

Female students from the Department of Mathematical Science in the College of Science at the United Arab Emirates University (UAEU) developed a new mathematical method that relies on the use of some mathematical measurements and then processing them via computer to determine the properties of viscosity of some materials and their efficiency, through the development of a numerical algorithm for solving non-linear differential equations, which will contribute to improving the efficiency of some industrial products within specific manufacturing standards.

Dr. Dalal Al Shamsi, a graduate of the United Arab Emirates University and the first graduate of the doctoral program in the Department of Geology also holds a Bachelor's degree with honours in Petroleum Geology and Water. She also has pursued a Master's degree in Geology and Petroleum Engineering and completed a Ph.D in Geology Radiation. Dr. Al Shamsi has contributed extensively to knowledge about the oil industry in the UAE.



After finishing the Foundation Year at UAEU she joined the College of Science to specialize in geology. Marriage and bringing up two children did not get in the way of her achievements.

Dr. Al Shamsi finds preparing a scientific curriculum her greatest challenge. She offers advice to struggling students pointing out that science takes time and requires trial and error, perseverance and patience. She added that students should "give each subject its own time and do not cram your schedule full in order to speed up graduation. Enjoy your university life since they are the best days of your life."

As to the future, Dr. Al Shamsi is planning to travel to Denmark to study the latest developments in radiation. She thanked the United Arab Emirates University for providing her with the scientific, financial and moral support on both practical and personal levels, that allowed her to become the person she is today.



Students in the College of IT at UAEU invent and design a number of smart applications to support technological developments in the community. These applications meet the needs of individuals in many areas.

UAEU administration accepts 105 students for the 30th cohort in the College of Medicine and Health Sciences (79 female; 26 male). They successfully passed the entrance exams and private interviews for admission.

UAEU ranks in the Arab World according to the latest "QS" University Rankings. It also ranked 100th in global faculty appointment.

A team of students from the College of Engineering at UAEU design a solar desalination system under the supervision of Dr. Muhammad Hamdan from the Department of Mechanical Engineering. The project was funded by Abu Dhabi National Oil Company (ADNOC).

Three students from the College of Information Technology at UAEU design a device to monitor respiratory problems in children, the elderly and other people with respiratory problems such as suffocation during a fire, from gas emission and shifts in weather conditions.

The College of Medicine and Health Sciences at UAEU organized the 12th annual meeting of the College of Medicine and Health Sciences Alumni Association, in collaboration with the Center for Career Placement and Alumni, on the occasion of the 10th anniversary of the graduation of the 2005 cohort of 33 doctors and physicians.
