Concerns over safety of baby walkers in UAE

A study conducted by a team of researchers based in the UAE has raised concerns over the use of baby walkers. The study, which saw the participation of students of various high schools in Al Ain, was led by a team of researchers at the United Arab Emirates University (UAEU). The researchers have found that every child placed in a baby walker is at a risk of injury; there is a 1-in-200 risk of serious disability and a 1-in-1,000 chance of death.
