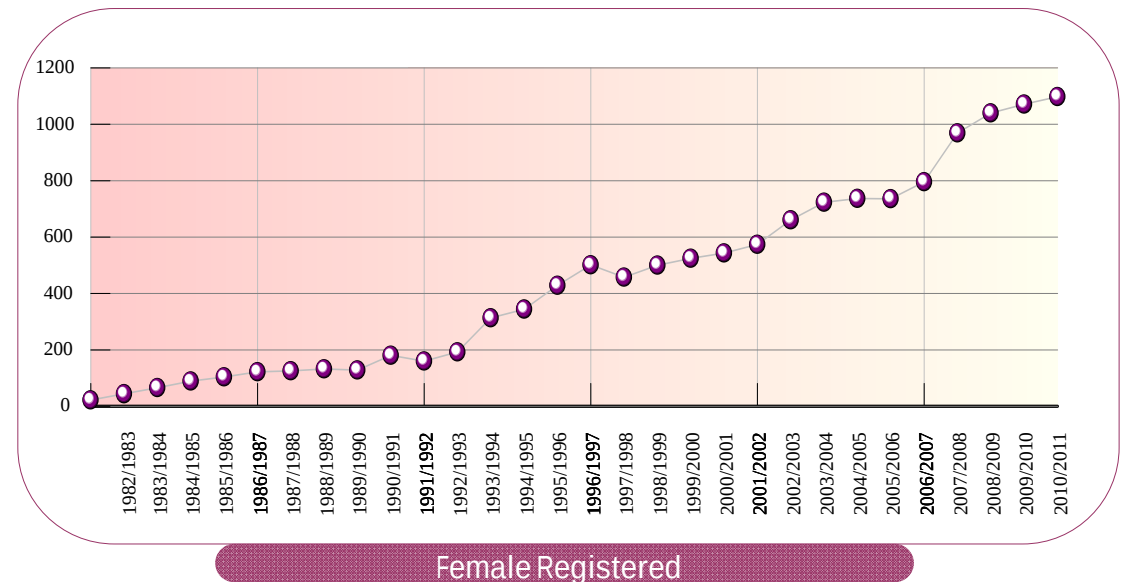
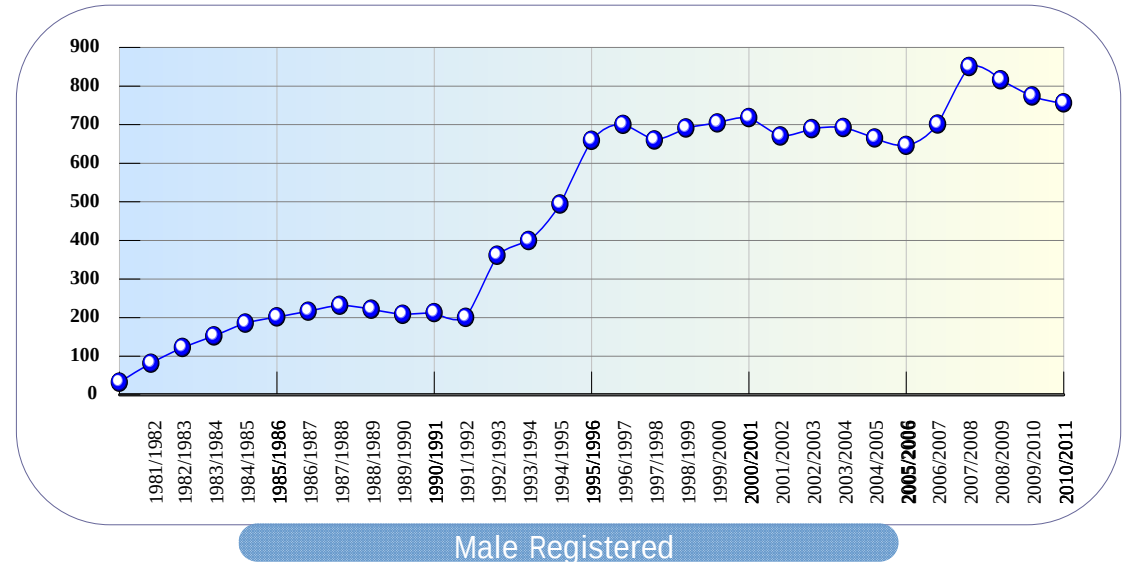


% Distribution of Expected Graduates by Major / Nationality groups

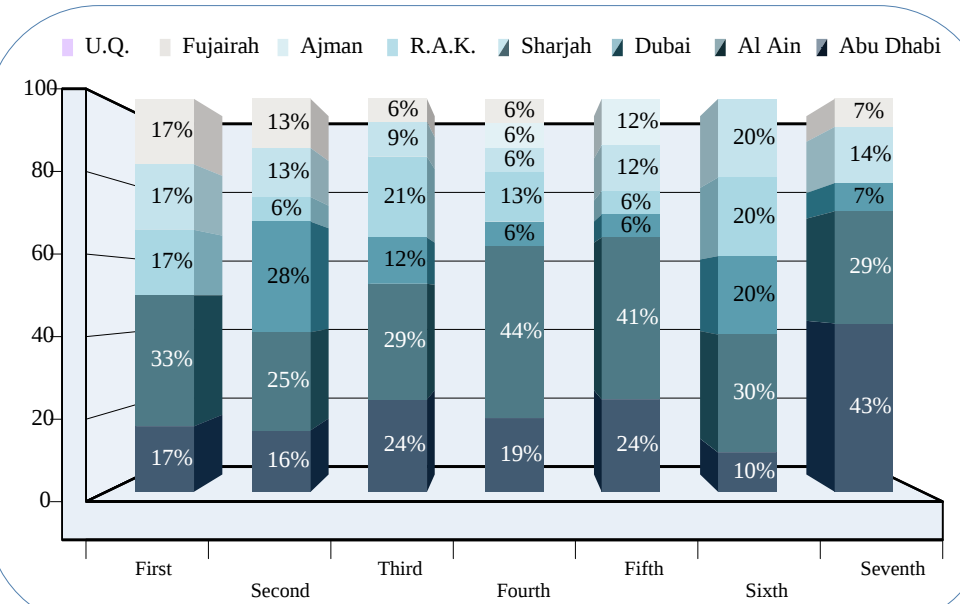


Registered Students by Major / Student Level (Fall 2011–2012)

% Distribution of Female Registered by Major / Student Level

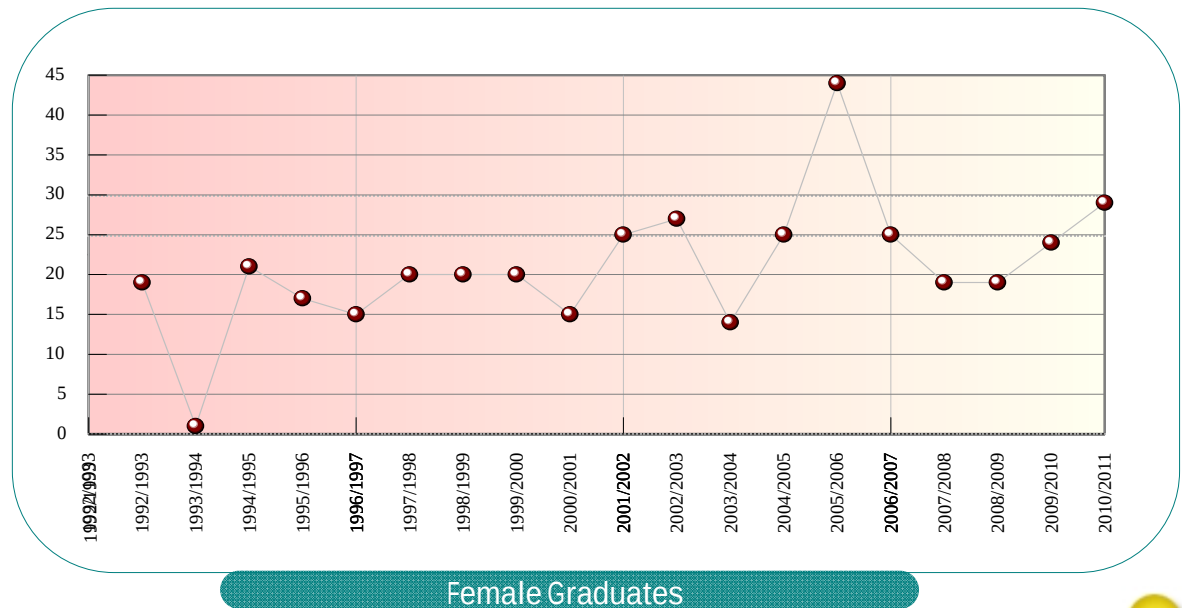
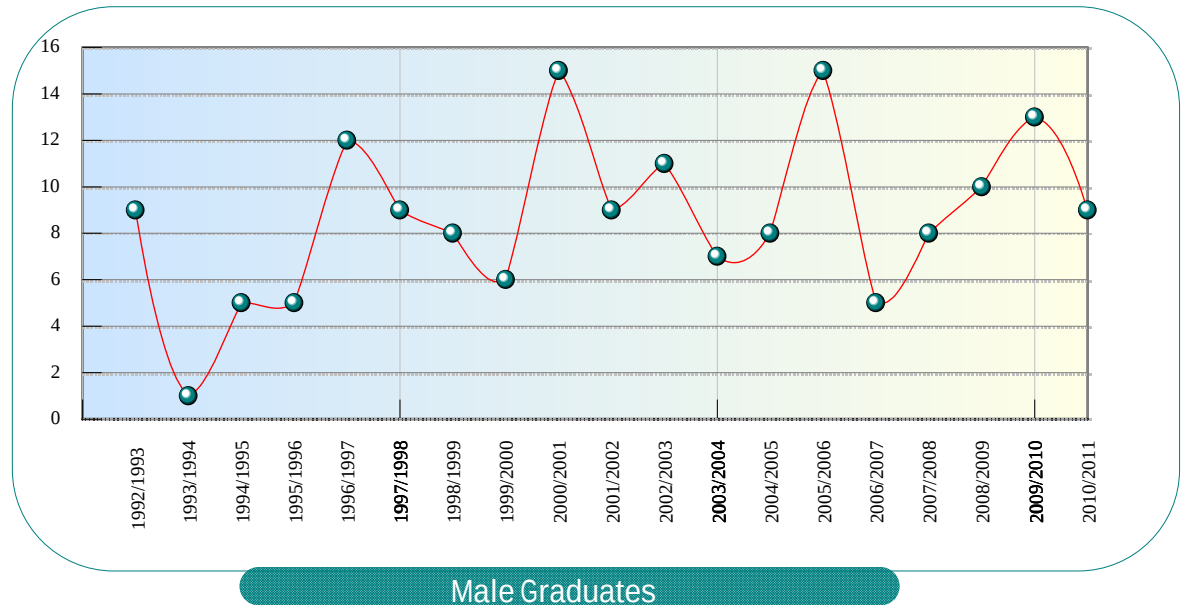


% Distribution of Male Registered by Major / Student Level

% Distribution of Male Registered

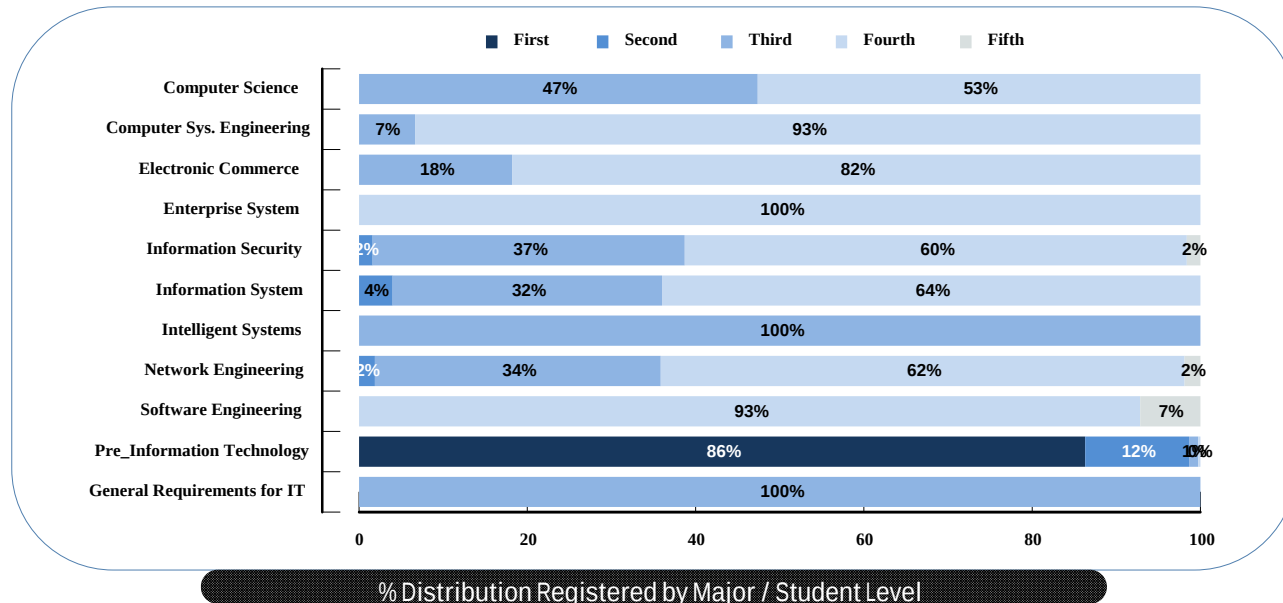

% Distribution of Male Student Graduates

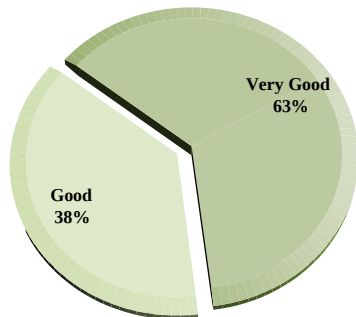

% Distribution of Expected Graduates by Major / Gender



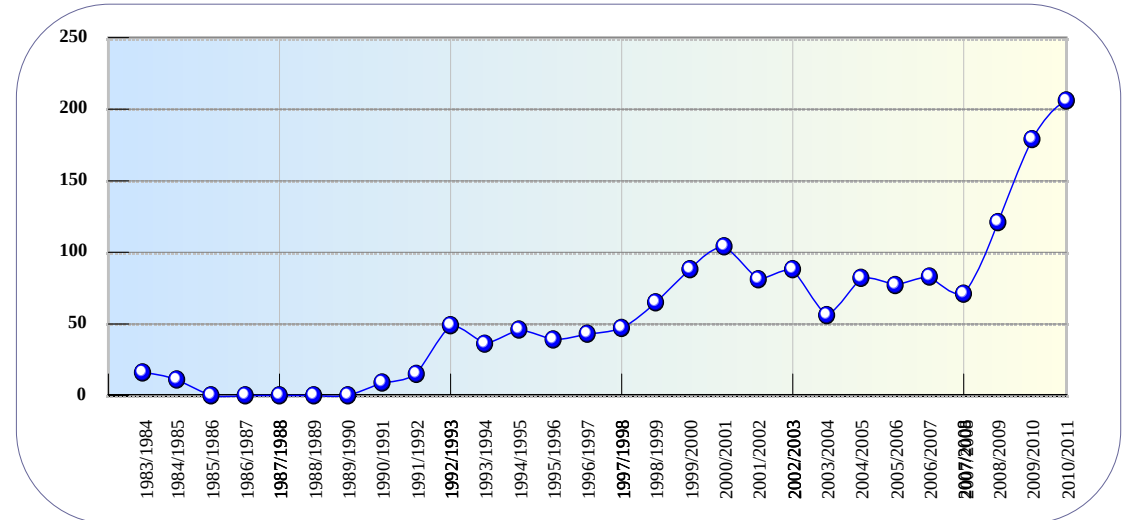

% Distribution of Male Registered



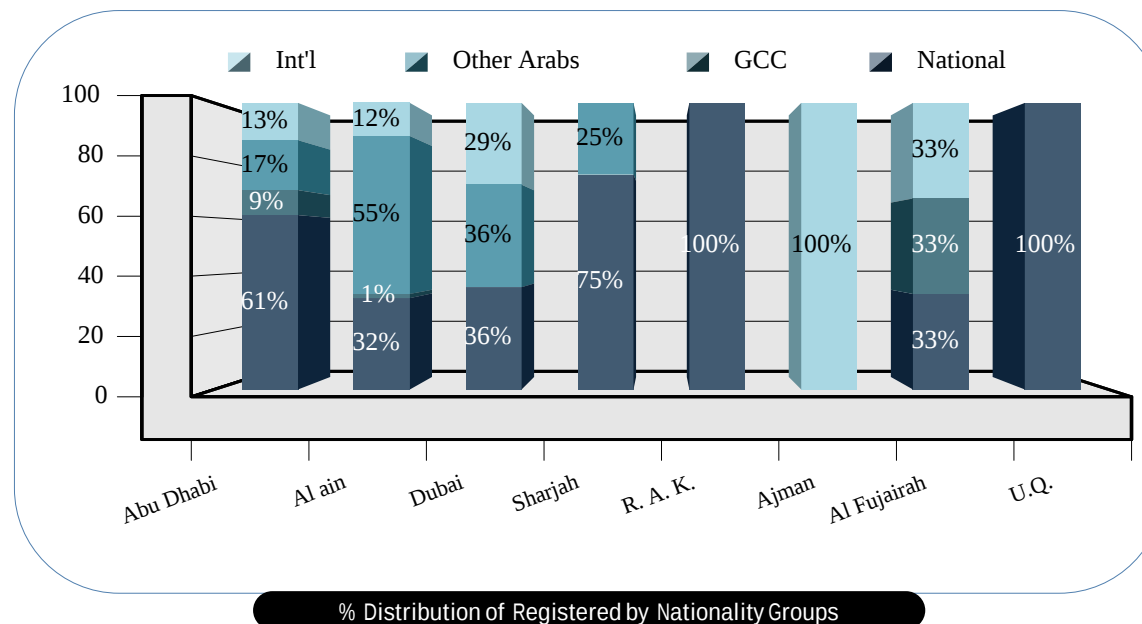

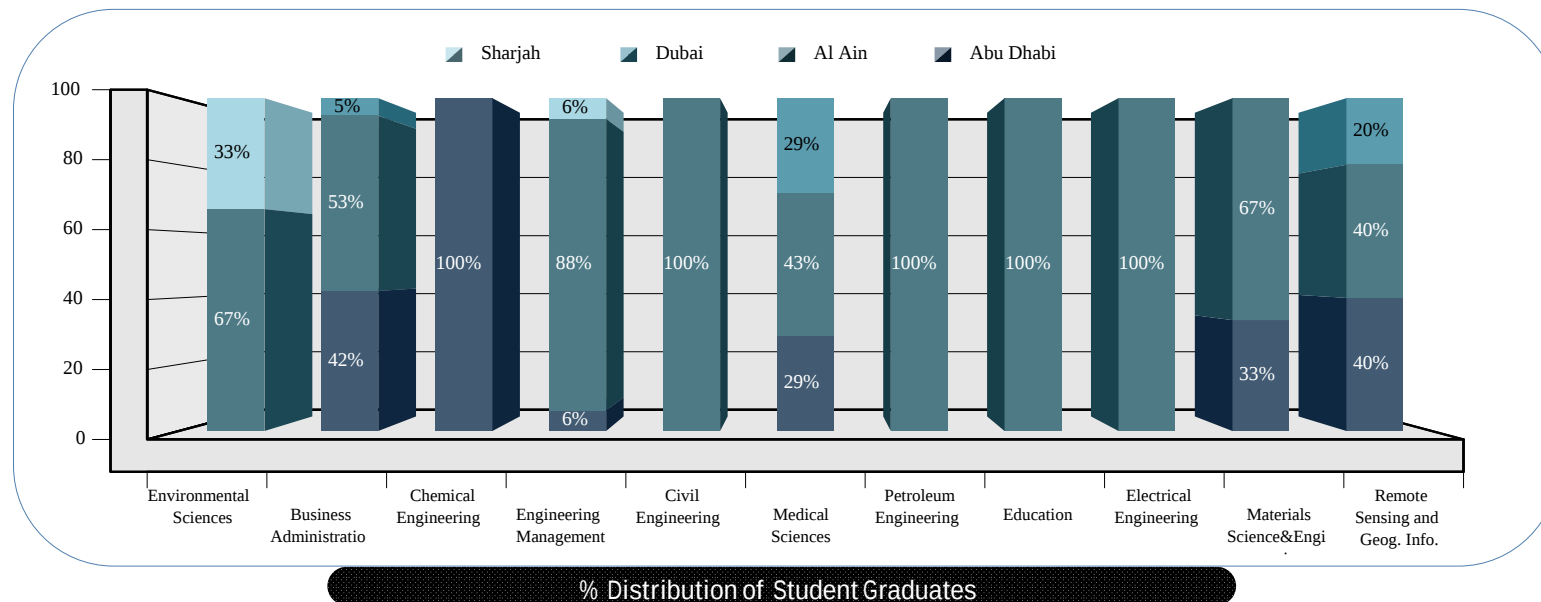


% Distribution of Graduates by Major / Grades

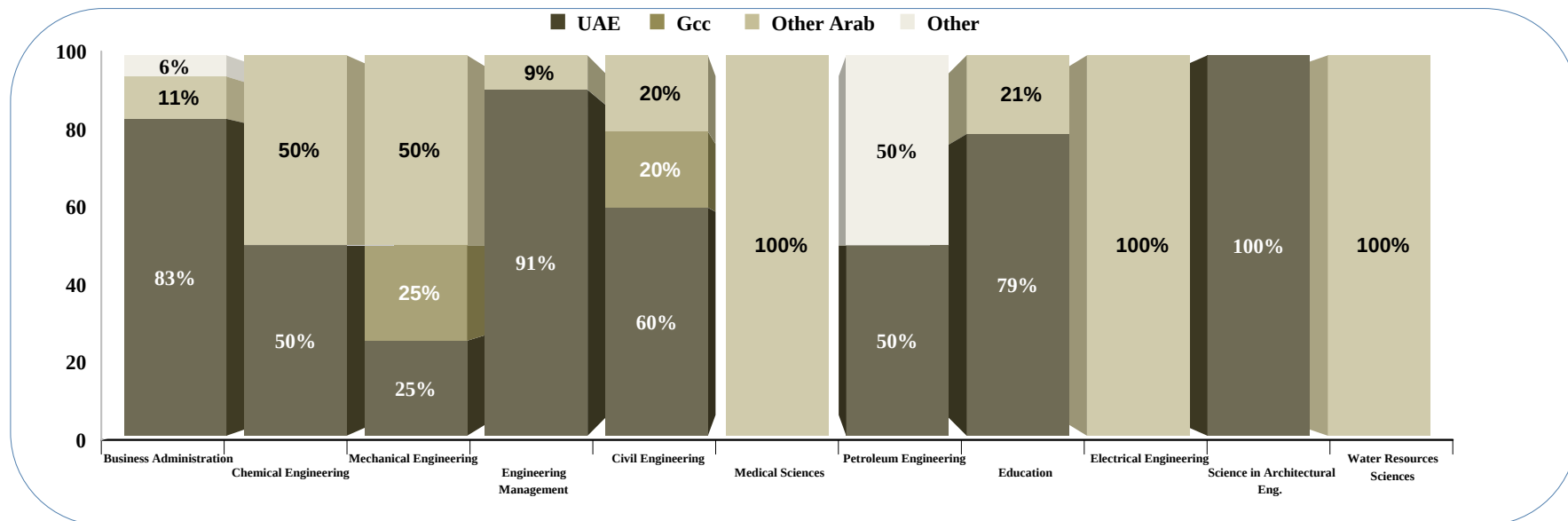
